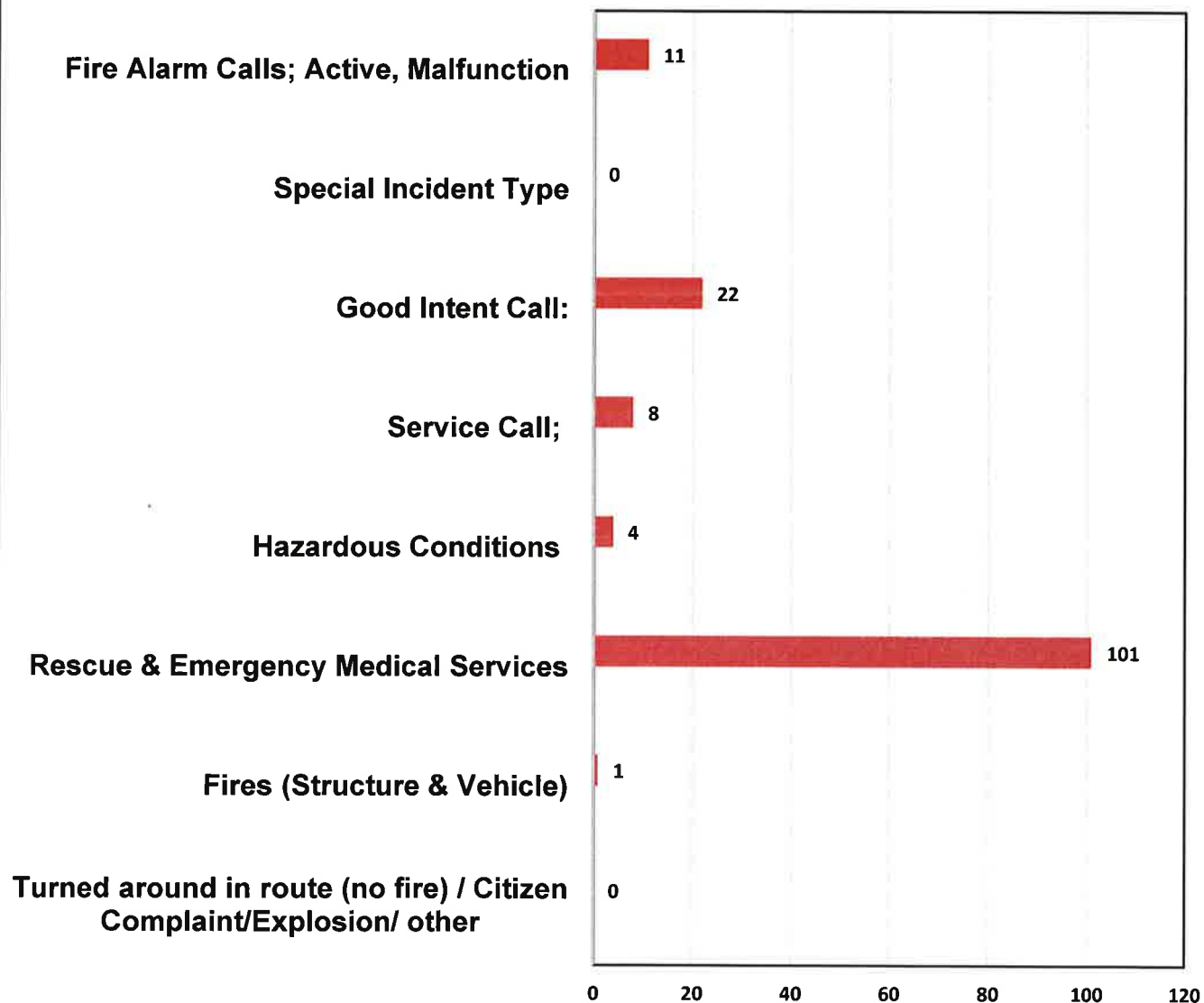

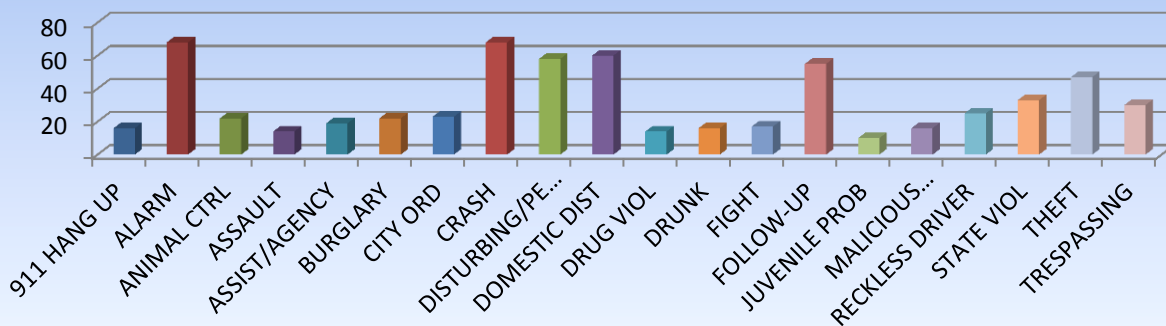

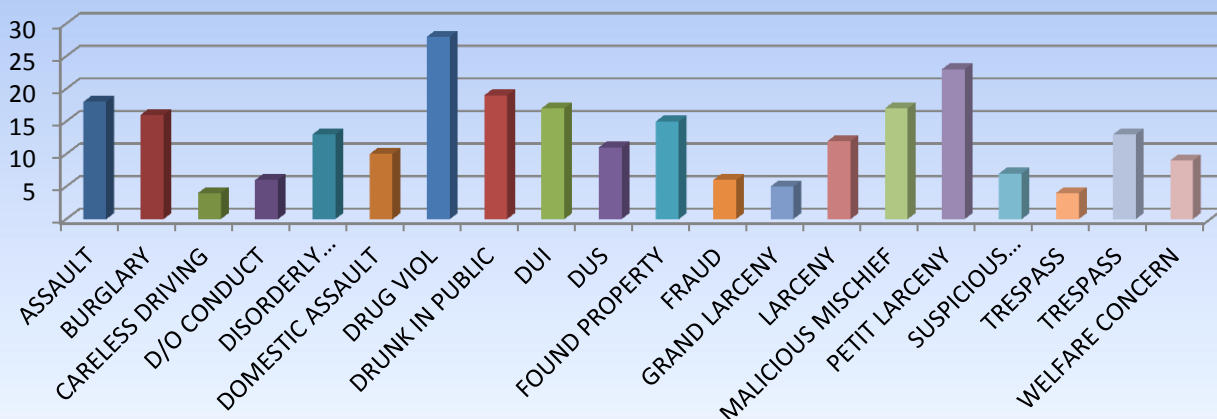

Community Development Update 5/31/2016

Last week in Community Development, certificates of occupancy were issued for the new Walmart Neighborhood Market and Fuel Station on Popp's Ferry Road. The new store is scheduled to open tomorrow, June 1, at 7:30 a.m. A certificate of occupancy was also issued for Wentzel's Seafood Restaurant on Beach Boulevard. The restaurant opened early last week.

Also last week, the Development Review Committee made minor design revision recommendations for the site plan for the Popp's Ferry Causeway Park. The design will be revised and resubmitted for final approval. This week, the DRC will review site plans for a major expansion of Campers World at I-10 and Oaklawn, and for a new Doughnut Shop on Shriner's Boulevard.

Final building plans were submitted for Big Play Family Fun Center for the bowling alley and arcade. The \$1 million dollar project will include 12 regulation lanes for bowling, an arcade and a café. Plans were also submitted for 3 new single family houses. For the week, 71 building permits, and 11 certificates of occupancy were issued. Business licenses were issued for 9 new businesses, with 1 change of ownership. Building Inspectors performed 136 inspections, and code officers opened 70 cases and resolved 150.
