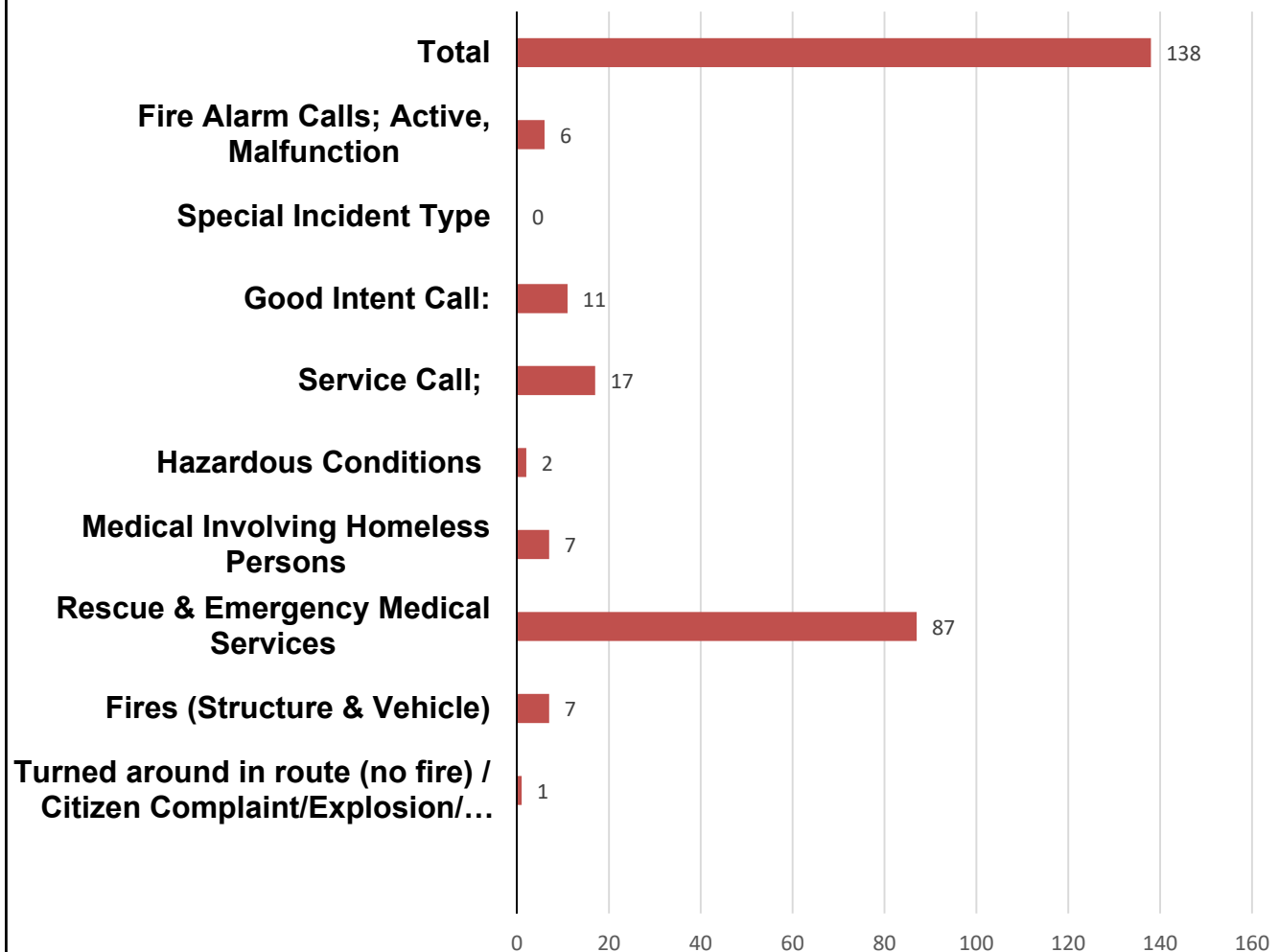

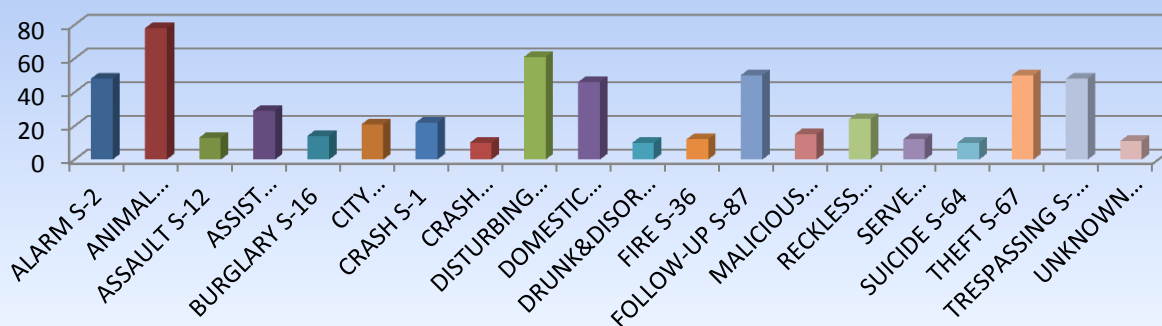

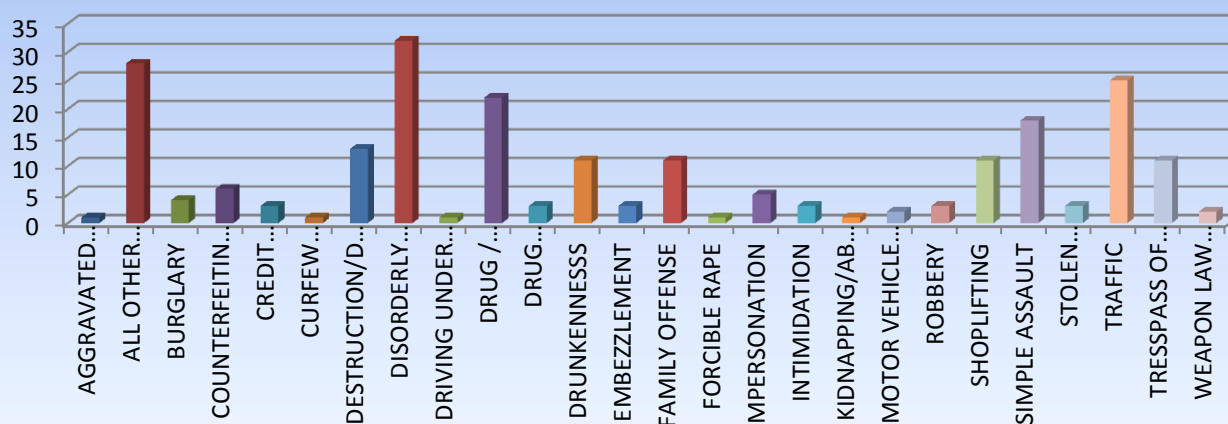

### **Cspire Fiber Install**

- All boring is complete, pulling fiber now and working on repairs.

- **Requested Cspire complete/repair pull box at Porter & Judge Sekul this week**

### **Centerpoint Repairs**

- Jackson Street - Main to GE Ohr – holes to remain open to make taps, pressure testing complete, holes will be repaired once taps are made
- Jackson Street – Reynoir to Caillavet – bores complete; will be doing these bores after the clean up on Main to Ohr.
- Will now be installing 45 services

- Atkinson Road – Met with GRPC, they agreed to fund the traffic study funding won't be available until October 2019; GRPC issues a call for Studies, submitted application for this project
- **Bayview Avenue Boardwalk** – Permits are approved; funding is now available; requesting a draft contract from Seymour Engineering
- Bayview Ave. Bridge Replacement (State-Aid Project) – Bridge construction complete; need to get waterline reattached and turned back on and asphalt at approaches
- **Belle La Vie Parkway** – wetlands permit application has been submitted; *received bids September 18, 2019; bids over budget; reviewing bid packages pending decision by Administration on how to address about budget issues*
- Building Façade Program (CDBG) – program has been advertised; work is pending applications
- Canaan Fishing Dock Improvements – received DMR & Corps permits, ready to move forward with design contract when funding is available
- Canaan Fishing Dock Repairs – Contract for plans/specs was approved by City Council.
- Cedar Lake Bridge Repairs (Const. Funding 2021) – Have executed MOA; met with DE to request an updated contract; and then met again on site for them to review the current condition of bridge; waiting on a design contract
- Circle Park Upgrades – working up preliminary site plan for approval; should be videoing the pipe this week
- Citywide Street Paving
  - Jim Byrd Road – *county to perform this work*

- Mason Road – county to assist (Res. 456-49)
- Snug Harbor – requested by Councilman Barrett
- **Crowder Drainage** – on the list for the Repair/Replace Contract which opens bids on June 12<sup>th</sup> , *responded to Public Records Request, they have reviewed our project files and asked for copies which have been provided to them*
- **CSX Crossing Closure (CDBG Funded)** – *received application for inspection fees from CSX, once that is approved by council we will have clearance from CSX to work; only have one relocation remaining and then construction can begin*
- CSX Crossing Closure Delauney & Nixon – Received the crossing agreement from CSX, pending council approval, on council agenda for 8/26/19;
- East Biloxi Public Access & Living Shoreline – DCD Construction \$1.8M; NTP Oct. 8, 2018; Completion Sept. 23, 2019; work north of Hwy 90 on-going
- East Biloxi Boardwalk (Small Craft to Oak St) & Kuhn St. Boat Launch Expansion – Pending design contract; received GOMESA funding; will this be one project or two?
- **Eagle Point Park** – *received 90% set of plans, currently under review*
- Ellzey Place II – final plat approved; Lane Construction submitted a bond for the sidewalk repairs
- **Ellzey Place III (Medical Park Drive Extension)** – Wetlands permitting public comment period has ended; should have permit by mid-June barring no issues; *bids under review, award pending receipt of Corps wetlands permit; sent letter to Corps requesting update on permit*
- Fire Station No. 7 – Starks Construction;
- Fire Station No. 10 – JW Puckett \$2.35 million; finished the new bore Friday, have laid approx. 40' of new gravity main; working through the additional days requested
- Glen Eagle Subdivision (formerly Jordan Subdivision) – need pipe videos, asphalt installation next
- **Henry Beck Park Restroom** – Bids opened September 4<sup>th</sup>, *project awarded Oct. 1<sup>st</sup>, waiting for the return of the contract documents then NTP can be set*
- **Keesler Gate Outside** – Property acquisitions continuing with only 8 just compensations remaining, and approx. 15 out of 27 acquired; All asbestos survey completed;

- Keesler Gate Inside – Necaise Brothers Const. \$4.8 million, Completion Date 12/2019; work beginning on the roundabout – MS Power work currently on-going
- Main Street Railroad Crossing Upgrades (MDOT Funding 2020) – held the MDOT kickoff/field review meeting; project ready to bid by September 2019;
- Malpass Landing/Watersview – regrading of rear yards is complete as a temporary fix; need to hire a DE to come up with a more permanent solution; using the Repair/Replace contract which opens bids June 12<sup>th</sup>
- Nature’s Trail – all work complete except permanent erosion control in detention pond; has areas of storm drain pipe failure that contractor is repairing
- **Nixon Street RR Crossing Closure** – *will order barricade in new FY then will proceed with closure*
- Parking Lot upgrades – Lot next to Margaritaville and south of Bridge at Golden Nugget; have selected company, award pending council approval
- **Pine Grove Drainage** – *Task Order has been approved by council, waiting for executed copy so contractor can begin; Contractor won’t start before Cruising the Coast*
- **Pedestrian Crosswalk @ Harbor** – Dan Hensarling, Inc. \$2.4M; NTP October 8, 2018; work on-going; *waiting for revised cost for Gold Star Monument foundation;*
- Point Cadet Marina Improvements (West) #1024 – Old Task “A” & “C”; currently on hold
- Point Cadet Waterfront (Boardwalk) – Design pending final scope of work
- Point Cadet Traffic Analysis - Submitted to GRPC for potential 80/20 funding
- Popps Ferry Extension #913 – Coliseum has the draft MOU for Board approval; 32 parcels to acquire; all surveys complete; 15 appraisals complete; 4 acquired; Build Grant application has been submitted and we’ve received confirmation

- 310 Oakmont – pending asbestos report (survey completed week of 7/8/19) – under MDOT review; *received bids September 18<sup>th</sup>*; bids currently under review

- Popps Ferry Bridge Submarine Cable – work complete, waiting on MDOT approval of a couple change order items that need to be added to the work that were found during construction
- Popps Ferry Bridge & Approaches – pending EA approval; once the EA is approved by MDOT and FHWA, we will be asking for permission to start acquiring ROW; received comments back on revised EA; have a few issues to respond back to; still working toward having it approved by early Fall with final ROW plans before the end of the year
- **Port Commission Roof Repairs** – *Opens bids Oct 9<sup>th</sup>*
- Public Excursion Pier South of Pine/Cedar #1030 – Old Task “B” on hold
- Public Safety Center Roof Leaks (3<sup>rd</sup> floor sealing) – work on going; meeting with Saucier Brothers today to look at the roof warranty issue; additional cracks found were sealed; the Soprema Rep came to look at the roof last week, we’re waiting on a determination from them on how to proceed with roof work.
- **Repair/Replace Contract** – Bids opened June 12<sup>th</sup>, on council for approval on July 23<sup>rd</sup>
  - Pine Grove Drainage – *task order approved by council, contractor starting after Cruising the Coast*
  - Churchhill Ditch – *getting a survey to check pipe inverts and see how much cut/fill will be needed, this is next on the repair/replace work*
  - Dr. Crowder Drainage -

- **Saenger Theater Phase I & II Fly Tower & Exterior** – *NTP November 4<sup>th</sup>; MS Power still working on electrical lines*

- **Sediment Removal Phase II** – *Goosepoint & Bent Oaks received bids Sept. 4<sup>th</sup>; bids being reviewed; will be on the Oct. 15<sup>th</sup> Agenda for award*



- Sediment Removal Phase III - Hiller Park Pond/Beau Chene/Cedar Lake Rd. Canal/Cedar Lake Broadus/Kennedy Ln/Savannah Estates; Eagle Point Pin Oak; Linda Dr.; hydrographic surveys have been completed, working on permit applications for each site
- Sediment Maintenance Plan – pending design contract from Seymour Engineering
- Shorecrest Subdivision – clearing and grubbing
- Shriners Blvd. Drainage - Overstreet & Associates developing a drawing for the additional drainage pipe crossing Shriners Blvd.; reviewing a proposal from Overstreet
- Sidewalk repairs
  - o Jackson St. from Main to Lameuse (City Hall) – PW
  - o Keller Avenue south of RR Tracks to Hwy 90 – PW
  - o **Popps Ferry – Taylor Oaks to Walmart – Eng** *PO has been issued to contractor, should be finished*
  - o Fayard Street – Reynoir to Jackson – Eng (pending decision by City Hall)
  - o **Southern/Greater – Eng**; request from Councilman Lawrence – *Have the costs for this one, will have the PO this week and contract will start this one after Popps Ferry*
- Smith Subdivision (north corner of Woolmarket Rd. & Old Hwy 67) – water line tie into Larkin is complete
- **Tanglewood Infrastructure** – survey work complete; completed 30% review; should have 60% by end of October
- Ward 4 Paving
  - o Baywood & Rustwood – Meeting with pavement management contractor to get estimates
  - o On The Green – on County’s schedule to complete
  - o Working on a list of streets for pavement preservation will have by end of May
- Ward 6 Paving
  - o Working on a list of streets for pavement preservation, will have by end of May
- Ward 7 Drainage – Met with Councilman Barrett, Jerry Creel & Dennis Steiffel on 8/26/2019 to discuss drainage issues in Woolmarket; Councilman Barrett requested a map of all ditches in Woolmarket.
- **Watersview Drainage Cleaning** – Council Glavan has requested assistance from Harrison County and we have submitted application for wetlands permit; *received email from Corps that no permit was needed, DMR is issuing a waiver*

- **West Biloxi Boardwalk Phase 1B** – Construction pending tidelands leases and easements; *RPR contract is in place, ready to bid once all legal is complete, there will be a meeting mid October with the last remaining property owner to ensure all his issues are taken care of and I expect that he'll sign the easement after that meeting*
- **Woolmarket City Center Addition** – *NTP Sept. 16<sup>th</sup>, starting on sitework, metal building will be delivered Oct. 14<sup>th</sup>*
- **Woolmarket Rd. East Drainage** – 5/29 mtg - bid plans & specs by end of July; wetlands permit will be submitted by end of June; legal & acquisitions contracts are in place to being easements; had an update meeting July 12<sup>th</sup> wetlands permit will be submitted in next couple days; still working toward end of July advertisement; *mid-September received 90% review set, sent back with mark ups and request for quantities and updated cost estimate*
- **Woolmarket Road Sidewalks** – pending design contract from Machado Patano; have a draft contract with MP; currently reviewing
