Game-Day Experience Traffic Plan

- Howard Ave., through Vieux Marché, closed to vehicles all day
- Howard Ave., Caillavet to Reynoir, closes at 10:30 a.m.
- Caillavet, southbound, closes at 12:30 p.m.
- Caillavet, northbound, open all day
- Pedestrian Only
- Stadium

All other roads remain open.

- The Vieux Marche portion of Howard Avenue - from Reynoir to Lameuse - will be closed all day Saturday. The portion of Howard from Caillavet to Reynoir will close to vehicles about 10:30 a.m.
- Caillavet Street south of Howard will be closed to southbound traffic about 12:30 p.m.; however, northbound traffic from U.S. 90 will be permitted.
- North and southbound traffic will be permitted on Reynoir and Lameuse
- Roadways will remain closed until about 30 minutes after the end of the ball game
- Officers will be posted along U.S. 90 between Lameuse and Hopkins to assist with pedestrian traffic



Free park and ride service

For opening day, CTA will offer free park and ride service along its Casino Hopper route from 5:30 a.m. to 10 p.m. Take the shuttle service from your favorite east Biloxi casino resort and you'll be dropped off at the Biloxi Transit Center, two blocks from the game and in the middle of the Game-Day Experience.

The CTA shuttle fleet will stop at each location every 20 minutes during peak times.
