Dear Spring Break Promoters and Organizers,

Our firm represents the City of Biloxi, and the Community Development Department of Biloxi. It has come to our attention via your website and the Visit Mississippi Gulf Coast website that during Spring Break there will be multiple areas where food and retail vendors will be located. Per your website, these areas are called "Vendor Row," "Pop-Up Shops" and/or the "Park-N-Play" lots located at 2506 Beach Blvd and 2450 Beach Blvd, Biloxi. The City of Biloxi requires these vendors to have a Temporary Permit.

According to Biloxi Code of Ordinances Section 23-4-5, a Temporary Permit is required for a Special Event (an event drawing more than 100 persons) and Outdoor Seasonal Sales, both of which apply to Vendor Row, Pop-Up Shops and/or the Park-N-Play lots. The purpose, applicability and procedures for a Biloxi Temporary Permit are listed in Biloxi Code of Ordinances Section 23-2-3(J). Attached is a sample of the Biloxi

Temporary Permit required for Spring Break Vendors which each of your vendors is required to obtain is attached for your convenience.

It is imperative that you inform the vendors currently approved by Mississippi Gulf Coast Spring Break for a vendor space on Vendor Row, Pop-Up Shops and/or the Park-N-Play lots that they must apply for and be approved by Biloxi Community Development for a Temporary Permit. Biloxi Community Development is located at 676 Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard, Biloxi, Mississippi.


Once approved, the Permit must be visibly displayed on the tent/booth during the full three days of the event. Biloxi must ensure these vendors comply with the standards, rules and regulations established for the City of Biloxi. The Temporary Permit Fee is \$25. Once the event begins, no additional licenses will be issued. Therefore, Biloxi Community Development Department will stop issuing Temporary Permits by 2:00 pm on Friday, April 13, 2018.

Please review and send a copy to all vendors which you anticipate to participate in Mississippi Gulf Coast Spring Break Vendor Row and/or the Park-N-Play lots located on Beach Boulevard. We would appreciate your cooperation in this matter.
