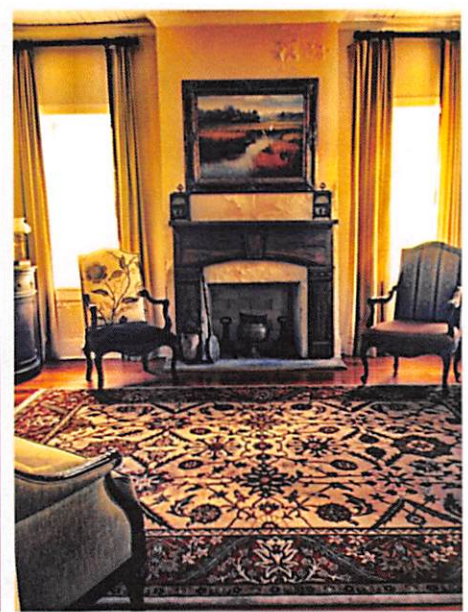


The Old Brick House

622 Bayview Ave, Biloxi, MS 39530

The Old Brick House, also known as *Biloxi Garden Center*, was built around 1850 as a modest family home by John Henley, a former sheriff and mayor of Biloxi. The home was added to the National Register of Historic Places in 1973, and was designated a Mississippi Landmark in 1987. Although heavily damaged by Hurricane Katrina in 2005, the house was restored and re-dedicated in 2011 and available for private events up to 99 guests.

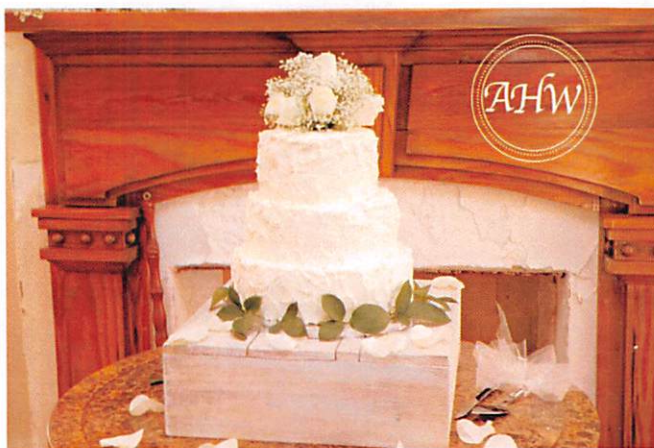

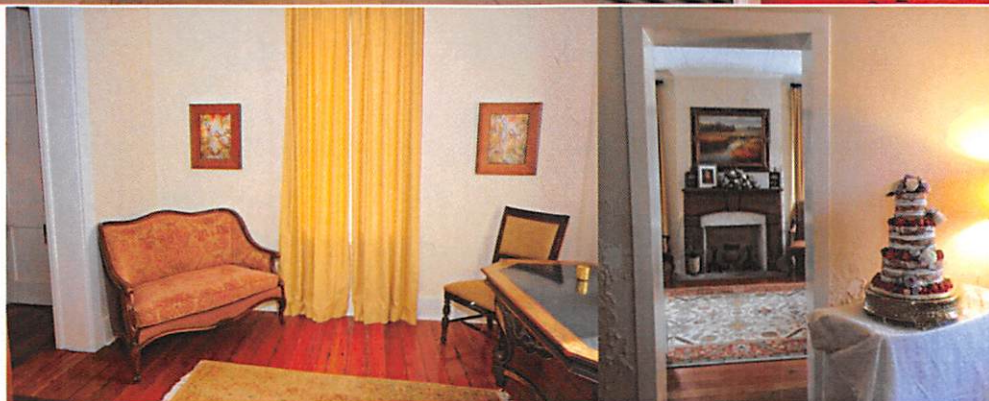

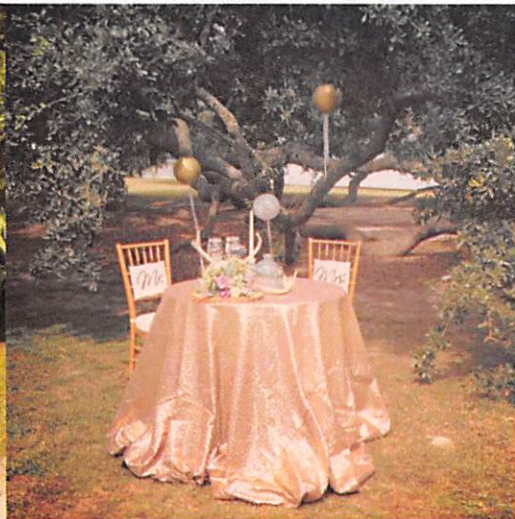

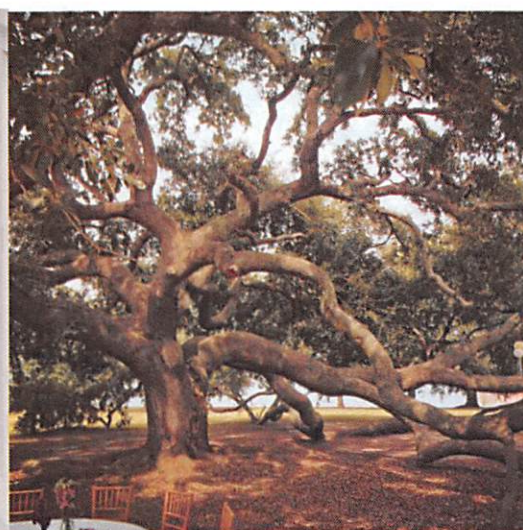
