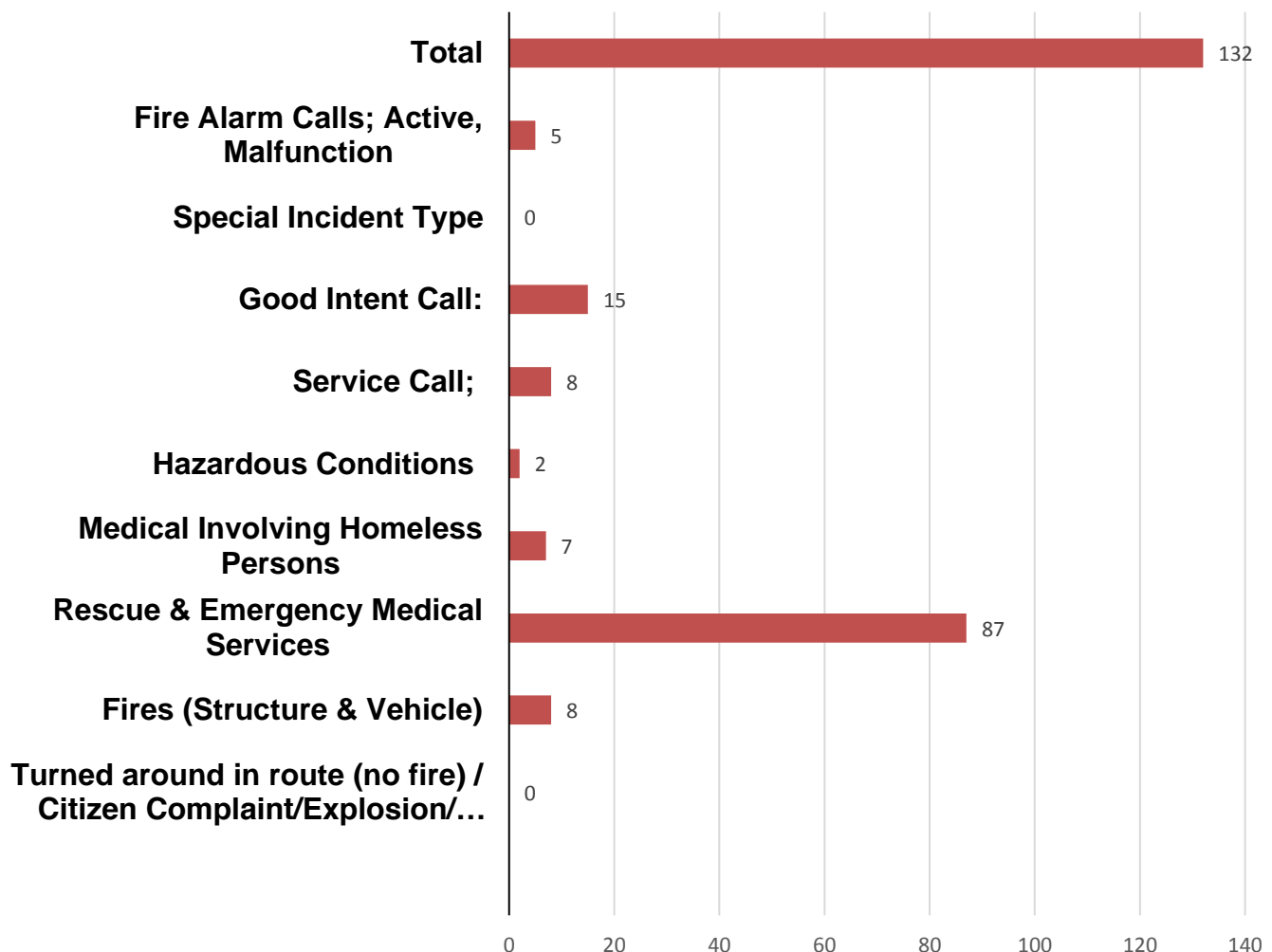

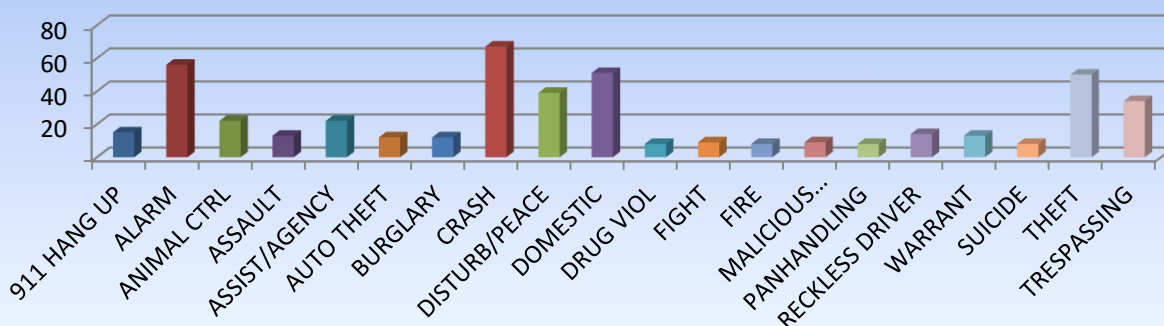

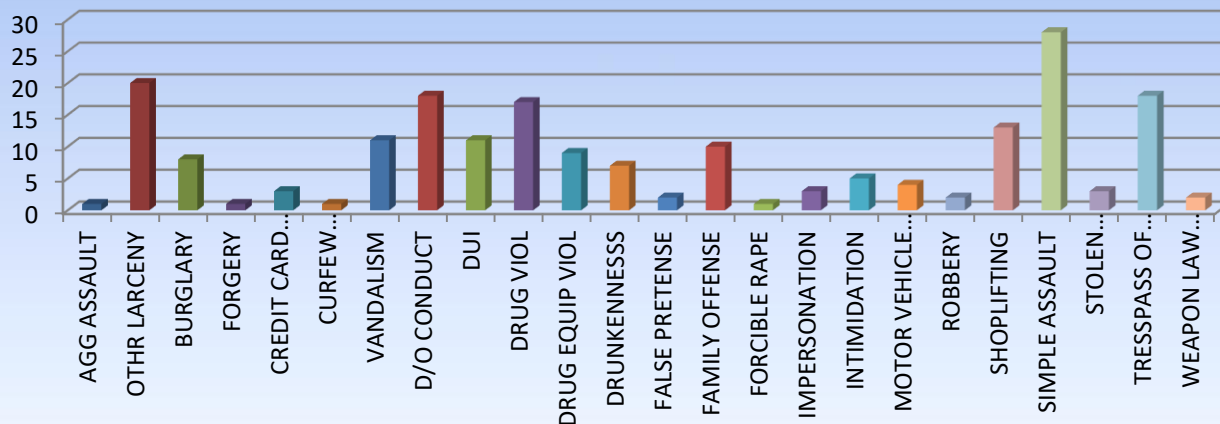

- Back Bay Blvd. Extension (Pine St. Ext.)

#### Hurricane Nate

- **Lighthouse Pier Repairs opened bids on April 4<sup>th</sup> - bids under review**
- **Ice Wharf, Coliseum and Oak St. Pier Repairs opened bids on April 4<sup>th</sup> - bids under review**

#### Projects

- Amtrak rail platform grant – Continuing assisting Southern Rail Commission with grant application
- Bayview Avenue Boardwalk – Waiting for cost estimate from Power Co to make a decision on how to address electrical.
- Belle La Vie Parkway – Survey completed for Increment 1; Garner Russell & Associates working on surveying of Increment 2A, 2B & Technology Center
- Canaan Fishing Dock Improvements – Wetlands mitigation contract amendment approved by council
- CSX Crossing Closure (MDOT Funded) – Received MDOT MOU, moving forward with MDOT review of NS contract

- CSX Crossing Closure (CDBG Funded) – Have applied for the permit to survey on CSX ROW
- Dredging – Finished Canaan, Point Cadet finished, working on Hiller Park; Hiller expected to be complete within 3 weeks, moving to Mercedes should take 2.5 weeks; then to North Haven; should have Oak St. Pier Debris removal within 2 weeks
- East Biloxi Public Access & Living Shoreline – Task D (South of Bridge to Small Craft) and Task E (North of Bridge to Palace) working on environmental permitting
- East Biloxi Boardwalk (Small Craft to Kuhn St.) – BMA performing structural analysis
- Ellzey Place II – Lane Construction expected to be completed end of April or early May
- Ellzey Place III – had 30% review meeting with Rumsey Engineering working on utility conflicts at Senior Center
- Fire Station No. 7 – Met with design team, contractor, and SMPDD to value engineer the project, made significant cuts to the project but still more are needed to reach project budget
- Fire Station No. 10 – 90% complete, Williams finalizing offsite utility work
- **Howard Avenue** – NTP date April 9, 2018; Completion Date October 6, 2018; ground breaking April 9, 2018 @ 11:00
- **Lighthouse Parking Lot** - Should be striping today
- Jordan Subdivision (Old Hwy 67) – Utility installation complete; installing roll over curb
- Keesler Gate Outside – Parcel acquisition underway
- **Keesler Gate Inside** – Received bids, apparent low bidder is Necaise Brothers Construction at \$4,806,328.48; bids being reviewed by legal counsel
- **Keesler Privatization** – Received 3<sup>rd</sup> round of inquiries, mainly regarding costs working on a response; expect final decision Oct – Dec 2018
- Popp's Ferry Extension – preparing maps & deeds for property acquisition; talking to Coliseum about contributing funds for project

- Pedestrian Crosswalk @ MGM – Installation of test pile underway
- Pedestrian Crosswalk @ Harbor – Had status update meeting Tuesday March 27<sup>th</sup> 10 am with Dale Partners, project proceeding on with design
- Public Safety Center & Donal Snyder Center Roof Leaks – Dale Partners doing assessment of buildings
- Popp's Ferry Bridge Submarine Cable – Additional funding was approved, waiting for MDOT approval to award the project
- Popp's Ferry Bridge & Approaches – pending EA approval
- Popp's Ferry Causeway – Construction continuing, current completion date
- Post Office Build-out – Finalizing HVAC, should receive plan by mid march then project will be ready to bid
- Rock Creek Subdivision Phase III – contractor finishing punchlist, working toward final plat approval; contractor working on re-grading some of the properties along Sage Road to drain toward street instead of toward existing homes in rear, met with residents to look at drainage issue
- Saenger Theater – Exterior repair design underway
- Smith Subdivision (north corner of Woolmarket Rd. & Old Hwy 67) – Saunders Const. has done clearing & grubbing but no other work; no start date at this time
- West Biloxi Boardwalk - Project under construction – ground level signage and overhead signage
- Woolmarket Master Plan – Met with NS/GR Thursday March 22<sup>nd</sup> 2 pm to set priority ranking criteria
- Woolmarket Rd. East Drainage – met with Corps of Engineers and DMR; going to have to minimize impact to wetlands
- **Woolmarket Rd. East (Larkin) water line** – Pre-con meeting scheduled April 10<sup>th</sup>.
