As part of the city's \$355 million Restore Biloxi Infrastructure Repair Program, a major sewer, water and storm drainage improvement project is coming to your area. We want you to know about potential impacts to your neighborhood.

The construction will take place on Plantation, Scott, Walters and Jordan Drives, and portions of Saylor, Melissa, Linda and Bonneville Drives. The project will include replacing water mains, sanitary sewer lines and storm drains as well as replacing the streets, curbs and sidewalks affected by the construction work. Sewer pump stations at Linda Drive and Saylor Estates will be eliminated and their flows consolidated into a new Melissa Drive Pump Station.

The work will begin in early July 2012 and is scheduled to be completed 240 days later. Some lane closures will be required over the course of the work as well as periodic short-term interruptions in water service. However, we will work to inform you about these in advance. You may see heavy equipment using the streets in and around the construction zones. Any traffic detours will be clearly marked.

You can learn more about this project at an informational meeting scheduled for Thursday, June 28 at 6 p.m., at the Donal M. Snyder Sr. Community Center on Pass Road. Staff will be on hand to answer any questions you might have.

Once work begins, if you have any questions or issues regarding the project, the contractor for this work is Lane Construction. Lane's Project Manager is Shannon Wilkerson, (228) 219-6303. Lane's Field Superintendent is Johnny Walters, (228) 219-6306.

Please understand that when a city undertakes large improvement projects such as this, temporary inconveniences are unavoidable. We will provide you as much information as possible so that you can plan accordingly.

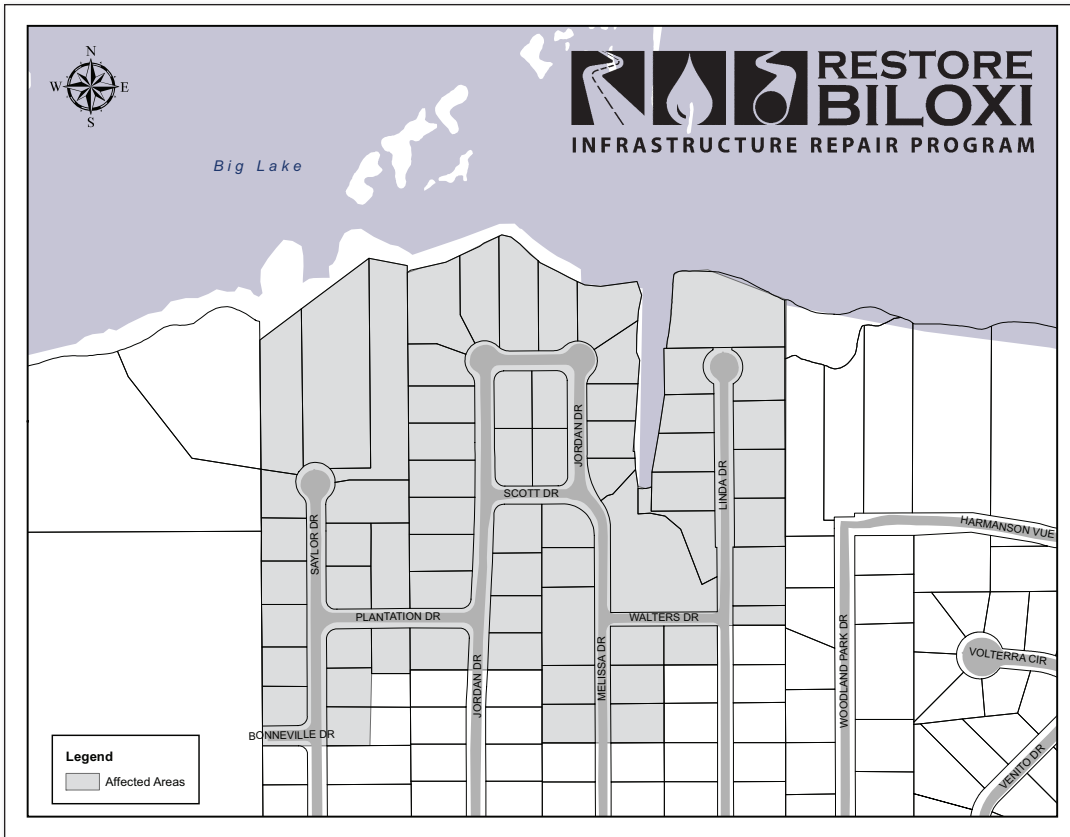
