Recipe of the Month

Quick Remoulade Sauce

- 2 green onions
- 1 clove garlic
- 1/4 cup reduced-fat mayonnaise
- 1 T. dijon mustard
- 1 T. sweet pickle relish
- 1/4 tsp. cayenne pepper

Makes about 1/2 cup. Use on fish fillets, shrimp, crab patties, etc.
