RESOLUTION ORDERING THAT A SPECIAL ELECTION BE HELD FOR THE OFFICE OF MAYOR

WHEREAS, A.J. Holloway has submitted his resignation as Mayor, effective as of a Special Meeting held on March 10, 2015 by Resolution No. 105-15; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 21-8-7(5), Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended, vacancies in municipal office are to be filled according to the procedure established in Section 23-15-857, MCA, wherein the City Council is required to order a special election to be held to fill said vacancy; and,

WHEREAS, said election must be held on a date not less than thirty (30) days and not more than (45) days after the date upon which the order mandating the election is adopted;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BILOXI, MISSISSIPPI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: A vacancy in the office of Mayor is hereby acknowledged and declared as by Resolution No. 105-15.

SECTION 2: A special election is hereby ordered to be held on April 28, 2015, to elect a Mayor to complete the remainder of the term.

SECTION 3: The Municipal Clerk shall cause a notice to be published once each week for three (3) successive weeks preceding the date of such election, the first notice to be published at least thirty (30) days before the date of the election. Said notice shall also be posted in at least three (3) public places in the municipality not less than twenty-one (21) days prior to the date of the election, one such location being City Hall.

SECTION 4: As provided in Section 23-15-875, MCA, candidates must qualify by

petition filed with the Municipal Clerk at least twenty (20) days before the date of the election, and the petition must be signed by not less than fifty (50) qualified electors of the City in order to have their name placed upon the ballot.

SECTION 5: The Mayor, Municipal Clerk, and legal counsel are hereby authorized and directed to submit the acts of calling this election.
