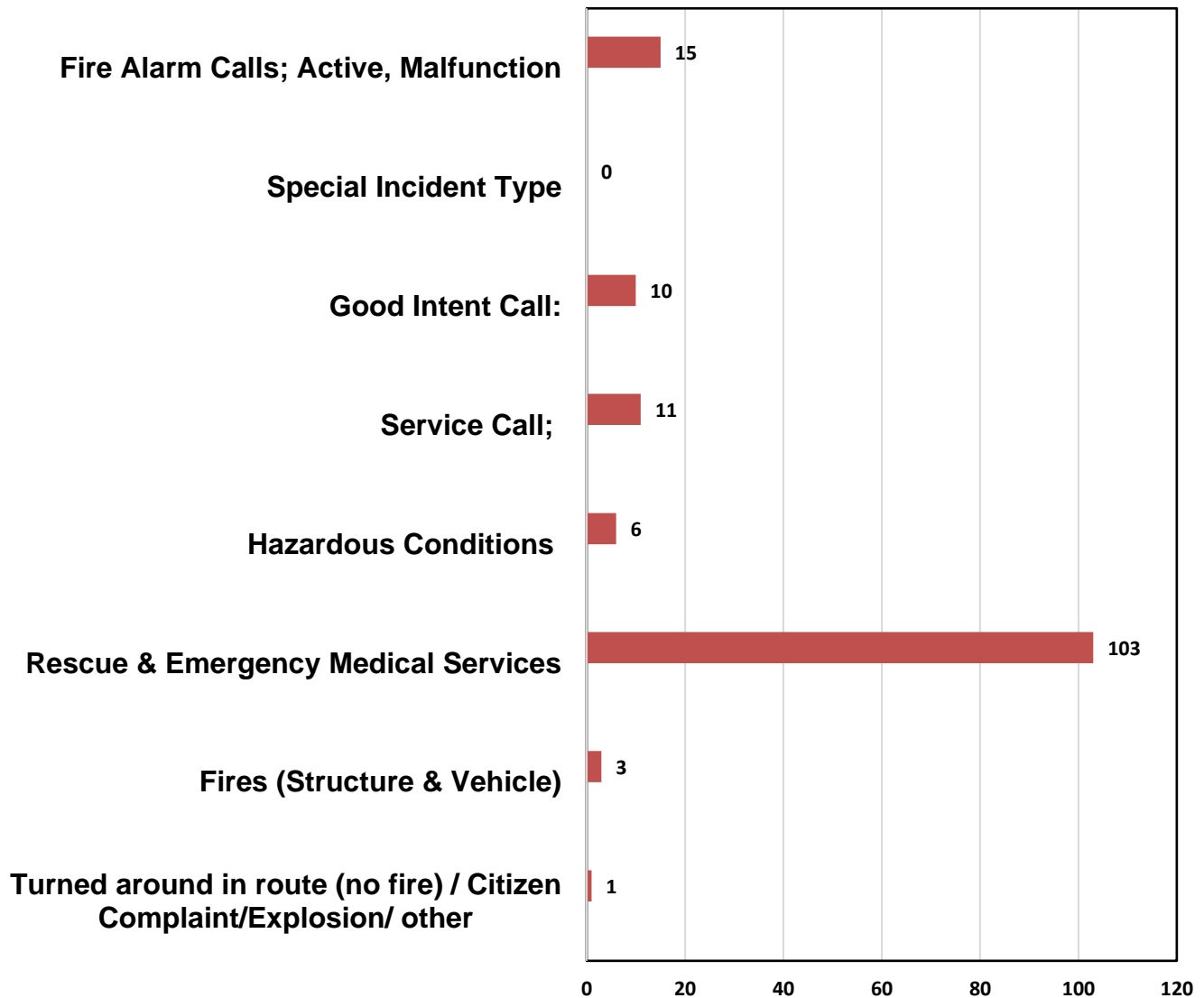

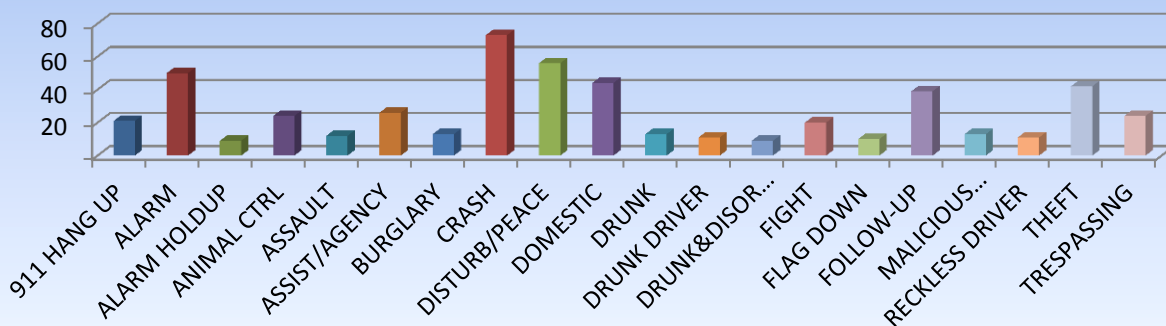

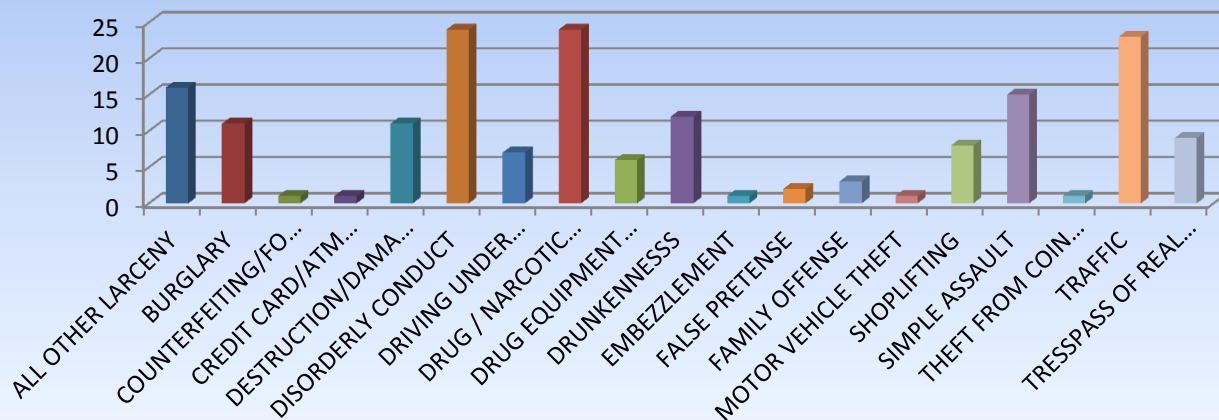

Last week in Community Development, the Development Review Committee approved the site plan for the proposed Dunkin Doughnuts Shop to be located on the west side of Cedar Lake Road, north of Taco Bell. Building construction plans have also been approved for the project and for the Sonic Restaurant to be located in the former Backyard Burger Building on Pass Road. Permits are expected to be issued this week. Permits were issued last week for five new single family houses, and building plans were submitted for three more.

This week the City Council will conduct a Public Hearing for the zoning change application for the proposed Belle La Vie Development to be located in the newly annexed area of Biloxi. The proposed Mixed Use Development will include a commercial center, a certified retirement community, and market rate single family homes and apartments.
