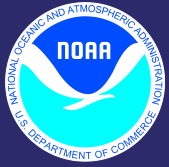

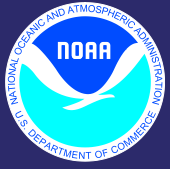




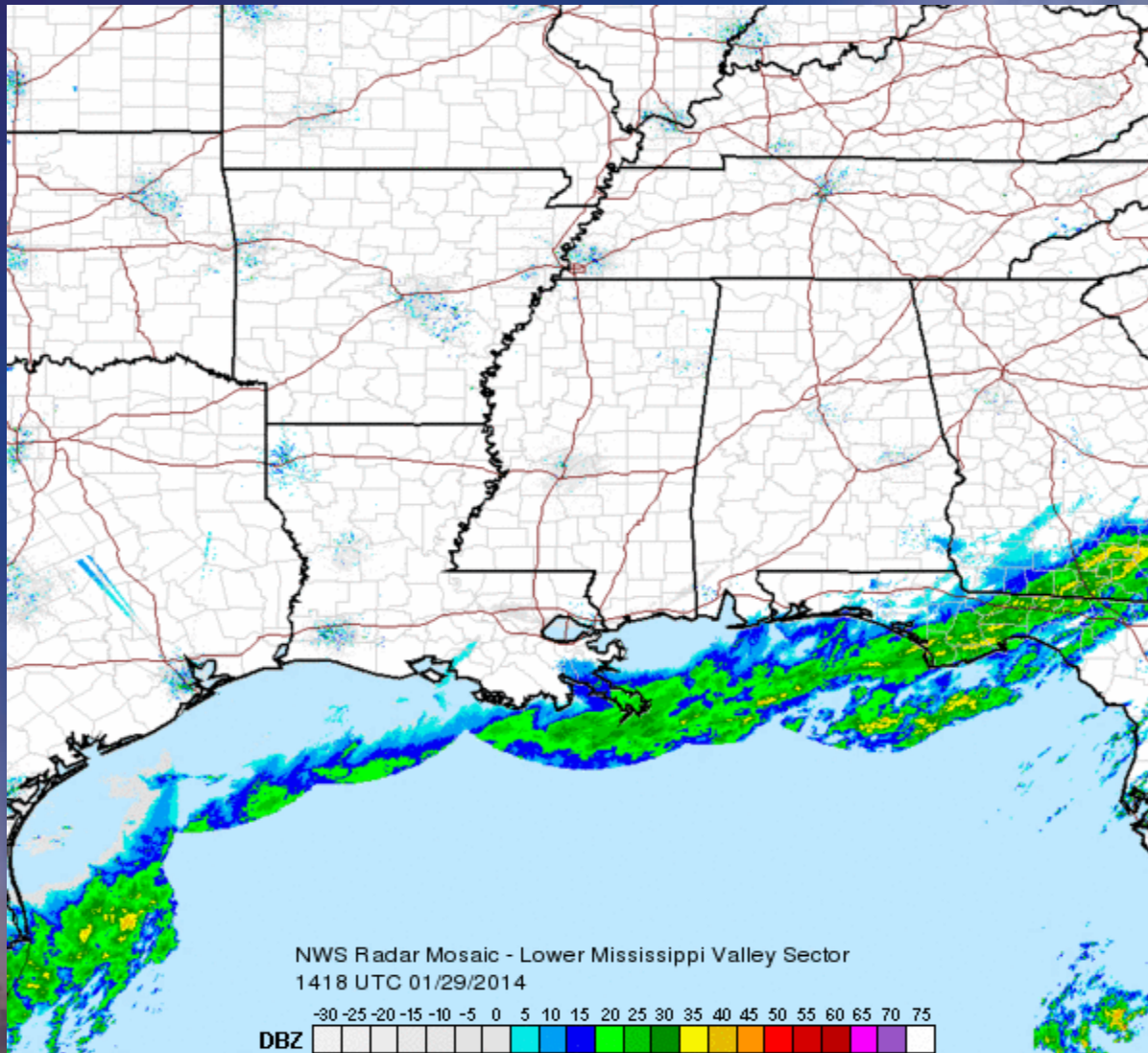
Overview

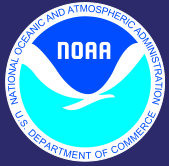


- **Temperatures ranging in the 20s across much of the region this morning.**
- **Most locations will remain below freezing through much of the morning (cloud cover could be the one thorn in the side).**
- **Hard Freeze warning in effect for tonight**
 - *Lows ranging from mid teens to mid 20s*
 - *Freezing temperatures expected for another 14-18 hours*



Latest Radar

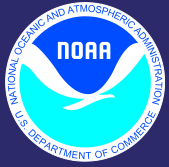




Impacts and Outlook



- **Ice will continue to be a problem until the temperatures get above freezing. At this time temperatures should get above freezing across much of the area around noon but if clouds hang around longer temperatures may struggle until mid afternoon.**
- **Estimate 3 to 6 hours above freezing.**
- **Temperatures will quickly fall this evening with southwestern and coastal MS back below freezing around 6pm, the Baton Rouge metro and the northshore around 7pm, and then the southshore around 8pm.**
- **A Hard Freeze will occur again tonight . Overnight lows range from the mid teens to near 20 along and north of the 10/12 corridor and low to mid 20s elsewhere with freezing temperatures expected for another 14-18 hours.**
- **Back above freezing between 9 and 11am Thursday morning.**
