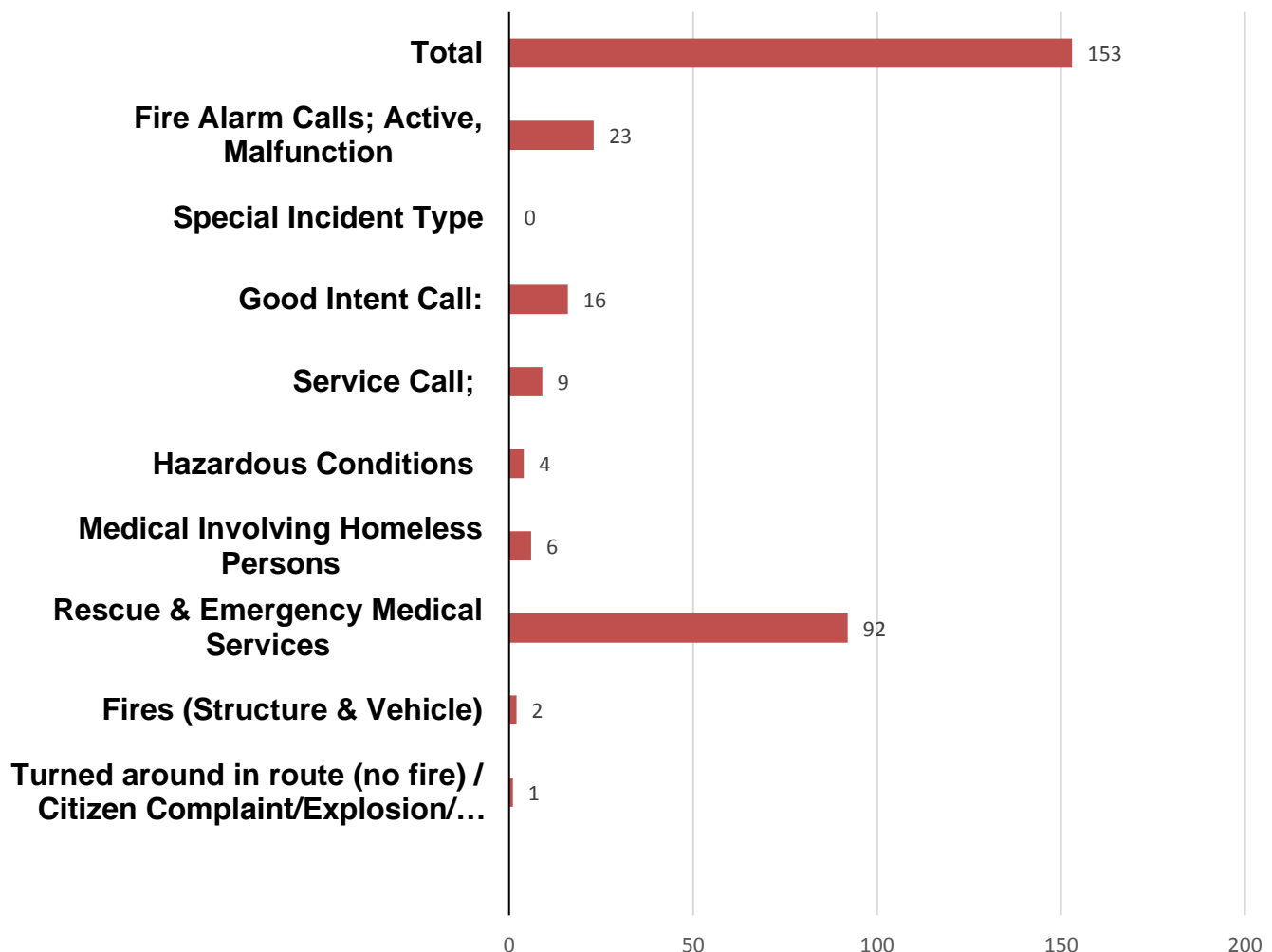

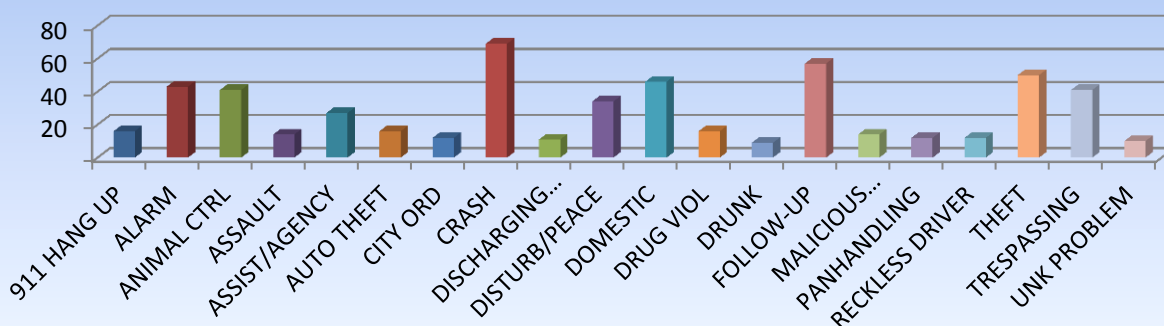

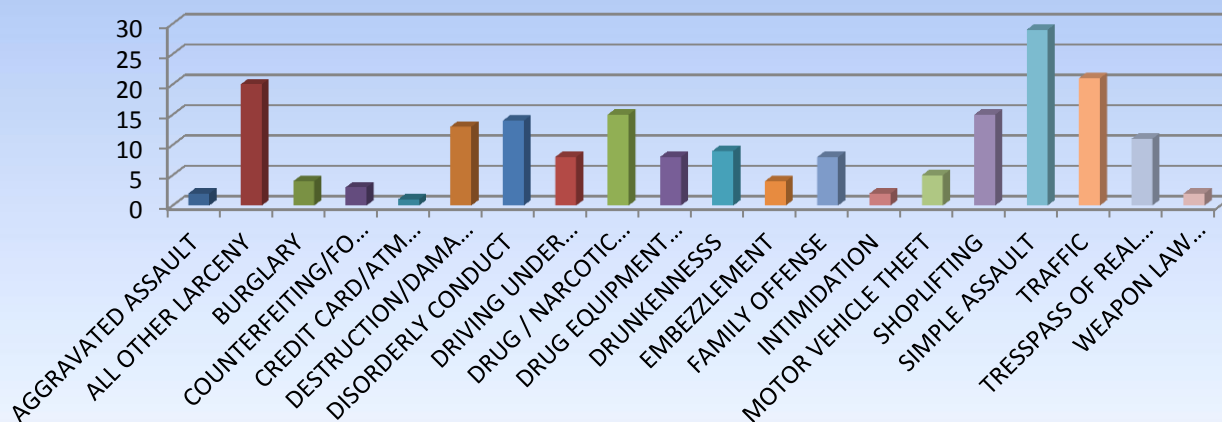

### Hurricane Nate

- Lighthouse Pier Repairs opens bids on April 4<sup>th</sup>
- Ice Wharf, Coliseum and Oak St. Pier Repairs opens bids on April 4<sup>th</sup>

### Projects

- Amtrak rail platform grant – Continuing assisting Southern Rail Commission with grant application
- Bayview Avenue Boardwalk – Met with Seymour Engineering for an update, Mayor approved conceptual, moving forward with permitting
- **Belle La Vie Parkway** – Survey completed for Increment 1; Contract with Garner Russell & Associates on Feb. 27<sup>th</sup> Council Agenda for surveying of Increment 2A, 2B & Technology Center
- Canaan Fishing Dock Improvements – Conceptual approved, need contract amendment to begin wetlands
- **CIPP McDonnell Ave.** – Rejected bids due to state of pipe during point repair, having to do emergency replacement of pipe instead of lining
- **Clearview Drainage** – Notified contractor of sprinkler heads, contractor trying to coordinate hydroseeding
- **CSX Crossing Closure** – Waiting for MDOT approval of MOU prior to moving forward with NS contract
- **Dredging** – Finished Canaan, Point Cadet finished, working on Hiller Park Permit pending for Oak Street debris removal

- East Biloxi Public Access & Living Shoreline – Task D (Palace to Bridge) and Task E (Bridge to Small Craft) under design;
- East Biloxi Boardwalk (Small Craft to Kuhn St.) – BMA performing structural analysis
- Ellzey Place II – Lane Construction expected to be completed end of April or early May
- Ellzey Place III – had 30% review meeting with Rumsey Engineering working on utility conflicts at Senior Center
- Emerald Lake Subdivision Phase II (Hudson Krohn Rd.) – ready for final plat
- **Excursion Pier** – Pier complete
- Fire Station No. 7 – SMPDD negotiating with contractor
- Fire Station No. 10 – 90% complete, Williams finalizing offsite utility work
- **Howard Avenue** – Bids currently under review
- **Lighthouse Parking Lot** - Paving work will be complete this week; then 2 weeks for striping; going to add fencing inside of plant islands in parking areas to prevent vehicle traffic
- Jordan Subdivision (Old Hwy 67) – Utility installation complete; installing roll over curb
- **Kayleigh Cove Sewer** – Sidewalk complete, contractor finishing final clean up
- Keesler Gate Outside – Parcel acquisition underway
- **Keesler Gate Inside** – Pre-bid meeting held Feb. 22<sup>nd</sup>, had about 10 contractors in attendance; Opens bids on March 14<sup>th</sup>, currently 7 plan holders
- Keesler Privatization – submitted 2<sup>nd</sup> round responses; expect final decision Oct – Dec 2018
- Popp's Ferry Extension – preparing maps & deeds for property acquisition; talking to Coliseum about contributing funds for project
- **Pedestrian Crosswalk @ MGM** – Traffic control in place, delivery of materials has started,

- Pedestrian Crosswalk @ Harbor – Survey complete; geotech samples complete; waiting for geotech report
- Public Safety Center & Donal Snyder Center Roof Leaks – Dale Partners doing assessment of buildings
- **Popps Ferry Bridge Submarine Cable** – Bids being tabulated by DE, apparent lowest bidder KR Borries at \$1.1M; will find out March 1<sup>st</sup> if additional funding is available
- Popps Ferry Bridge & Approaches – pending EA approval
- Popps Ferry Causeway – construction continuing; adding the following work – sidewalk to Cambridge Drive, additional solar lights, fishing cleaning stations, bait tanks at bait shop, kayak racks at bait shop, additional educational signs and components, upgrade walking trail materials to flexipave; trying to fit in additional parking but looking like there's not enough room; any work at the boat ramp was denied because it wasn't in original scope and there are not permits covering that area
- Post Office Build-out – Finalizing HVAC, should receive plan by mid march then project will be ready to bid
- **Rock Creek Subdivision Phase III** – contractor finishing punchlist, working toward final plat approval; contractor working on re-grading some of the properties along Sage Road to drain toward street instead of toward existing homes in rear, meeting with Resident on Wednesday afternoon to look at drainage issue
- Saenger Theater – Exterior repair design underway
- Smith Subdivision – Saunders Const. has done clearing & grubbing but no other work; no start date at this time
- **Tremont Drive repairs** – Complete
- West Biloxi Boardwalk - Project under construction
- Woolmarket Master Plan – Pending final submittal
- Woolmarket Rd. East Drainage – met with Corps of Engineers and DMR; going to have to minimize impact to wetlands
- **Woolmarket Rd. East (Larkin) water line** – Received bids, DNA Underground apparent low, contract award on Feb. 27<sup>th</sup> Council Agenda
