<u>Accountable Governance – Municipal Development/Use of</u> Public Space

Rationale: In the past year, the Georgian government strengthened the role of municipalities, and the U.S. Mission in Georgia is eager to work with newly enfranchised municipal public servants and those supporting municipal development efforts.
