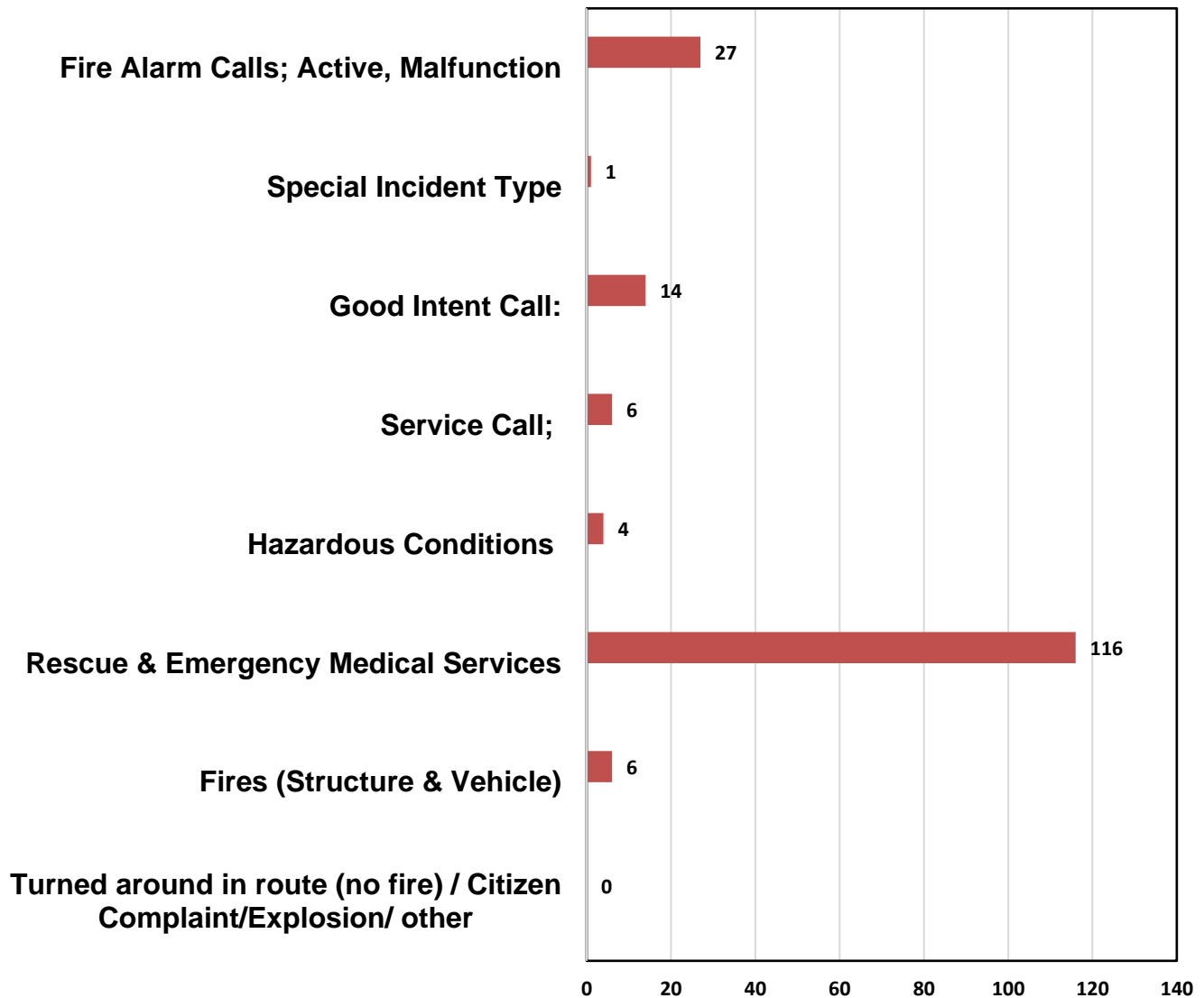

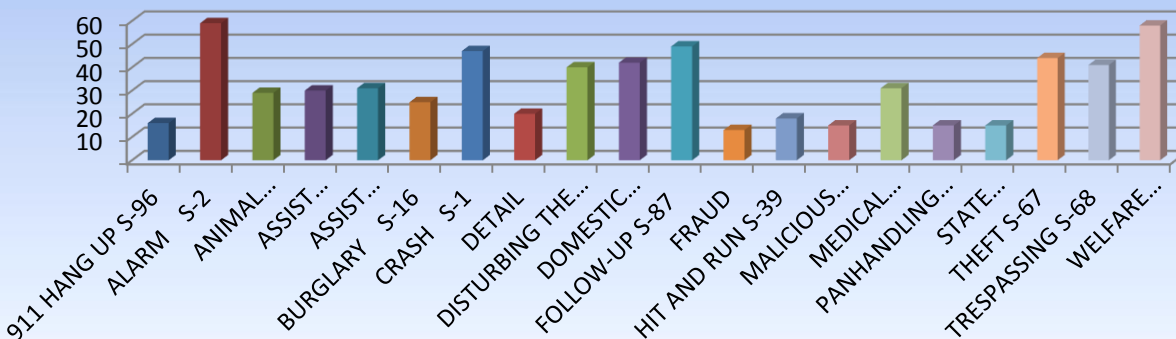

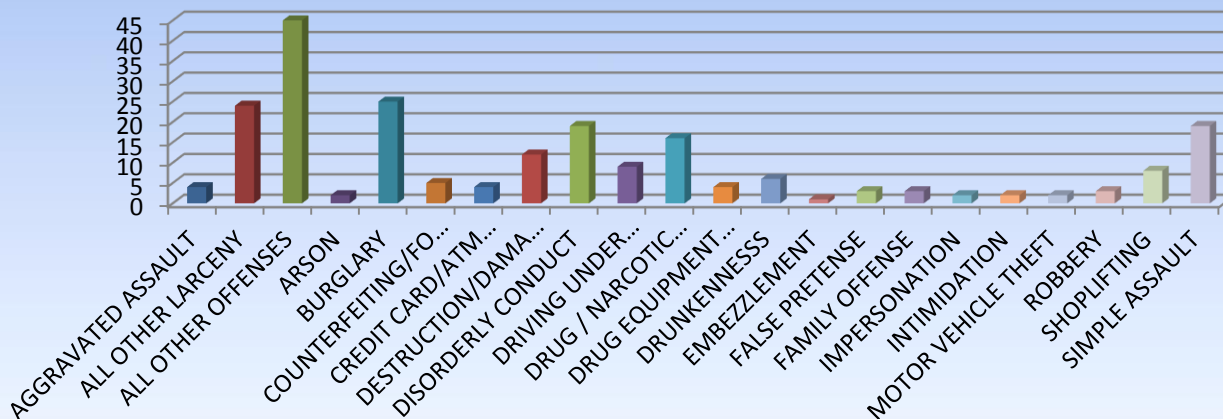

Community Development Activity Report, Aug. 29, 2016

Last week in Community Development, the Architectural/Historical Review Commission voted 6-3 to approve the exterior building design for the La Quinta Inn & Suites. The proposed hotel will be located at 950/956 Beach Blvd., and will have 66 units. The approved rendering incorporates many historic residential features into the design, including a gable and hip roof with arch dormers, corbelling, columns, and railings to create a balcony effect. Building construction plans will now be submitted for review and approval.

Also last week, the City Council approved an application for short-term rental, for the existing structure located at 1096 Beach Blvd.

The Building Department issued 54 building permits last week, with a construction valuation of \$202,700. Certificates of occupancy were issued for nine structures, and licenses were issued for three new businesses with 368 renewals. Construction plans were submitted for two new single family houses. Building inspectors performed 124 inspections, and code enforcement officers opened 168 cases, and resolved 139.
