The city's \$355 million Restore Biloxi Infrastructure Repair Program is coming to your neighborhood, and we want to let you know how this major sewer, water and storm drain improvement project will impact you.

The construction in your area, valued at more than \$3.3 million, will take place primarily along Runnymede Road, Channel Mark Drive, Tide Mark Cove, Lost Channel Drive, Channel Place and Cove Drive. The project will include replacing water mains, sanitary sewer lines and storm drains as well as replacing the streets, curbs and sidewalks impacted by the construction work. As part of this project, the existing sewer pump station along Tide Mark Cove will be eliminated and the existing Goose Pointe sewer pump station will be rehabilitated.

The work will begin early July 2013 and is scheduled to be completed 320 days later, in early June 2014. Some lane closures will be required over the course of the work as well as periodic interruptions to water service. However, we will work to inform you about each of these in advance. You may see heavy equipment using the streets in and near construction zones. Any traffic detours will be clearly marked.

You can learn more about this project, known as RDN1, during a community meeting on Wednesday, June 19, 2013 at the Fine Arts Auditorium, Room D-110 at the Jefferson Davis campus of Mississippi Gulf Coast Community College. The meeting will begin at 6 p.m. Park off DeBuys Road, on the east side of the campus. Representatives from the city, program manager HNTB, and the contractor, Necaise Brothers, will be on hand to answer any questions you might have. Please try and attend this informational meeting.
