Notice is hereby given that the City of Biloxi, Mississippi, will receive sealed bids at the Mayor's Office, City Hall, second floor, until 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, the **30th day of June, 2010**, for the following:

**CONTRACT FOR OIL POLLUTION
PROTECTION AND REMOVAL IN RESPONSE TO THE
BRITISH PETROLEUM DEEPWATER HORIZON OIL SPILL
CITY OF BILOXI, MISSISSIPPI**

The City of Biloxi will accept Statements of Qualifications & Experience from qualified firms for **OIL POLLUTION PROTECTION AND REMOVAL SERVICES** for a pre-position contract to facilitate the protection of the waters, lands, and facilities of the City of Biloxi; and in the event the oil pollution breaches the protective measures, the removal and proper disposal of the oil pollution from the BP Deepwater Horizon Oil Spill at the direction of the City. The service will include placement and continued maintenance of oil spill protective measures, all labor, materials and equipment necessary for oil spill clean up measures, proper disposal in an approved landfill, preparation of operational reports, meetings and communications. This contract will be for a term of 2 years, and since this is a pre-event contract, work assignments will not be issued unless directed by the City Engineer and approved by the Mayor. The work performed under this contract will be in conjunction with the work performed by British Petroleum (BP), their contractors and/or sub-contractors.

The Oil Spill Pollution Contractor will assist the City in identifying the effort needed to enhance the protective and cleanup measures being implemented by BP, their contractors and/or subcontractors and mobilize the labor, equipment, and materials necessary to meet the obligations outlined in the Scope of Services. The Contractor must be familiar with the National Oil and Hazardous Substances Contingency Plan, the Mobile Area Contingency Plan, and the City of Biloxi Sub Area Contingency Plan, and have a proven track record of providing these services.

Please forward 5 copies of your proposal to the Mayor's Office by **10:00 AM on June 30, 2010**, with your firm qualifications and hourly rates (completed in the format as shown in the FEE Table). Minimum information in the Statements of Qualifications & Experience must include: a reference list of at least five (5) clients for whom you have performed similar services, completed Fee Table, and Project Manager with contact information and experience. A selection committee will rank the proposals received by the following criteria:

Experience on Oil Spill Remediation Contracts within in last 5 years	40%
Schedule of Contract Items	40%
Personnel	10%
Office and Equipment Locations	10%

Proposals will be reviewed by the selection committee using the above selection criteria. A written contract will be awarded to the firm whose proposal is within the competitive range and determined by the committee to be most advantageous to the City, cost and other factors considered. The contract will include scope and extent of work and other essential requirements. The City of Biloxi reserves the right to reject any and all proposals and to waive any irregularities or informalities in the proposal process. The City of Biloxi is an equal opportunity employer.
