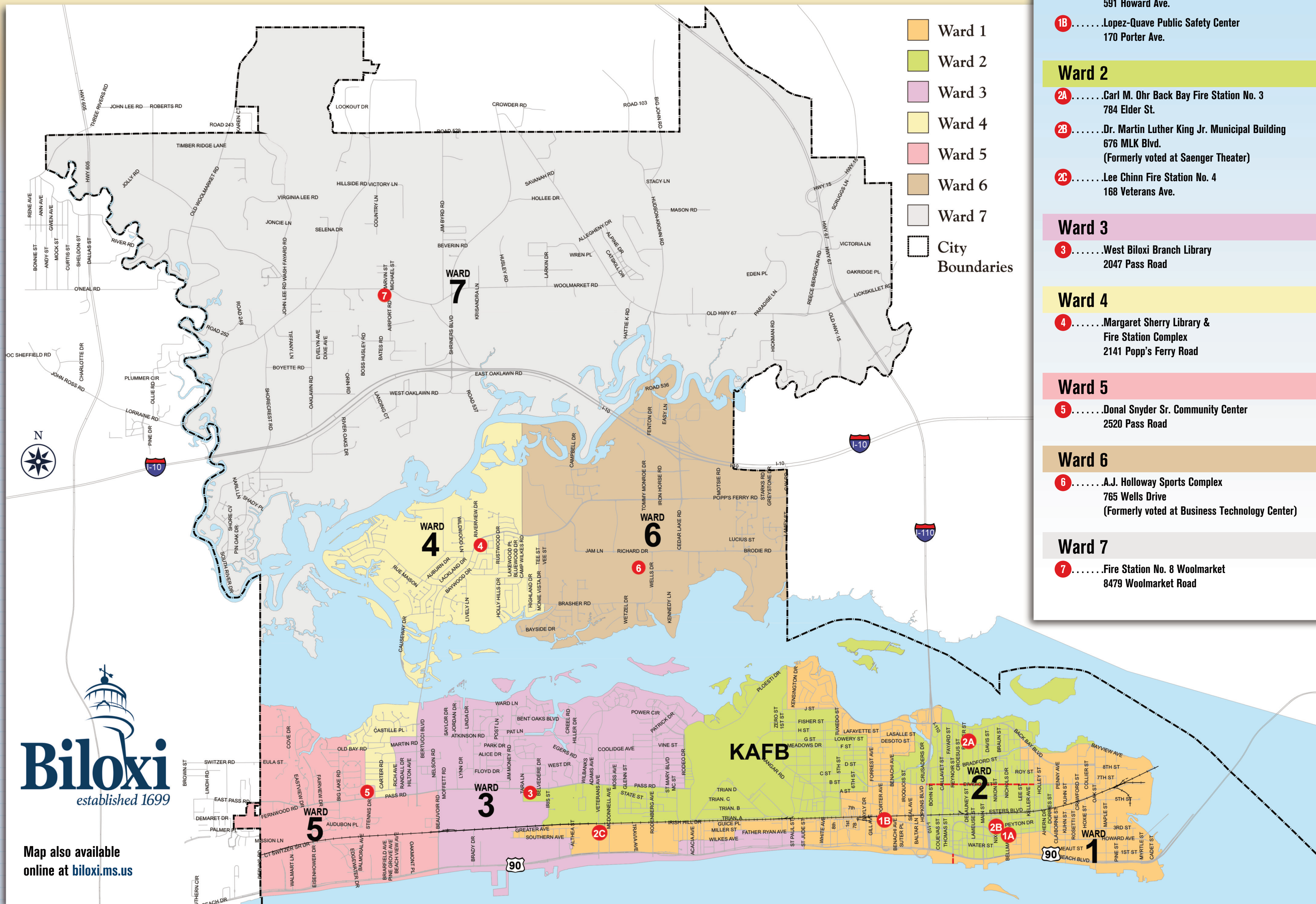

- **Saturday, May 6 and May 13, 8 a.m. to noon** – Municipal Clerk’s Office at Biloxi City Hall will be open for in-person absentee voting for Primary Election Runoff, if necessary.
- **Tuesday, May 16** – Run-off election, if necessary. Polls open 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.
- **Saturday, May 27 – 8 a.m. to noon** - Municipal Clerk’s Office at Biloxi City Hall will be open for in-person absentee voting for General Election.
- **Saturday, June 3 - 8 a.m. to noon** – Deadline to vote in person at Biloxi City Hall by absentee ballot for General Election. (Absentee ballots by mail must be received by Municipal Clerk by 5 p.m. on June 5.)
- **Tuesday, June 6** – General Election. Polls open from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

Do you have a voter card? New voter cards are being sent to residents of Ward 2B and Ward 6 since they will be voting at a new polling place this year. Voter cards are not mandatory, but they are handy guides to remind you of your polling place for local, state and federal elections. If you don't have a voter card and would like one, visit the Circuit Clerk's office at the Harrison County Courthouse in Biloxi or Gulfport, Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.
