## Ordinance No. 2509

## ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTIONS 5-4-2 (a) TO ADOPT UPDATED VERSION OF NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BILOXI, MISSISSIPPI

WHEREAS, on March 24, 2020, the City of Biloxi adopted the 2020 version of the National Electrical Code (with amendments) as published by the National Fire Protection Association; and

WHEREAS, for many years the City of Biloxi has adopted various editions (with amendments) of the National Electrical Code; and

WHEREAS, the National Electrical Code is widely recognized as achieving the purpose of making electrical code standards more uniform; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Biloxi to approve and adopt 2023 version of the National Electrical Code (with certain amendments) as the electrical code standards of the City of Biloxi in Section 5-4-2 (a); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BILOXI, MISSISSIPPI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: The findings, statements, and conclusions of fact contained in the preamble are adopted, ratified, and incorporated herein:

SECTION TWO: Section 5-4-2 (a) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Biloxi, Mississippi, is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

Sec. 5-4-2. Adoption of National Electrical Code.

(a) *Adoption*. The National Electrical Code, 2020 2023 edition, as published by the National Fire Protection Association is hereby approved and adopted by the city and made a part of this article. A copy of said National Electrical Code shall be kept in the office of the Community Development Department of the City of Biloxi as a permanent record. Such National Electrical Code is hereby adopted fully as if set out at length herein, subject, however, to all amendments,

deletions, and substitutions contained in the code, and subject further to inconsistent provisions contained in this code.

SECTION THREE: This ordinance shall become effective thirty days after its passage and publication as required by law.
