Annual Biloxi Twelfth Night ... Jan. 5 – Begins 5 p.m., Biloxi Visitors Center, 1050 Beach Blvd. The Gulf Coast will officially change from the holiday season to Carnival season with the celebration of Twelfth Night beginning at the Biloxi Visitors Center and parading to the Mardi Gras Museum. Twelfth Night, the 12th day from Christmas, is the night before the Epiphany, the day when the three wise men visited the infant Jesus, foretelling the revelation of God the Son being born as a human.

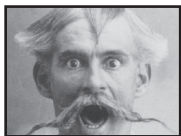
