Administrative	<p><u>Open Positions: Committee representation has changed hands a few times since last reporting: The current Committee is as follows: Robin Lang, Secretary (1), April Ready (2), Matt Dubaz (3), OPEN (4), Carroll Campbell (5), Christine Davis (6), Pam Barlow (7), Tracy Wyman, Chair, .</u> The Committee met via ZOOM during the pandemic, and will resume in-person meetings at the Community Development building in May. 2nd Monday of each month; new time is 3:30 - 4:30; Community Development Large Conference Room.</p>
Committee Review	<p><u>1. Committee Review and Recommendations to Planning Commission is required when 5 or more protected trees are proposed for removal. All Tree Committee submitted recommendations are available on the City website. With each review, applicants are reminded of tree protection procedures required during construction, are provided with a list of native species, are directed that the mitigation should occur within 6 months of project completion on-site where possible, and given a list of City-approved alternative mitigation sites.</u></p> <p><u>2. Seven (7) applications were reviewed this period:</u> <u>APPLICATION 1 (12/19/19): Husley Storage Facility, Phase 1, 1750 Popp's Ferry Rd.:</u> 156 protected trees permitted for removal. Committee Recommendations were not read into the record of the Planning Commission hearing, Dec. 19, 2019, but were paraphrased by CA Eric Nolan with the following approved by the Commission: a. 124 trees were removed, and replanting/mitigation of 372 trees (3:1). b. Mitigation species are to include a substantial portion of live oaks, other oak species and magnolias; and native species (not crepe myrtles or palms) will account for the balance in limited quantities.</p> <p>Committee recommendations for site plan adjustments to save a 24" live oak, 8" oak, 16" cypress, and 9" magnolia, as well as 2 large healthy magnolias, was not approved.</p>
	<p><u>APPLICATION 2 (1/16/2020): Bertucci Park Subdivision: 131 protected trees:</u> Tree Committee recommendations were not read into the minutes of the Planning Commission meeting of Jan. 16, 2020, but were approved as follows: a. Replanting/mitigation ratio of 3:1, or 393 trees, and with 50% of new trees replacing same species as removed.</p>
	<p><u>APPLICATION 3 (2/20/2020): Big Play Race Trak: 15 protected trees proposed for removal and approved as follows:</u> a. Replanting/mitigation ratio of 3:1, or 45 trees. b. Mitigation species will consist of 50% live oaks, 25% magnolias; 25% bald cypress;</p> <p>The Committee recommended retaining and raising the canopy of 2 24" water oaks; and one 24" live oak. These recommendations were not approved.</p>
	<p><u>APPLICATION 4 (9/14/2020): Husley Storage Facility, Phase 2, 1750 Popp's Ferry Rd.:</u> 86 protected trees were proposed for removal and approved by the Commission as follows: a. Mitigation is to occur at a rate of 3:1, with 50% of replanting should be Live Oaks; 25% of replanting should be Southern Magnolia; and 25% of the replanting should be Bald Cypress.</p> <p>The Committee also requested resubmission of the site plan with a complete tree survey (including species and DBH). An accurate tree survey is necessary in order to determine a mitigation strategy.</p>
	<p><u>APPLICATION 5 (1/16/2020) 133 Briarfield Ave., Applicant: Frank Zhang; 16 trees proposed for removal, approved by the Planning Commission.</u> a. Tree Committee reviewed the site with the City Arborist, who explained the developers' plans to retain certain healthy trees. b. Tree Committee did not provide recommendations. c. Applicant intends to mitigate at ratio of 4:1 with native species, including live oaks and magnolias.</p>
	<p><u>APPLICATION 6 (2/4/2021). Arbor Landing on the River apartment complex, 1850 Popp's Ferry Road; 14 trees proposed for removal.</u> The Tree Committee was not informed of this permit application by CA. a. Mitigation was not addressed in the Planning Commission hearing, though a Landscaping plan has been submitted b. Mitigation is required by ordinance at a ratio of 3:1 for a total of 42 trees."</p>
	<p><u>APPLICATION 7 (3/8/2021) Ocean Club Villas, 2046 Beach Blvd; 4 magnolias and 1 Live Oak proposed for removal.</u> a. Tree Committee recommended the trees be retained as all appeared healthy and were not impinging on any structure, City Arborist concurred. b. Tree Committee noted that mitigation is required if the trees are removed at a ratio of 3:1, with same species as removed.</p>
	<p>AREAS FOR IMPROVEMENT: a. All Tree Committee Recommendations are to be read aloud during a public Tree Hearing, and included in the official minutes. b. Tree Committee is to be informed of all cases to be heard in public Tree Hearing. One instance occurred this period where this did not happen.</p>
	<p>NOTE: Full versions of the Tree Committee recommendations are posted to the City website. Tree hearings take place during Planning Commission meetings, whose minutes are available through a Public Records Request with the City.</p>

<p>Compliance Reporting</p>	<p><u>The Committee reports compliance concerns to Code Enforcement and to the City Arborist. The Committee is working with the City to improve consistency of response. Examples below.</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Stockpiling of gravel and dirt under trees that is still in place in some locations. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - One occurrence was reported at Big Play Go Kart during construction. - Port-o-let and trucks parked under live oak canopy at Briarfield apartment development. b. Incomplete Tree Permit Applications: Site Plan tree inventories are often incomplete, lacking species and size of proposed removals, making it difficult for the Committee to prepare recommendations, and the Planning Committee to make an informed determination. <p>The following cases featured initially submitted inadequate tree inventories:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Husley Property Storage Facility (Stoorage City or 24 Hour Storage) --110 species not specified, phase 1; 101 species not specified, Phase 2 permit. - Big Play Go-Kart--tree species not indicated for 13 trees. c. Revised site plans are not provided to Tree Committee even when specified in Recommendations prepared for Planning Commission tree hearings. (3 OCCURANCES THIS PERIOD) d. Incidents have continued wherein trees are significantly altered or else are removed without a permit. See 'Citizen Concerns' below. e. An undetermined number of protected trees were removed for new construction, and not reported by the CA to the TC via the usual email system that has been established.
<p>Citizen Concerns</p>	<p><u>When compiling this report, the TC learned that many permits did not name number or species to be removed.</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. <u>Azalea Street Live Oak</u>: Tree Committee members joined with Mayor Gilich to meet with the media concerning the proposed removal of the significant live oak at the corner of Azalea and Irish Hill. In response to citizens' concerns about conservation of this tree, the City has decided to pursue root trimming in order to clear the Azalea St. right of way rather than remove the tree entirely. 2. <u>Woolmarket</u>. Citizens of Woolmarket continue to remark on extensive tree removal in recent years for subdivisions, and have asked about alternatives. In one incident in February at Emerald Lake Subdivision, the tree removal service hired by the developer to prune substantially altered several large, old live oaks without a permit. In September of 2019, a large area adjacent to Oaklawn Dr. in Woolmarket was essentially clear cut without a permit for tree removal or City Arborist oversight. <p>Committee Recommendations</p>	<p><u>The Committee is working cooperatively with the Director of Community Development and City Arborist on the following ongoing recommendations:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The City require utilities to contract only with companies with a reputation for adherence to best practices. 2. Members of the public who know of any tree deaths or declining health due to inappropriate pruning should contact the City Arborist. 3. Greater consistency is needed in relation to the transfer of tree permit information to the Tree Committee, and that this information always includes the number of trees and the species proposed for removal. 4. Clear-cutting done and substantial pruning without permitting continues, particularly by development companies. It was learned many of these are 'falling through the cracks' due to the companies requesting permission only via building permit, not the appropriate tree permit. This issue is in the process of being corrected. <p>Examples:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - (2019) Oaklawn and Shorecrest Road, Woolmarket clear-cutting by Elliot Homes (2019) Roxanne Drive (2020) Emerald Lakes--two live oaks were substantially pruned without a permit by Adams Construction (2020) Good Pointe Road See permit report for others 5. The Tree Committee is very much encouraged by the reinstatement of a Community Court with jurisdiction dedicated to handling violations of the Land Development Ordinance. To date, one case of tree ordinance violation has been heard by the court, and penalties of \$4000 levied.

Other Updates and Good News:

1. **LDO Revisions:** TC has been working together with City Arborist and Director of Community Development to revise the tree ordinance for readability, consistency, and to improve mitigation systems. The Tree Committee's response to City Arborist's notes on LDO revisions was presented to CA and Director of Community Development at March 11, 2020 meeting. Once finalized these will go before the Planning Commission for a workshop that will be open to the public once circumstances allow. Unfortunately, no progress has been made regarding LDO revisions since March 11, 2020 as the Community Development has not met with TC to finalize for submission to the Planning Commission. A mitigation bank has been proposed, which would remove the onus for mitigation from developers, and which they currently do not perform at adequate levels, but this mitigation bank cannot happen unless we all meet and put a semi-final draft before the Planning Commission.
2. **Mitigation Systems Update:** The Committee, the Director of Community Development, and City Arborist continue to cooperate regarding the Tracking of Replacement Tree / Mitigation Requirements. A system for mitigation tracking is continuing to be developed, and will be refined once LDO revisions are complete, and which may include innovative options for developers such as a mitigation bank when replanting/mitigation on-site is impractical. Please see adjacent Mitigation Report.
3. **Tree Canopy Survey**--Tree Canopy is natural resource whose benefits to citizens are well-established. As part of our mitigation strategy, the City Arborist looked into funding to support a Tree Canopy survey, identification of targeted areas for new tree plantings, and demonstration sites that incorporate tree planting and sustainable development strategies. Planning administration and the City legal department wanted a "tree survey" rather than a "canopy survey". A tree survey process would require a dedicated budget for maintenance once completed. As agreement was not achieved, the idea has stalled. Tree Committee stresses the importance of doing a one-time tree canopy survey that can then be repeated at regular intervals thereafter so that we will know a) how much canopy we have; b) track gains and losses; and c) assess opportunities for mitigation / replenishment of our tree stock.
4. **Tree Permits Tracking:** Tree Permits Tracking for removal of 1-4 trees continues, and is currently the task of Ward 7 Representative Pam Barlow
5. **Education/ Public Relations:** The Tree Committee has committed to coordinate with the City's PR team regarding education/public relations efforts for tree protection. This will include the creation of articles and other media materials to support public education in the City's tree matters. Topics include "Right Tree Right Place", urban forestry, and common native species. Additionally, the City will work with the Committee to publish tree-related news and information through various media, as well as an educational video to be viewed annually by developers. Three Committee members are working with City Publicist Vincent Creel to promote notable city trees on the Facebook page entitled "The Trees of Biloxi."
6. **Majestic Tree Program:** Geneva Dummer, formerly on the Tree Committee, got the Majestic Tree Program off to a strong start. The program will be made public when it is approved by the City, and will emphasize trees receiving "Majestic" designation will require additional approvals if they are ever to be considered to be permitted for removal. The tree will be visually recognizable as "Majestic" by a plaque situated at its physical location. The Committee has already recommended that language defining a new Majestic Tree review process be included in revisions to the LDO verbiage. The "Majestic" designation would be extended from live oaks to any significant species above a certain dimension. The proposed plan directs interested citizens to apply for status through the Société des Arbres. Once designation is achieved through that organization, the tree would be named under Biloxi's program and presented to city Council. An application form for this program has been developed, and will be presented to the City Council for their approval.
7. **City Beautification Program:** The Committee is in the process of outlining a plan for a beautification program to the City. The Committee has mapped points of interest on a Ward Map. Tracy will compile a report of recommendations to the City.
8. **Action Tracking**--TC continues to monitor and track tree-related issues through its Action Tracker system.
