2023 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT ACTION PLAN COMBINED NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING, DRAFT AVAILABILITY & 30-DAY COMMENT PERIOD

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development has announced the City of Biloxi will receive a \$404,451.00 2023 CDBG Entitlement Grant allocation and, based on previous years' resources, the city anticipates generating program income of \$175,784.00 for 2023 activities.

The City of Biloxi has scheduled a second public hearing regarding development of the 2023 CDBG Action Plan at 5:30 p.m., on **Wednesday, June 21, 2023**, in the Community Development Auditorium, at 676 Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard, to give Biloxi residents and other interested **stakeholders'** opportunity to:

- Present oral or written input about City housing, non-housing community development and supportive public service needs; and
- Participate in developing and implementing the 2023 CDBG Action Plan, a component of the Five-Year Consolidated Plan.

Residents are urged to attend, particularly low, very low, extremely low income and public housing residents, minorities, and those with mobility, visual, and hearing impediments. Those who wish to participate but may be hindered by disabilities or are non-English speaking are urged to call the Biloxi Federal Programs Office at 228-435-6269 at least three (3) days prior to June 21, 2023 so reasonable arrangements can be made.
