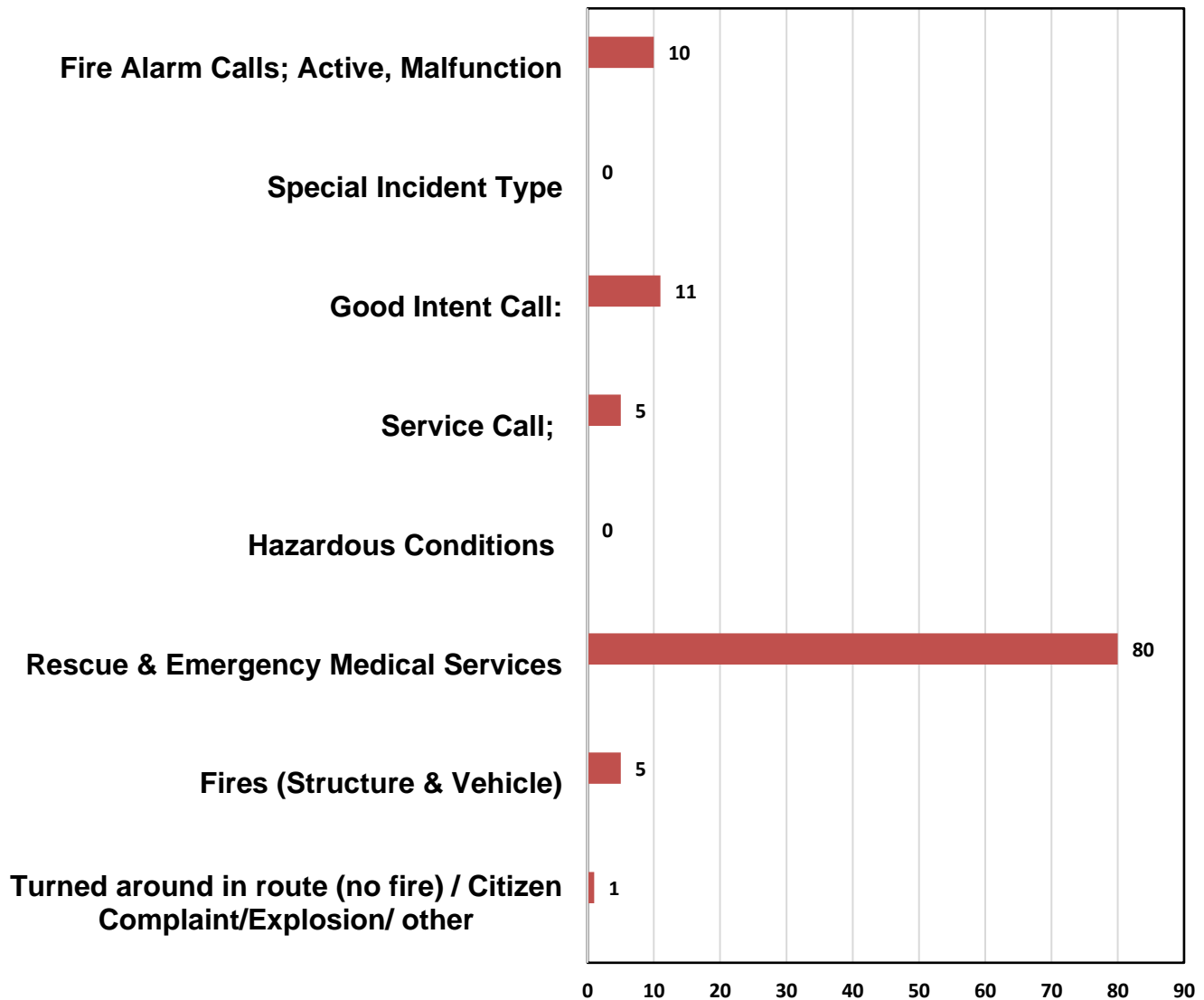

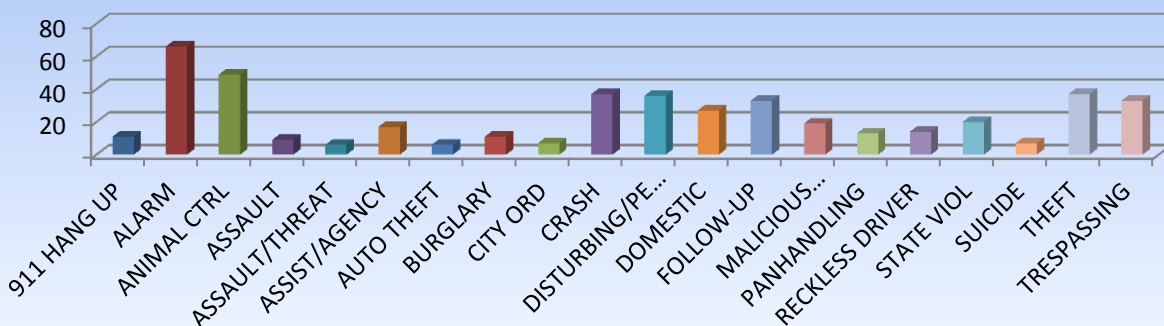

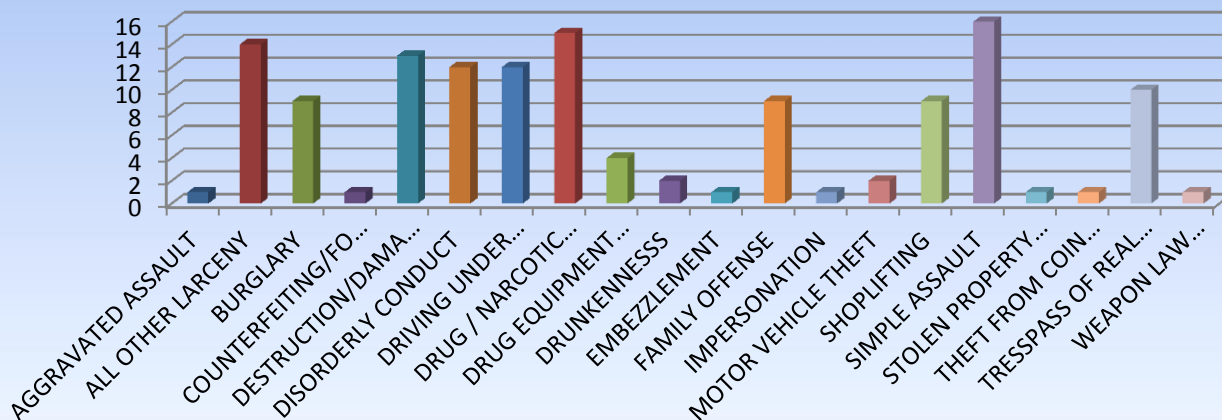

Last week in Community Development, the City Council voted to conduct a public hearing for a zoning change request for 626 acres in north Biloxi. The owners of the proposed Belle La Vie Master Plan Community have applied to change the zoning for the property, from A–Agricultural, to RB-Regional Business, RM-Residential Multi-Family, and RS- Residential Single Family zoning. The public hearing will be held in the council room at city hall on March 7 at 6 p.m.

Also last week, the Architectural/Historical Review Commission approved the Architectural design for the proposed Salt Grass Restaurant to be located at 140 Beach Boulevard. AHRC also approved the design for the proposed Waffle House to be located at 618 Beach Boulevard. Architects for both projects worked closely with city consulting architect Frank Genzer to incorporate historic features into their designs. Building construction plans can now be submitted for review, prior to permitting.

Final building inspections have been requested for the new Blind Tiger Restaurant located at 265 Beach Blvd. Owners are hoping to open within the next few days.
