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### PROJECT SUMMARY

### 10. Provide Brief Project Description/Overview:

Through this Tidelands grant project, the City of Biloxi will expand the Point Cadet Marina to meet market demand for more slips to accommodate 75-foot and larger recreational and sports-fishing yachts owned by Mississippi Coast residents and Intercoastal Waterway visiting boaters. The project also involves expanding public access to the waterfront through provision of a water's edge boardwalk, which will include open-air pavilions, lighting, educational signage and a docking area to support the State's shuttle service to Deer Island.

The marina expansion and public access boardwalk project area will begin at the current western boundary of the Point Cadet Marina and extend to a point approximately 500 feet west of the new Margaritaville (formerly Casino Magic).

Design of this project will be consistent with the other public improvements that form Biloxi's chain of waterfront amenities, preserving authentic Biloxi styles, standards and materials. Ultimately, the waterfront boardwalk will extend west to DeBuys Road, connecting Point Cadet with the Schooner Pier Complex, Tricentennial Park, the Biloxi Small Craft Harbor, Lighthouse Park, West Biloxi Festival Boardwalk Area and the Sand Beach to the City Limits.

#### 11. LIST Project Goals/Objectives:

The project goals are:

- to expand safe public access to the Point Cadet waterfront along the area directly north of Deer Island
- to diversify affordable, family-friendly recreational opportunities and activities along the Mississippi Gulf Coast

Objectives to achieve these goals are:

- to expand the existing marina to meet the demand for additional large boat slips;
- to provide an ADA-compliant boardwalk with public amenities that support festivals, regattas, land-side fishing and enjoying the view:
- to offer land-side improvements for the State's marine shuttle to Deer Island; and
- to enhance educational opportunities through signage and native plant ladnscaping.

### 12. LIST Project Benefits:

Project benefits include:

- providing safe public access to a tidally-influenced area due north of Deer Island;
- expanding recreational and educational opportunities for residents and millions of visitors;-
- improving boater safety;
- enhancing and conserving a tidelands affected area;
- providing parking, ADA-compliant access and other amenities to support the State's marine shuttle service to Deer Island;
- improving public understanding of the need for long-term stewardship of the Mississippi Gulf Coast's natural resources through low-profile educational signage located along the boardwalk;
- promoting efficient use of state and local resources through expansion of an existing public marina to reduce construction and operational costs and to maximize public use of limited waterfront.

### APPLICATION SUMMARY

This project will expand public access to the Point Cadet waterfront area due north of Deer Island through expansion of the Point Cadet Marina and construction of an ADA-compliant boardwalk with amenities. The marina expansion will provide new slips to meet market demand to accommodate 75-foot and larger recreational and sports-fishing yachts owned by Mississippi Coast residents and Intercoastal Waterway visiting boaters. A public boardwalk, which will include open-air pavilions, lighting, educational signage, landscaping and a northern docking area to support the State's marine shuttle service to Deer Island, will be constructed to support public enjoyment of the waterfront and to expand family-oriented recreational activities.

The marina expansion and public access boardwalk project area will begin at the current western boundary of the Point Cadet Marina and extend to a point approximately 500 feet west of Margaritaville at the former Casino Magic site. Ultimately, the water's edge boardwalk will extend west, all the way to the City Limits at DeBuys Road, to provide pedestrian connectivity along Biloxi's chain of waterfront amenities that includes the Schooner Pier Complex, Tricentennial Park with the Ohr-O'Keefe Museum of Art, the Biloxi Small Craft Harbor, Lighthouse Park and the West Biloxi Festival Boardwalk Area.

The primary benefit of project implementation will be expanded public access to the waterfront for residents of the Mississippi Gulf Coast and the millions of annual visitors to Biloxi. The project area is unique in that it affords unobstructed views of Deer Island, it offers direct access to the East and Lateral Channels for recreational boaters and it is conveniently accessed from Highway 90. Other project benefits include diversifying affordable, family-friendly activities in East Biloxi; providing land-side marine shuttle improvements for public access to Deer Island; and maximizing public enjoyment of Biloxi's waterfront through amenities that support fishing tournaments, concerts, festivals, natural resource education and viewing.

Development of final project design will be coordinated with the Mississippi Department of Marine Resources and the Mississippi Secretary of State's Office and to most effectively and efficiently provide safe public access to this Point Cadet waterfront area and to maximize public benefit through appropriate waterfront uses that support a broad range of affordable, family-oriented recreational and educational activities. Design of this project will be consistent with the other public improvements that form the chain of waterfront amenities, preserving authentic Biloxi styles, standards and materials.

The project complies with the requirements of the Public Trust Tidelands Act for tidelands management programs that conserve, reclaim or preserve public trust tidelands, enhance public access to public trust tidelands and provide public improvements as they relate to those lands.
