General Forecast:

TD9 is moving north at 2 mph and is forecast to become a Tropical Storm before turning more northeasterly today.

Possible Local Impacts:

Winds and seas will rise as the depression makes its closest approach tonight. Tidal rises around 2 feet above normal are expected with higher tides possible depending on the track and strength of the depression.
