



Last week in Community Development, site work began on the proposed Mugshots Restaurant to be located downtown at the corner of Water and Main streets. The developer is hoping to be open for Cruisin' the Coast in October. A certificate of occupancy was issued for the new Sonic Restaurant located in the former Backyard Burger building on Pass Road. The new Sonic opened last Wednesday.

Building Plans were submitted last week for the proposed Waffle House Restaurant to be located on Beach Boulevard, just west of the Church of the Redeemer property, and a building permit was issued for an addition to Love's Truck Stop on Cedar Lake Road. Building plans are scheduled to be submitted this Friday for the proposed Salt Grass Restaurant to be located on Beach Boulevard across from the Golden Nugget.

Construction is continuing on the New Biloxi Junior High School, The Watermark Hotel, Saint Mary's Catholic Church, Citizens Bank, Tuesday Morning, Southern Supply, Camping World, Gulf Beach RV Resort, Sunbelt Lighting, Dunkin Donuts, and a number of other commercial projects. There are also 90 single family houses currently under construction.
