As part of the city's \$355 million Restore Biloxi Infrastructure Repair Program, a major sewer, water and storm drainage improvements project is coming to your area. We want you to know about potential impacts to your neighborhood.

The construction will take place on Park Hills Court, portions of Holly Hills Drive, Canterbury Drive and Sharon Hills Drive, along Live Oak Drive, along a portion of South Hill Road and on South Hill Court. The project will include replacing water mains, sanitary sewer lines and storm drains as well as replacing the streets, curbs and sidewalks affected by the construction work. Two sewer pump stations will also be part of this effort. The existing Holly Hills pump station will be rehabilitated and a new Monie Vista pump station will be built to replace the existing MV station, which will be removed from service.

The work will begin in early July 2012 and is scheduled to be completed 240 days later. Some lane closures will be required over the course of the work as well as periodic short-term interruptions in water service. However, we will work to inform you about these in advance. You may see heavy equipment using the streets in and around the construction zones. Any traffic detours will be clearly marked.

Please understand that when a city undertakes large improvement projects such as this, temporary inconveniences are unavoidable. We will provide you as much information as possible so that you can plan accordingly.

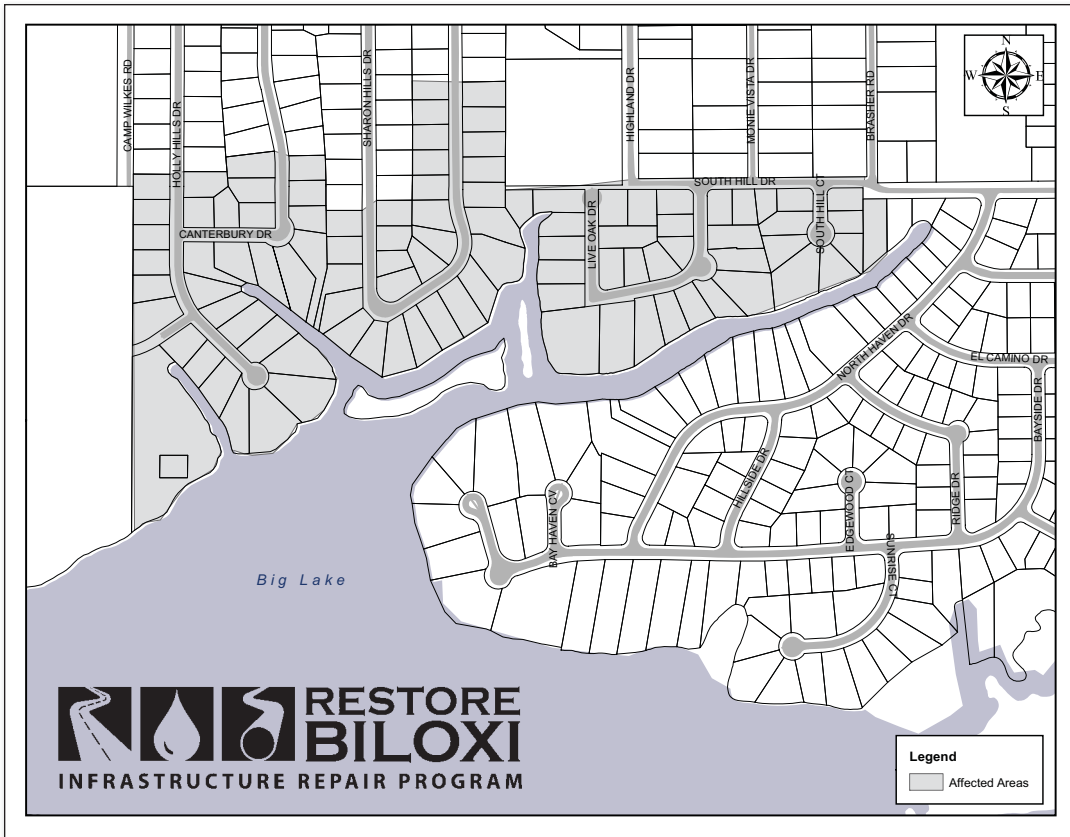
