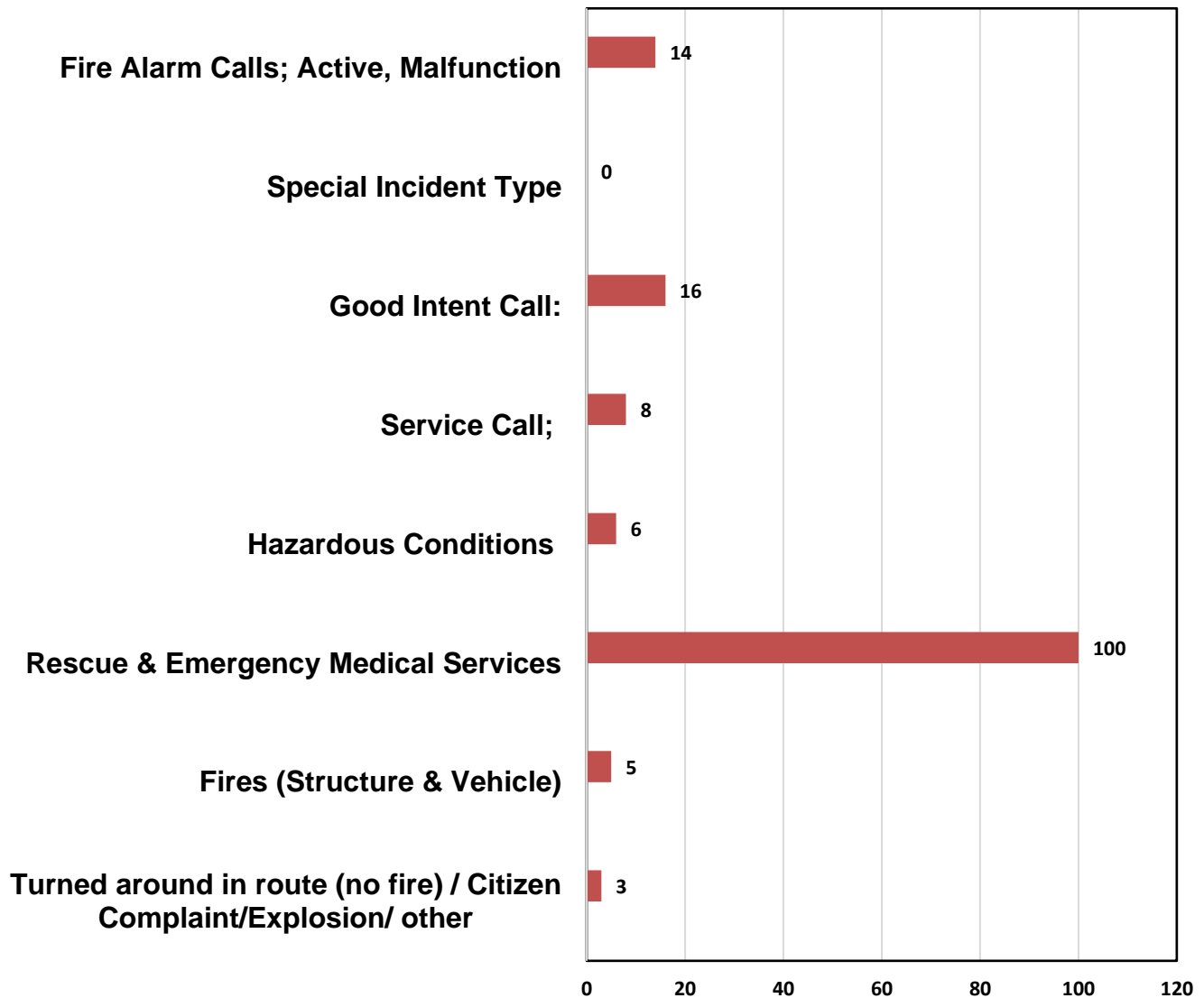

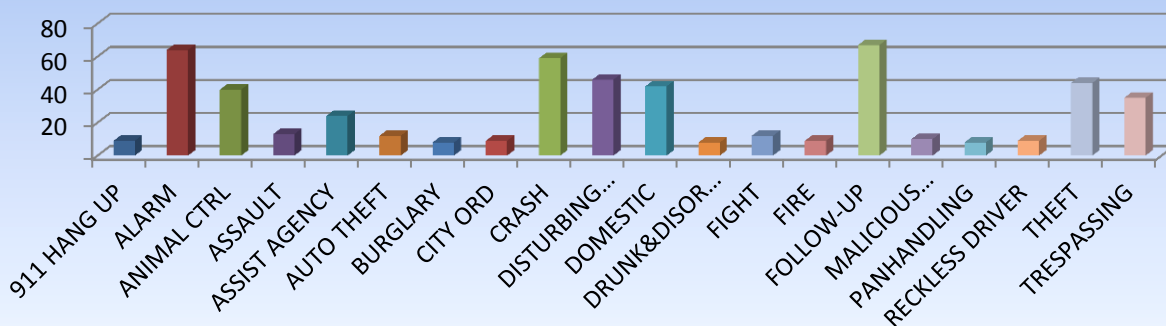

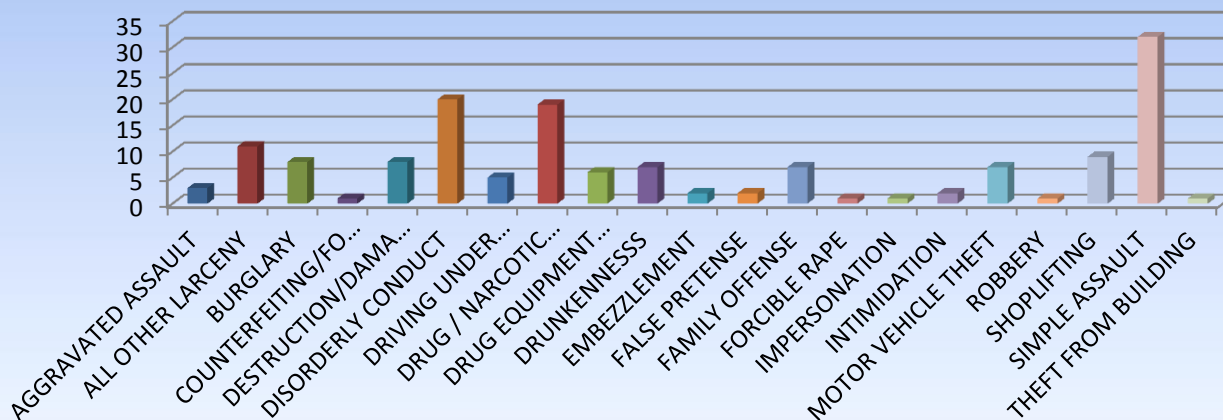

Last week in Community Development, the City Council approved new Waterfront Design Standards and Guidelines for future development projects to be located along the water's edge in Biloxi. The Council also voted to approve the overlay districts to be affected by the new standards. Under these guidelines, developers of new and improved projects will be encouraged to design their structures to capture the old and historic look of the Biloxi Seafood Industry.

Also last week, the Architectural and Historical Review Commission tabled an application for a new Waffle House Restaurant to be located at 618 Beach Boulevard. This action was necessary to allow the designers to meet with the City's Historic Administrator to implement AHRC features into the project.

This week the Development Review Committee is scheduled to review an application for a "Salt Grass Restaurant" on property located north of Beach Boulevard, across from the Golden Nugget Resort. The meeting will be held on Wednesday at 9 a.m.
