As part of the city's \$355 million Restore Biloxi Infrastructure Repair Program, a major sewer, water and storm drainage improvements project is coming to your area. We want you to know about potential impacts to your neighborhood.

The construction will take place primarily on Brookside Cove, Christi Lane, Alicia Drive, Mercedes Drive, Walda Drive, a portion of Big Lake Road, the northern end of Provence Place (at the cul-de-sac) and a portion of Old Bay Road and Bay Pointe Drive. The project will include replacing water mains, sanitary sewer lines and storm drains as well as replacing the streets, curbs and sidewalks affected by the construction work. Four wastewater pump stations will be removed from the city's system and consolidated into a new lift station on Walda Drive.

The work will begin in late March 2012 and is scheduled to be completed 240 days later, in mid-November. Some lane closures will be required over the course of the work as well as periodic short-term interruptions in water service. However, we will work to inform you about these in advance. You may see heavy equipment using the streets in and near the construction zones. Any traffic detours will be clearly marked.

You can learn more about this project at an informational meeting scheduled for Wednesday, March 14, at 6 p.m., at the Donal M. Snyder Sr. Community Center, 2520 Pass Road, Biloxi. Staff will be on hand to answer any questions you might have.

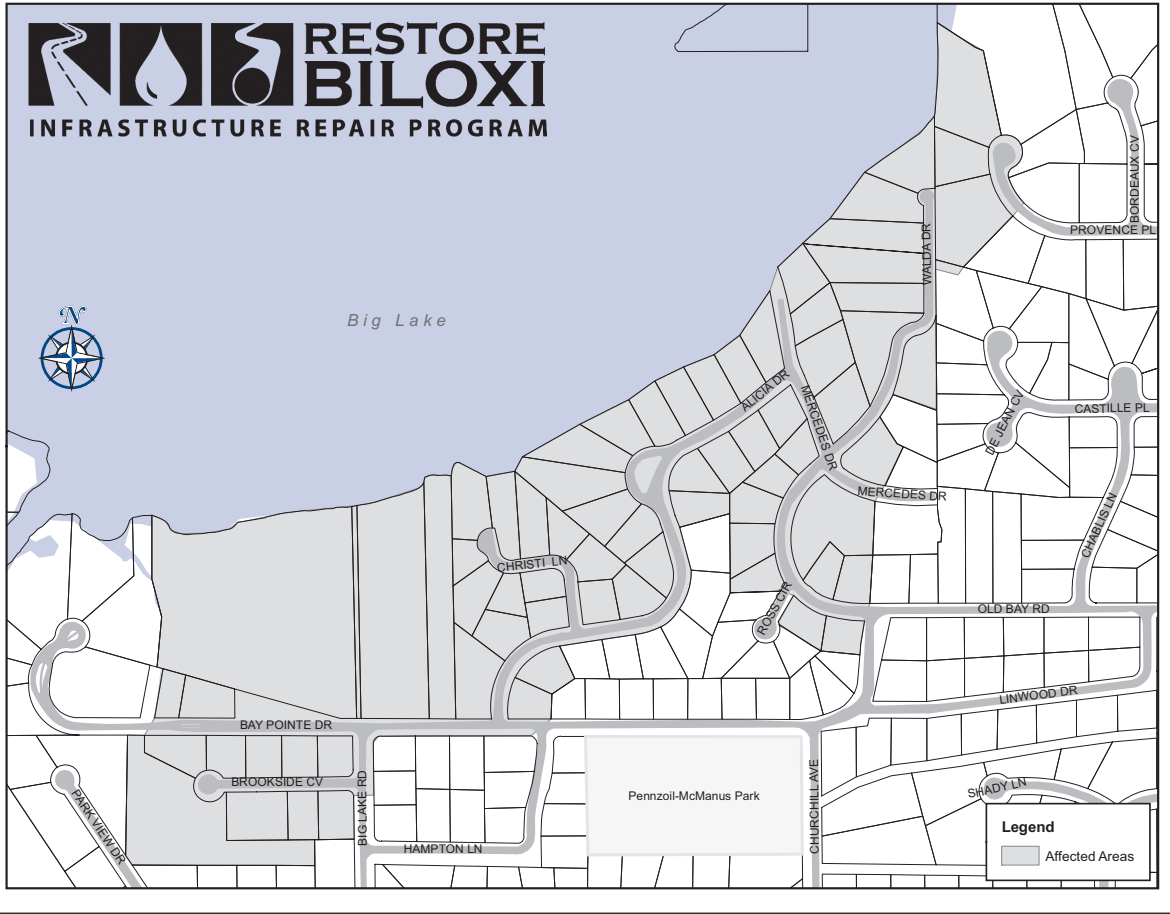
