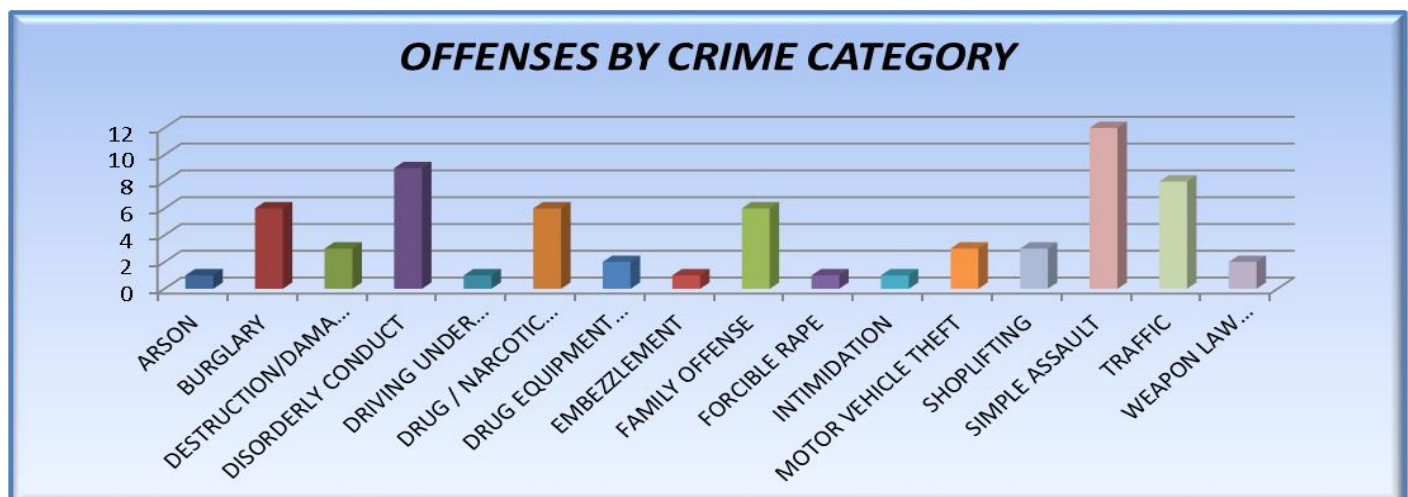
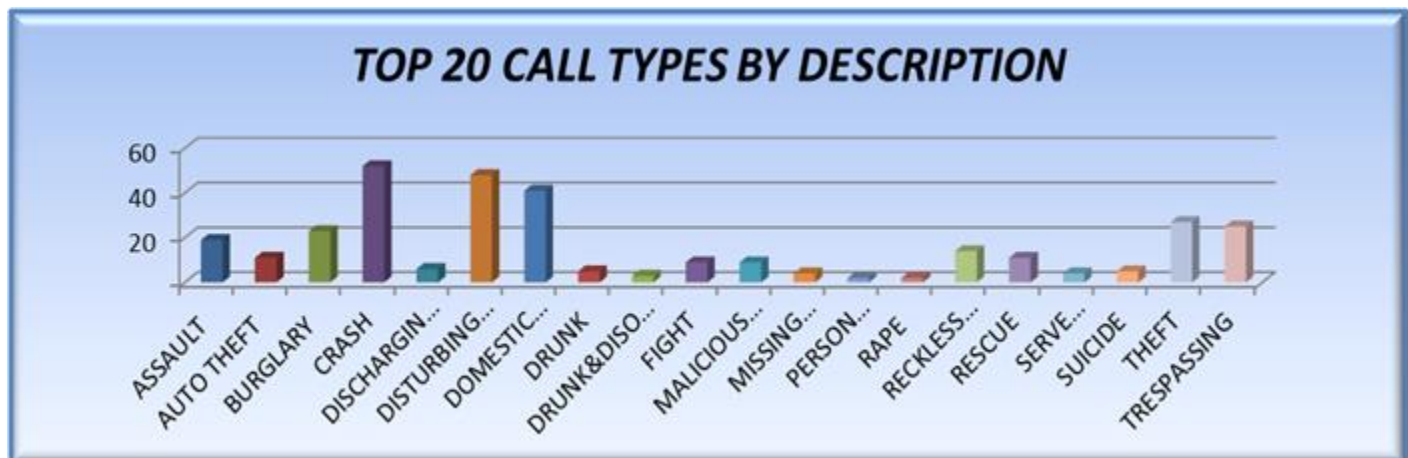

- **Atkinson Road Traffic Study** – on Oct. 6th council agenda, waiting on executed contracts to begin work
- **Bayview Avenue Walkway** – receive bids August 5th, apparent low JE Talley \$2.22M; *Scheduling pre-construction meeting for this week*
- Belle La Vie Parkway – Notice to Proceed 2/8/2020; Completion Nov. 2020,
- Canaan Fishing Dock Improvements (reconstruction) – received DMR & Corps permits, have DE contract, going to hold for now
- **Canaan Fishing Dock Maintenance Repairs** – waiting on contract documents to have pre-construction meeting and set NTP date; *Scheduling pre-construction meeting this week*
- Cedar Lake Bridge Repairs (Const. Funding 2021) – Have executed MOA; drafting a letter to DE requesting completion of contract

- Keegan Bayou Restoration – layout has been approved by Mayor and Seymour is moving forward with the permitting process
- Keesler Gate Inside – Completion Date 6/2020; roundabout complete except for final asphalt and Larcher Blvd. intersection curb being installed then it will be ready for base asphalt
- Kuhn St. Boat Launch Expansion – Design contract on June 23rd council meeting; preliminary layout approved by Mayor 9/7/2020; ready to start applying for permits
- Lorraine Road water line extension – CB Developers \$587,000; NTP date Oct. 5th
- Main Street Railroad Crossing Upgrades (MDOT Funding 2020) –looking for additional \$500K in funding MDOT stated don't worry about funding to just get project to final design stage, MDOT "office review" meeting August 25th
- Malpass Landing/Watersview – regrading of rear yards is complete as a temporary fix; need to hire a DE to come up with a more permanent solution; using the Repair/Replace contract
- Natatorium Roof Leaks –met with Machado Patano to look at roof March 4th; they are going to get up there with water hoses this week to see if they can track down the leak
- Passenger Rail Platform – Design approx. 60% complete, continuing to meet with FRA, SRC and Amtrak on the design
- Point Cadet Shoreline – permits submitted to DMR and Corps, expecting a minimum of 6 months to get permits approved
- Point Cadet Marina West – submitted revised drawing and cost estimate for grant agreement
- **Point Cadet Traffic Analysis** – *MDOT gave us comments back on the contract on 10/8/2020, NS is addressing those comments and sending back to MDOT*
- **Popps Ferry Extension #913** – Coliseum has the draft MOU for Board approval; 33 parcels to acquire; all surveys; appraisals, and review appraisals complete; *House demolition is underway*

- **Popps Ferry Bridge & Approaches** – Field review/ROW plans have been delivered to MDOT, once those are approved we will be able to transition into the ROW phase as discussed, *MDOT scheduled the field review meeting Nov. 17th*
- Popps Ferry Bridge P3 RFP - Issued Addendum answering questions regarding the project.
- Port Commission Roof Repairs – going to fix the windows first then replace the carpet.
