RE: Biloxi Spring Break 2019 Initial After-Action Brief for April 11-14 Event Period

The information reflected accounted for activities of officers assigned to the Spring Break detail, only, and consisted of event related calls for service, incidents, and arrests. The actual level of activity may be subject to change based on the availability of information and the fact event related calls for service, incidents, and arrests, encountered by officers not assigned to the event detail may have also been event related but not counted. Other Significant Incidents:

- Calls for service, there were 582 calls for service initiated by event detail officers, which accounted for 24% of all calls for service generated during the week.
- Incidents, there were 182 incident reports initiated by event detail officers that accounted for 233 offense types, which accounted for 43% of all case numbers generated during the week. Officers encountered firearms during no-less-than seventeen incidents and recovered two firearms during the course of enforcement actions.
- Arrests, there were 71 arrests that accounted for 104 charges. Arrests initiated by event detail officers accounted for 38% of all arrests generated during the week.
- Officers issued 209 traffic citations.
- Officers encountered firearms during 17 event related incidents and recovered two.
- Officers recovered a three stolen vehicles.
- A police officer sustained minor injuries when they were intentionally struck by a vehicle driven by a subject evading arrest.
- During the event period, crowds were estimated to be approximately 30,000 people. Pedestrian estimations likely did not include persons in vehicles or on private properties.
- Officers responded to a high number of motor vehicle crashes during the event period, 58 crash were investigated, city-wide during the weekend.
