2014 ACTION PLAN AMENDMENT

Notice is hereby given that the City of Biloxi's Department of Community Development will conduct a public hearing for the purpose of affording citizens of Biloxi an opportunity to:

Present their views and comments relative to a proposed amendment to the Biloxi 2014 Action Plan to decrease funding for approved, HOME-funded activities to develop and implement HOME-funded programs to address homelessness in the City of Biloxi. Specifically, the City of Biloxi is proposing to use previous and current years' HOME funds to construct a 4- to 6-unit rental complex for qualified homeless veterans and to initiate a rental assistance program to assist qualified homeless families with children.

The public hearing will be held in the Community Development Auditorium located at 676 Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard in downtown Biloxi at 5:30 p.m., Thursday, July 24, 2014. All interested citizens are urged to attend, particularly those of low, very low, and extremely low income, minorities, residents of public housing, and those with mobility, visual, and hearing impediments.
