

PUBLIC MEETING

To discuss an environmental assessment for a portion of Popp's Ferry Road and the Popp's Ferry Bridge

Thursday, March 6, 2008, anytime between 5:30 and 7:30 p.m.

The first phase of improving the Popp's Ferry Bridge and Popp's Ferry Road between Pass Road and Riverview Drive (across from the Margaret Sherry Library) is to perform an environmental assessment. An environmental assessment is a preliminary analysis to identify any issues to be addressed before the construction phase would begin.

Public input is vital at this early stage of the assessment. Please encourage neighbors and business owners to attend this meeting and bring any questions you may have.

No formal presentation will be made. Instead, this will be an informal setting where you will be able to individually look at the maps, discuss issues with the design team and public leaders, and provide comments on this potential project.

The environmental assessment will take as long as 16 months and will evaluate the feasibility of expanding the existing roadway to accommodate existing and projected traffic patterns.

This is not a discussion regarding a "North/South Corridor" between I-10 and U.S. 90. Instead, this project is an assessment of widening or building a new Popp's Ferry Bridge and improving the portion of Popp's Ferry Road from Pass Road to the Margaret Sherry Library.
