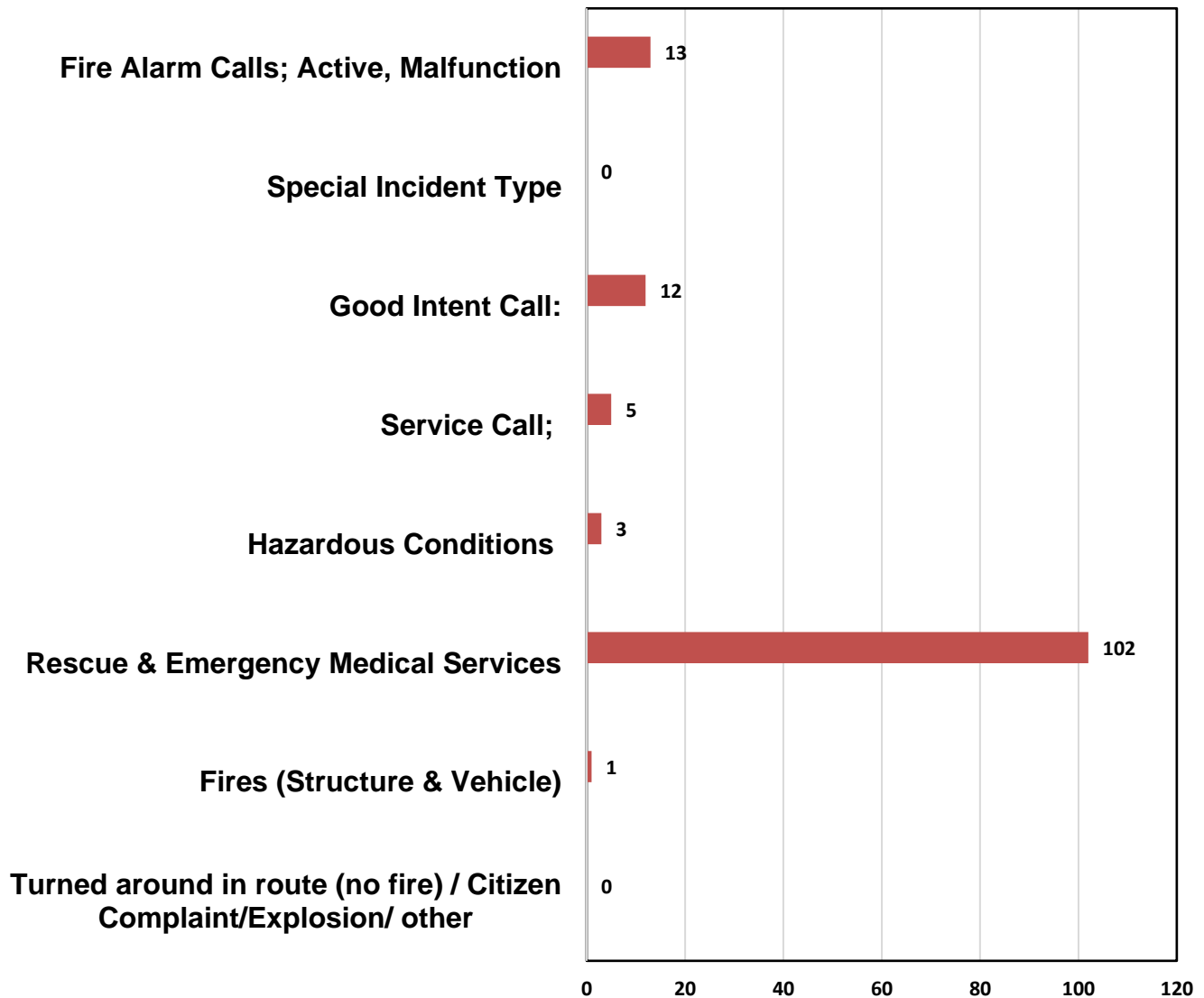

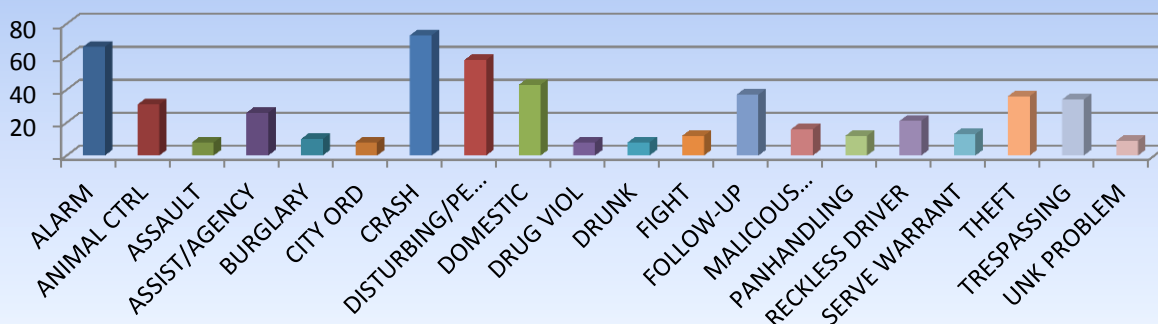

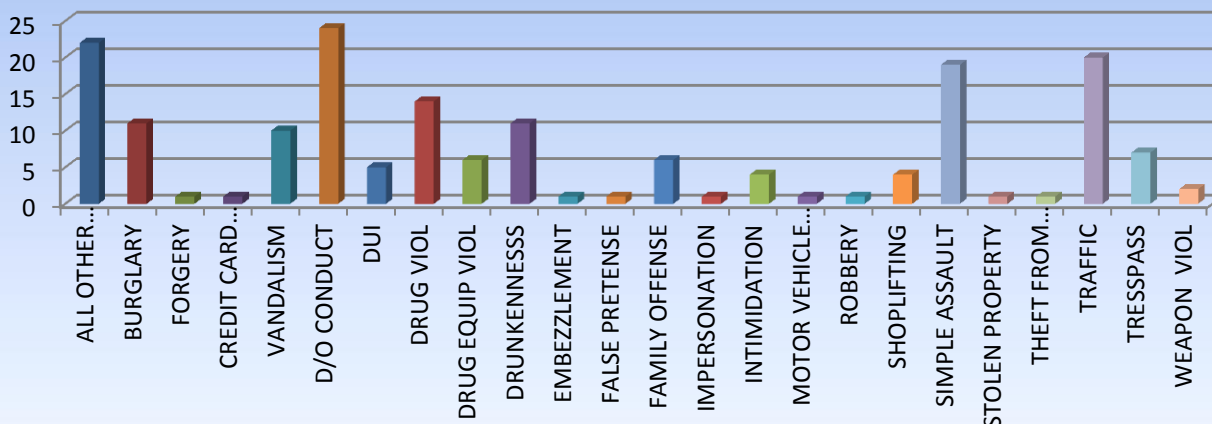

Last week in Community Development, a building permit was issued to Edgewater Village for Tuesday Morning. The new retail store will be located in the tenant space just north of Hibbett Sports, and should be open in early spring. A permit was also issued for a new parsonage for the Vietnamese Martyrs Church at 171 Oak Street.

Also last week the Development Review Committee examined site plans for a proposed commercial retail center at Popp's Ferry Road and Tee Street, the rebuilding of the Gulf Coast Rescue Mission on Mission Lane, and a new doughnut restaurant at 1739 Pass Road. This week the DRC will sign off on the site plan for Dunkin Doughnuts on Cedar Lake Road, and will review a proposed expansion to AAA Storage on Eisenhower Drive.
