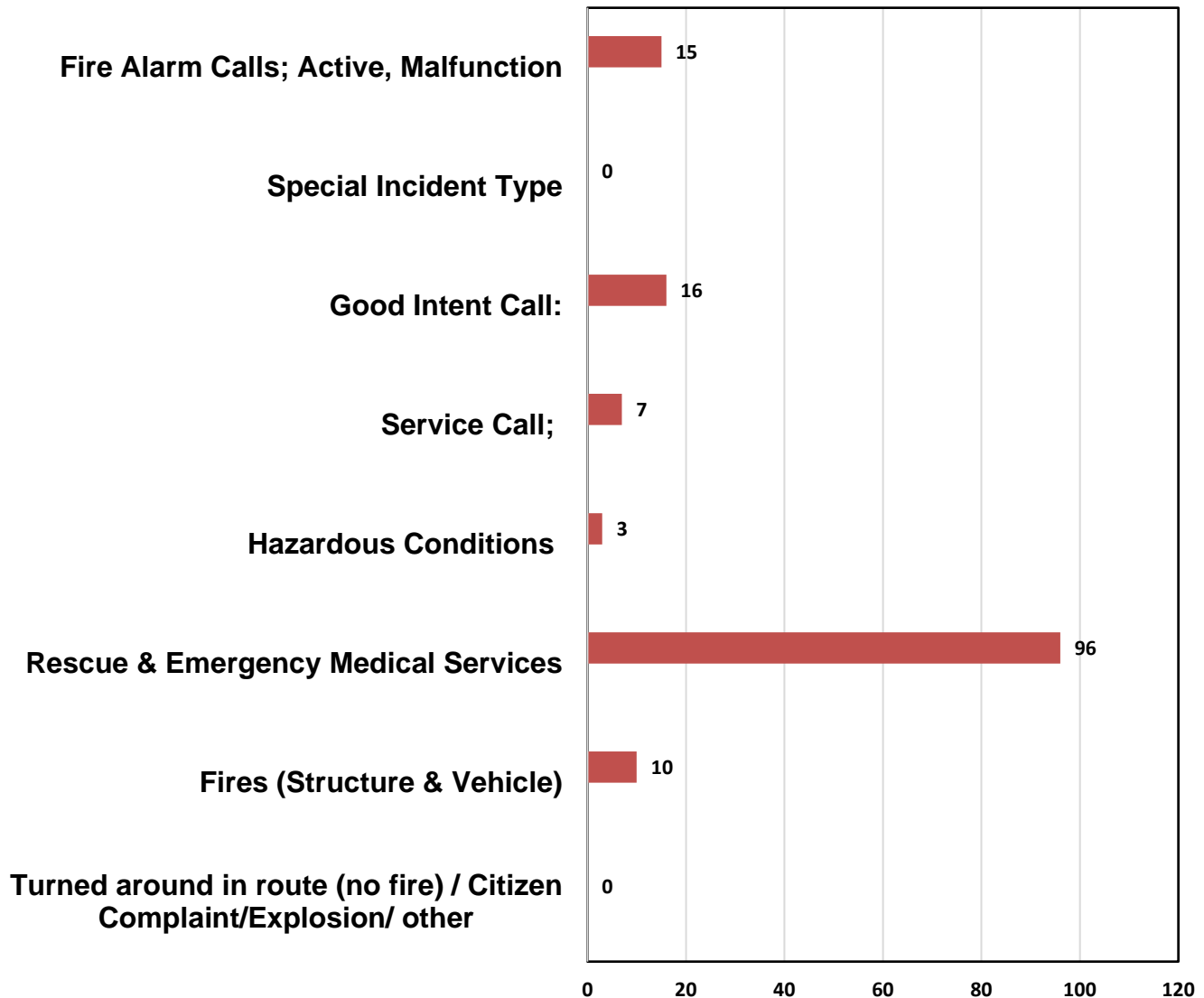

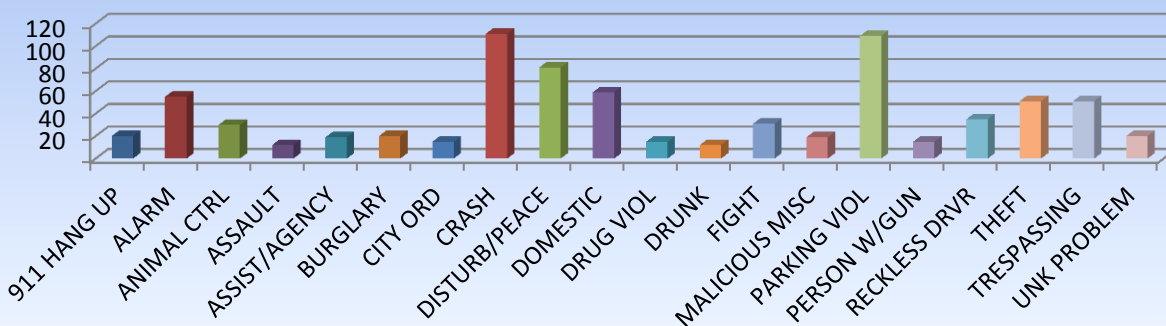

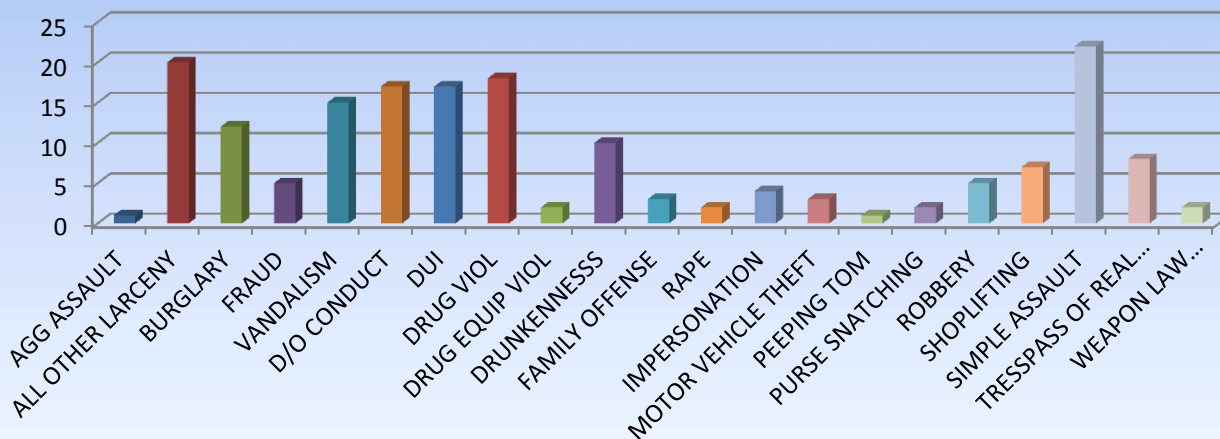

Last week in Community Development, the Development Review Committee reviewed a site plan for the conversion of the former Merchiston Hall Building on Howard Avenue into new professional offices for Machado/Patano Architectural and Engineering Services. The proposal calls for the complete renovation of both tenant spaces of the structure. The proposed improvements will be required to go before the AHRC prior to permitting. The DRC also reviewed a site plan for a new boat storage facility to be located on Hudson Krohn Road north of Old Hwy 67.

Also last week, the Biloxi Planning Commission voted unanimously to approve a zoning change application for property located at the south end of Wetzel Drive to accommodate a 24 lot single family subdivision. If approved by the City Council, the zoning for the 27.6 acres will change from AR, Agricultural Restricted Zoning to RS 7.5, Residential Single Family with minimum 7500 sq. ft. lots.

This week the DRC will consider an application for an 84 lot single family subdivision at Lorraine Road and Hillside Road. On Thursday, the AHRC will review the architectural plans for the proposed Mugshots Restaurant to be located on Main Street north of Patio 44.
