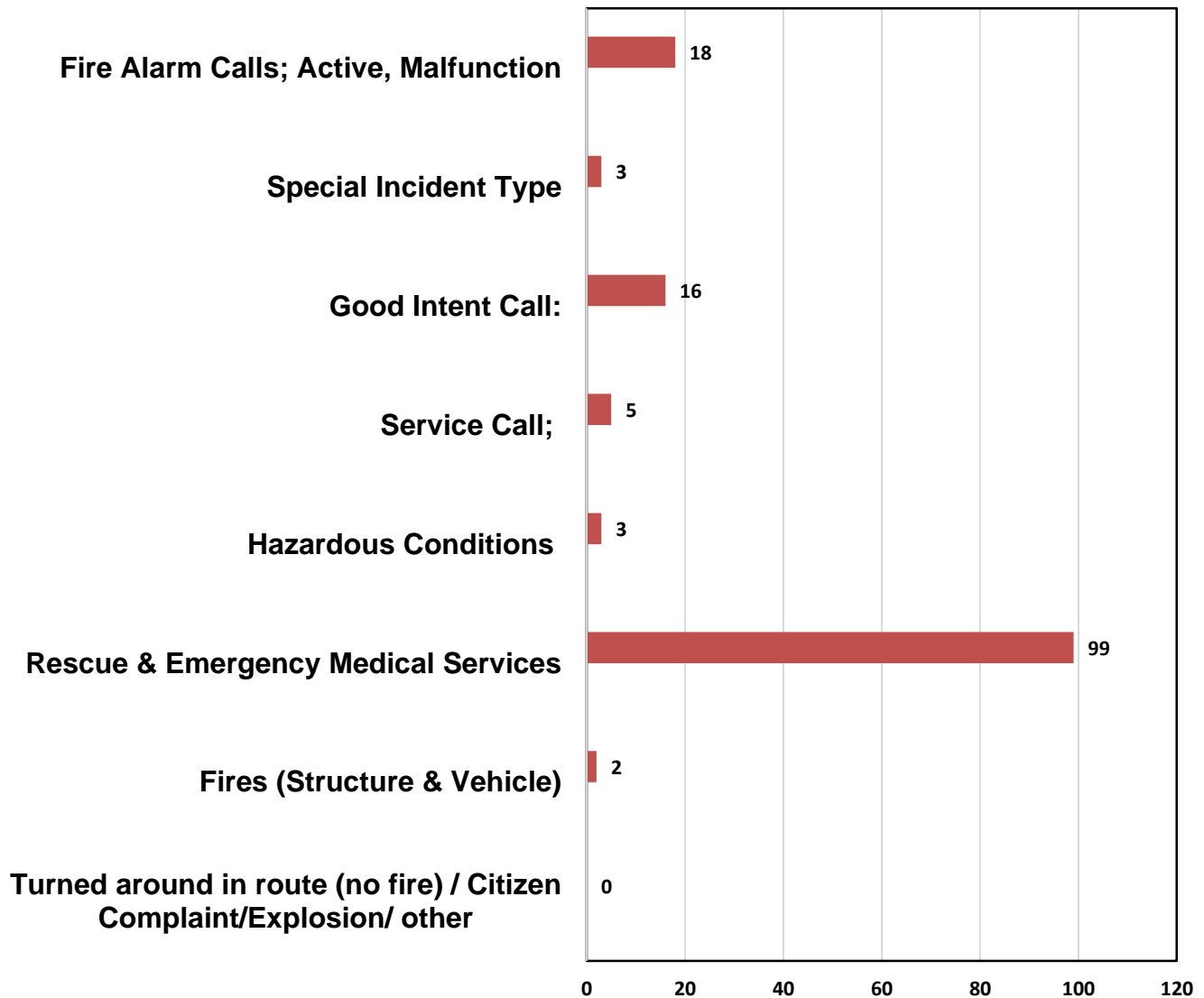

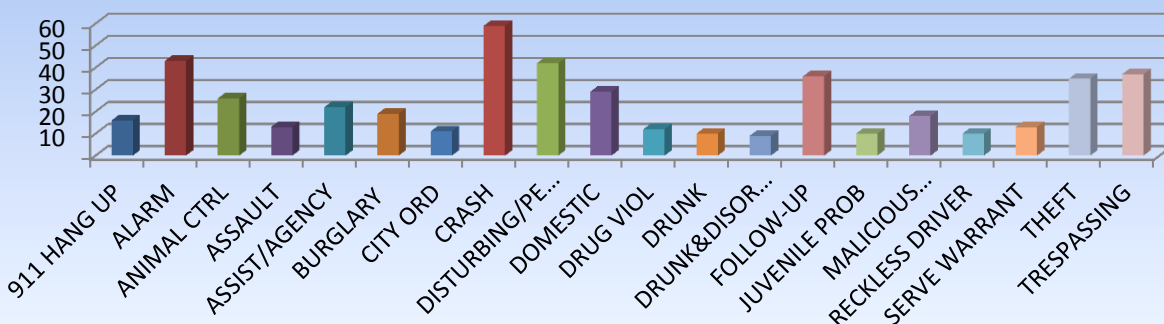

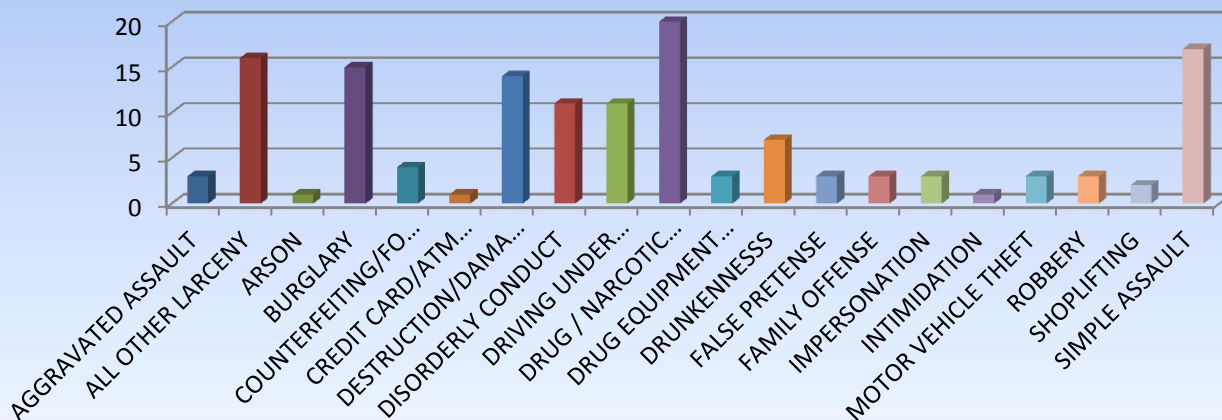

Last week in Community Development, building plans were submitted for the proposed Hilton Garden Inn to be located at the eastern corner of Beach Boulevard and Dukate Street, on the former Biloxi Specialty Hospital property. The proposed Hotel will be six stories in height, 72,000 sq. ft., and will have 100 rooms and a swimming pool.

Building plans were also submitted for the proposed Sunbelt Lighting Store to be located at the northeast corner of I-10 and Cedar Lake Road, just south of Love's Truck Stop. The \$1 million project will be 10,000 sq. ft. and will specialize in providing a vast inventory of light fixtures and related electrical products. Site work is expected to start this week.

This week, the City Council will conduct a first reading of the zoning change application for the proposed Belle La Vie project to be located in the newly annexed area north of Hidden Springs. The 626 acre site will be a mixed use community with a commercial center, and will include a certified retirement community, surrounded by market rate, multi-family and single-family homes.

Also this week, the proposed Salt Grass Restaurant, to be located at the eastern corner of Beach Boulevard and Myrtle Street, will be returning to the Development Review Committee on Wednesday and to the Architectural Historical Review Commission on Thursday to present revisions for approval. The proposed Waffle House Restaurant to be located on Beach Boulevard west of the Church of the Redeemer property also goes back to the AHRC this week.
