**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that the [111] Motion for Summary Judgment filed by Defendant U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is **DENIED**.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that the [109] Motion for Summary Judgment filed by Plaintiffs is **GRANTED**. Pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 706(1) and 16 U.S.C. § 1855(b)(2), the Court orders the Corps to consult with the National Marine Fisheries Service regarding the impact of Spillway openings on Essential Fish Habitats or before September 30, 2023.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that, all claims having been resolved by the Court, this case shall be closed. However, the Court will retain jurisdiction for the purpose of ensuring the Corps' compliance with the Court's Memorandum Opinion and Order and Judgment.
