Navy Band Southeast's **Ceremonial Band** is the traditional "military band" unit of the Southeast region. As the musical representative of Commander, Navy Region Southeast, the ensemble performs at official military ceremonies and special events. Drawing from a repertoire of traditional marches, fanfares, and patriotic favorites, this unit performs for change-of-command ceremonies, retirements, commissioning and decommissioning of naval vessels, and formal affairs. The Ceremonial Band also provides patriotic music for community festivals, dedications, opening ceremonies, and parades throughout the southeast

Established in 1995, Navy Band Southeast is one of 11 official U.S. Navy Bands. Proudly representing the Commander, Navy Region Southeast, the band consists of thoroughly trained professional musicians dedicated to the highest levels of musical performance. Excelling in versatility, the band or any of its various units are perfect for a wide variety of musical settings including military ceremonies, public concerts, parades and much more. Inspiring pride and patriotism through music, this incredibly popular band performs more than 350 engagements annually throughout the Southeastern United States.

Staging Requirements

- 25 feet wide x 20 feet deep performance area.
- 20 rust-free, armless chairs.
