The Biloxi Planning Commission will conduct a public hearing on Thursday, April 21, 2011, at 2:00 p.m. in the Auditorium of the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., Municipal Building located at 676 Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard, Biloxi, Mississippi, to hear the application of the City of Biloxi, Case No. 11-017-PC.

The purpose of the hearing is to consider a charge from the City Council of the City of Biloxi to the Biloxi Planning Commission to review the possibility of renaming an existing street – to specifically consider changing the name of an approximate one thousand, four and seventy-five (1,475) linear foot section of roadway, presently identified upon the City's Comprehensive Street Map as Highway 15, to Reece Bergeron Road, said street renaming to be compatible with a similar action presently being contemplated by Harrison County, and to change the City's Comprehensive Street Map to reflect said name change, the aforementioned Highway 15 described as being most nearly bounded by the following streets: to the North by and terminating at the Biloxi City Limits; to the South by and terminating at Old Highway 67; to the East by Highway 67; and to the West by Paradise Lane.



The Biloxi Planning Commission will conduct a public hearing on Thursday, April 21, 2011, at 2:00 p.m. in the Auditorium of the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., Municipal Building located at 676 Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard, Biloxi, Mississippi, to hear the application of the City of Biloxi, Case No. 11-018-PC.

The purpose of the hearing is to consider a charge from the City Council of the City of Biloxi to the Biloxi Planning Commission to review the possibility of renaming an existing street – specifically, to consider changing the name of a segment of roadway, measuring approximately two and seventy-five one-hundredths (2.75) miles in length (more or less), and presently identified upon the City’s Comprehensive Street Map as Highway 67, said new street name undetermined at this time, but open for suggestions, noting that the new name will be coordinated with Harrison County to insure roadway name compatibility with that roadway which is not situated within the Corporate Limits of the City of Biloxi, the present Highway 67 being described as a primary arterial roadway most nearly bounded by the following streets: to the North by and terminating at the Biloxi City Limits; to the South by and terminating at West Oaklawn Road; to the East by Old Highway 67; and to the West by Lorraine Road.
