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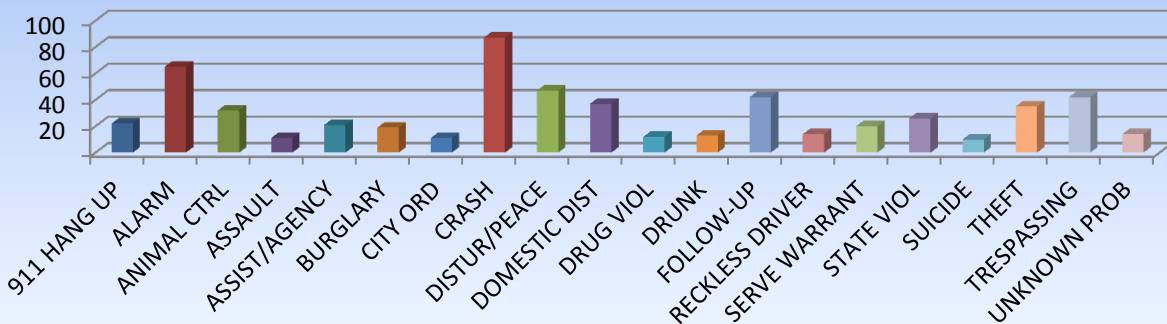

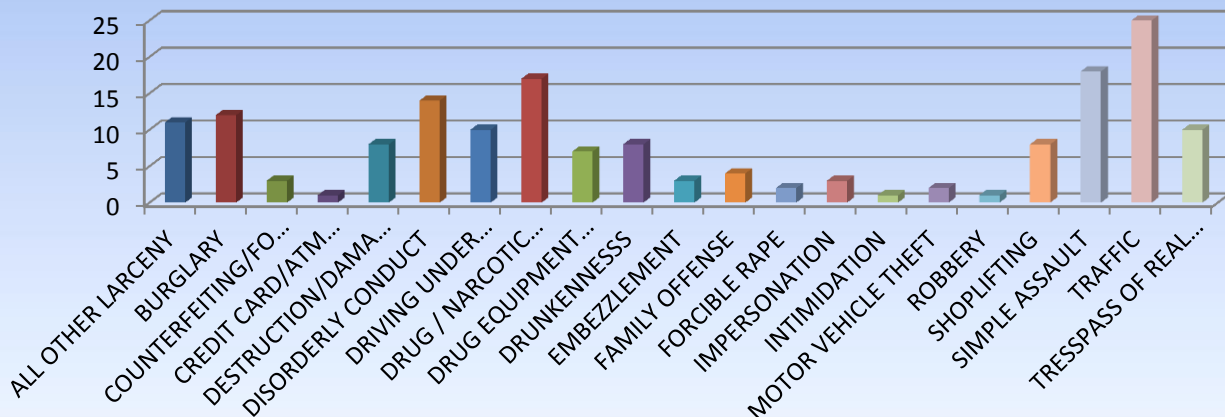

Community Development Activity Report Aug. 15, 2016

Last week in Community Development, building plans were submitted for the proposed Marshall's Funeral Home to be located at 234 Veterans Avenue. The new structure will be located south of the new crematorium that was completed last year. Plans were also received for the foundation for the Blind Tiger Restaurant. Construction of the restaurant is scheduled to begin as soon as the building plans are approved.

There were 68 building permits issued last week, with a construction valuation of \$680,000. Certificates of occupancy were issued for 9 structures and business licenses were issued for 2 new businesses. Building inspectors performed 84 inspections, and code enforcement officers opened 124 cases and resolved 132.

This week, the Planning Commission will consider an application for a zoning change, from LB-Limited Business, to NB-Neighborhood Business, for properties located at 2432 and 2436 Pass Road. The zoning change is necessary to accommodate potential retail tenants. The DRC will consider an application, and site plan, this week for a construction lay down yard for the Hidden Springs Pitcher-Point Development located in Woolmarket.
