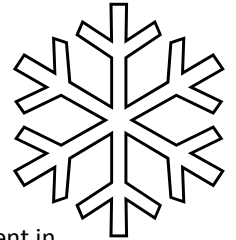
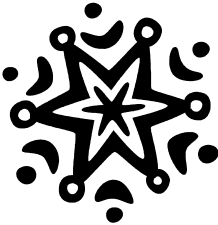

Santa will be there with hot chocolate and cookies!

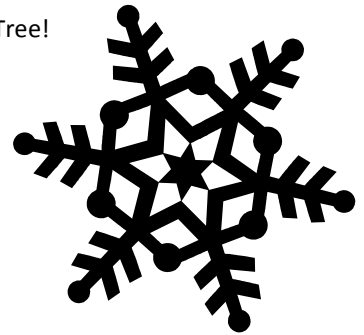
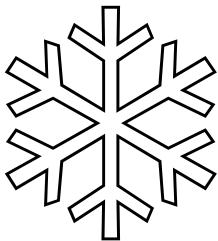
