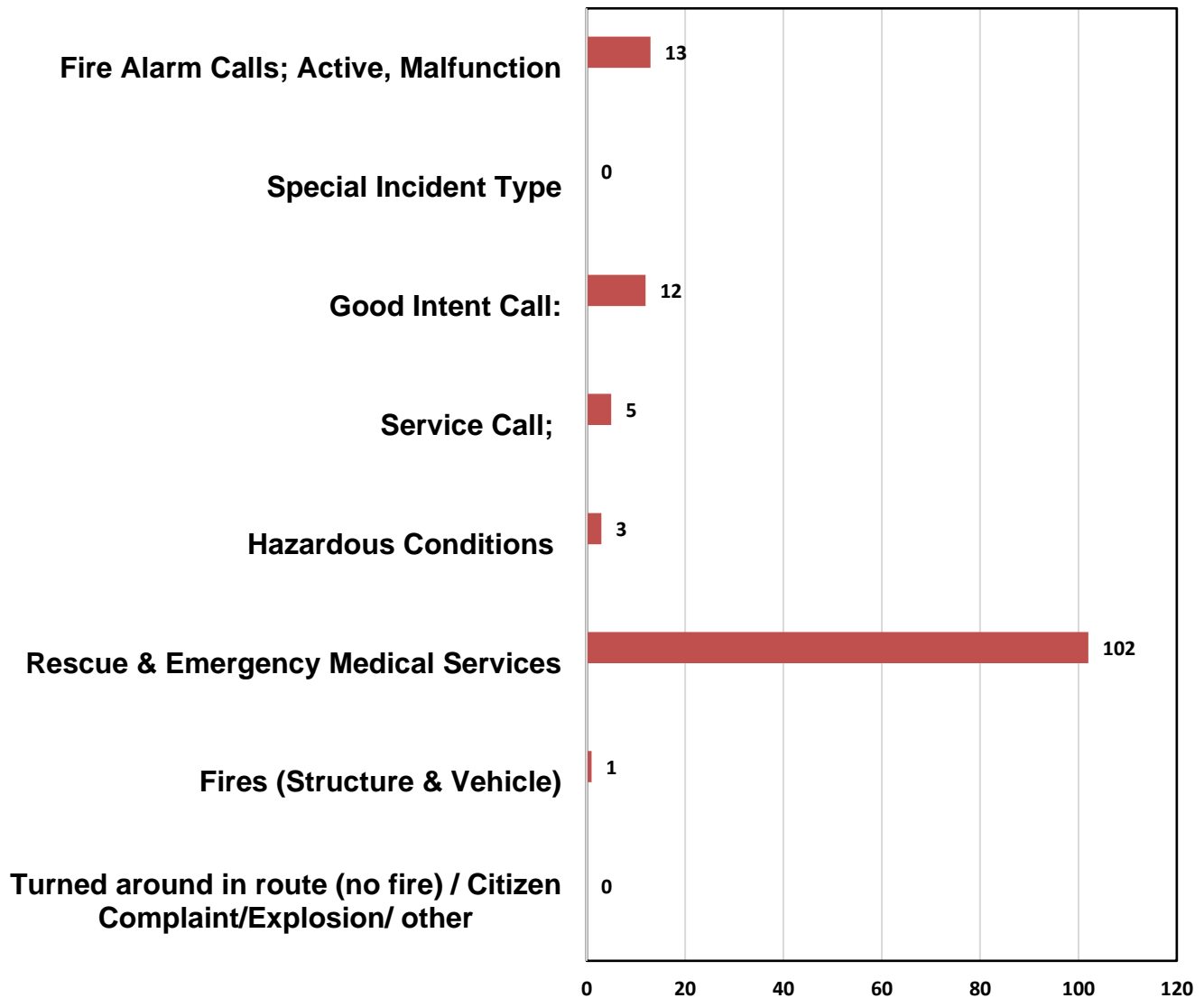

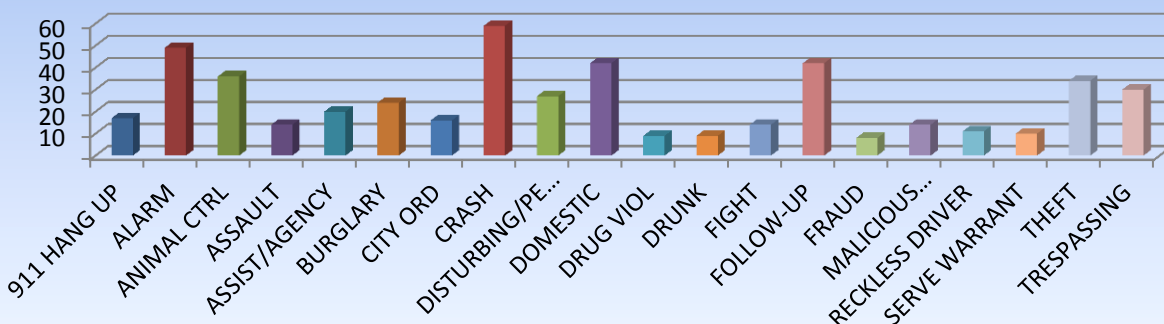

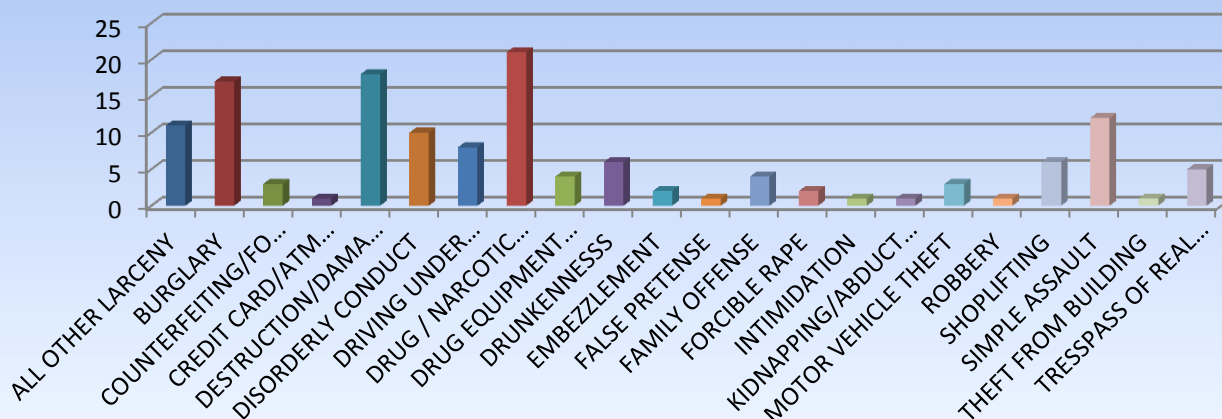

Last week in Community Development, the building department issued a building permit for the New Sunbelt Lighting retail store to be located at the northeast corner of I-10 and Cedar Lake Road. The 12,500 sq. ft. lighting and electrical supply center will cater to both homeowners and contractors. Construction is scheduled to begin immediately.

Also last week, a plans review was completed for the Tuesday Morning retail store to be located in Edgewater Village. The build-out is scheduled to begin immediately and should be complete this spring. Building plans were received last week for the renovation/conversion of the former Back Yard Burger building on Pass Road into a Sonic Restaurant. This will be only the second “dine in” Sonic in Mississippi.

This week the city council will conduct a first reading for a zoning change application from Gulf Coast Rescue Mission for property located at 2750 and 2758 Mission Lane. The zoning request to change the current zoning from RM-30, Residential Multi-Family to NB, Neighborhood Business, is necessary to allow the Mission to have retail sales. The council will also consider a resolution for Preliminary and Final Plat Subdivision approval for property located at 1795 Brasher Road. The proposed subdivision will have nine lots.
