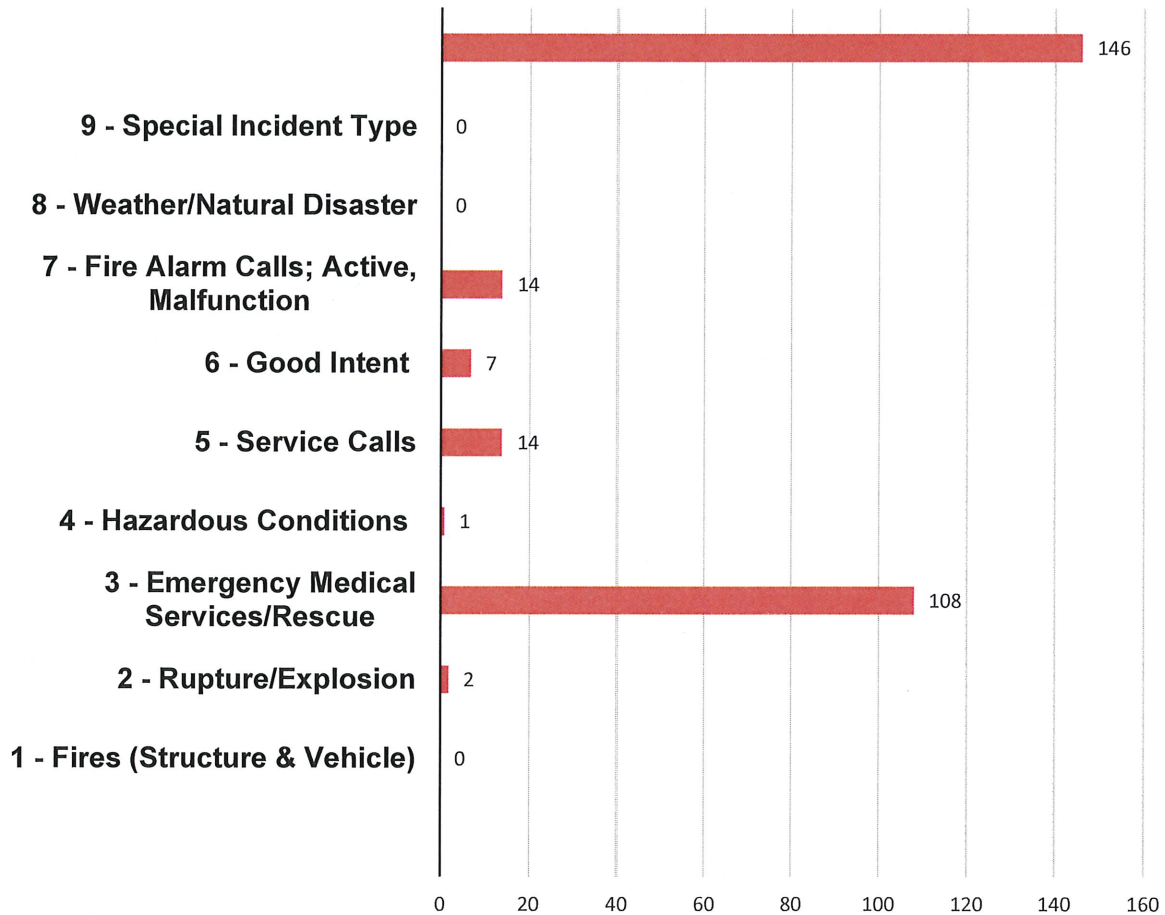

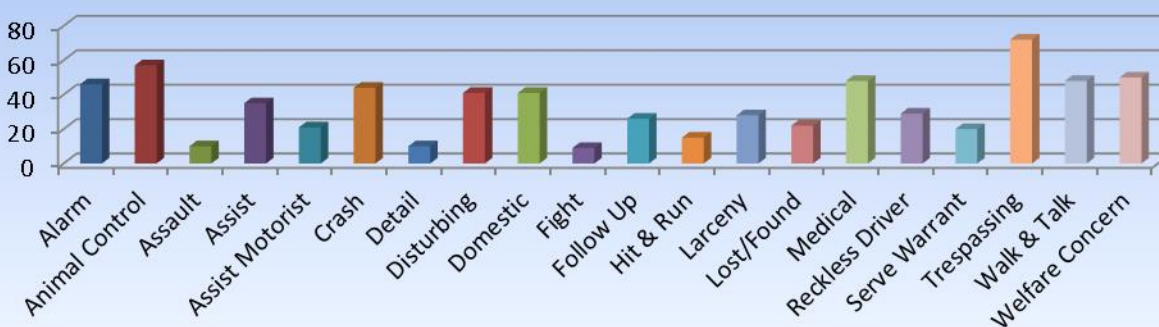
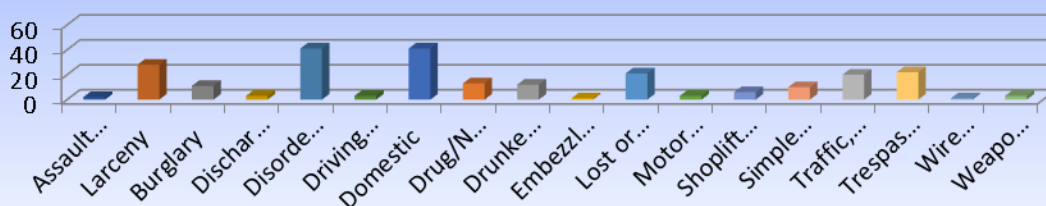

**Projects**

- Bay Vista Water Well - BMA is getting project ready to bid, MCWI grant agreement will be on council agenda before the end of June
- Biloxi-OS Bridge Walking Path Ramp – pending a design contract from BMA
- Biloxi/Keesler Welcome Sign – pending a design contract from BMA

- Bridge Repairs
  - Porter Avenue/Keegan Bayou Bridge – Have PO waiting to schedule with contractor
  - Cedar Lake Bridge – Have fracture critical repairs that need to be made asap, don't have quote yet on repairs
- Causeway Lights – Have costs to repair lights, waiting on DMR approval of Tidelands funding reallocation to get Purchase Order
- Causeway Pier Zeta Repairs – Receive bids June 21<sup>st</sup> – postponed bids due to questions that needed to be addressed via addendum
- Causeway Pier Repairs (west side) – Design pending Tidelands grant paperwork received and approved
- Cedar Lake Bridge Repairs – Plan to submit for MDOT Emergency Road & Bridge Repair Grant and BRIC Grant for M&E and structural repairs
- Churchill Drive Ditch Improvements – BMA contract approved on council agenda June 4<sup>th</sup>, they have started preliminary investigation
- City Hall Preservation & Improvements – Received preliminary condition assessment from historical preservation expert, EGH is working on developing scope of work and costs
- Citywide Street Paving (Landshapers) – Warren Paving is planning to start paving on Thursday June 15<sup>th</sup>, pending weather delays

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- Concrete Annual Contract – need to readvertise, current contract is expiring
- East Biloxi Connector Road Porter to Hopkins (CDBG Funded) –starting on Phase I from Porter to Benachi, all property is expected to be acquired by the end of May
- Eagle Point Park – Working on design for lights, picnic tables, benches at playground, benches around walkway, trash cans, and possible shade structure
- Fire Station No. 5 – (Mark Williams) design underway

- Hiller Park Drainage Improvements – Cypress getting me a proposal to do conceptual drawings for grant application
- Hwy 90 Small Craft to Oak Street Curb & Gutter Repairs – pending design contract, have conceptual
- Lighthouse Pier – design efforts continue, Corps permits out for public hearing
- Keegan Bayou Restoration – Permits being requested, GOMESA project submitted to DMR, also in the Restore Act Portal Working with DMR to get dredging permit approval
- Kuhn St. Boat Launch Expansion – Conceptual started by Pickering, vegetation removal started, project scope revised to match tidelands funding grants, Pickering working on adding the 3<sup>rd</sup> boat ramp
- Lorraine Road Water Line Extension Ph 2 – ARPA application for funding submitted, Awarded to Bottom 2 Top at \$1.1M - NTP May 22<sup>nd</sup> 150 days completion Oct. 19<sup>th</sup>, **work has started**
- Main Street Railroad Crossing Upgrades – (Gulf Breeze Construction) NTP Jan. 16<sup>th</sup>, construction has started
- McDonnell Avenue Extension – Pending design
- MGCCC Traffic Signal – **MOA from MDOT was approved on council agenda June 6<sup>th</sup>, have a preliminary signal layout for the Mayor's approval**
- Oak Street Pier (South) – Cypress presented conceptual plans, pending Tidelands notification (\$400K) to start design; pending a design contract from Cypress
- Parker's Creek Sediment Removal – Seymour contract approved by council, added scope to go as far north of I-10 as possible, **permits have been applied for, waiting for comments back from the permitting agencies**
- Pickleball Restroom – Apparent low bidder Argus Building, \$142K, **contract awarded on June 6<sup>th</sup> council agenda, waiting for contract documents to be returned to schedule a pre-construction meeting and set start date**
- Point Cadet Re-Development #1092 – Machado Patano is working concept
- Point Cadet Living Shoreline – BMA – No cultural resources issues, should have COE permit by end of May then will be ready to advertise
- Point Cadet Nearshore #1096 –BMA contract will be on council agenda this month

- Point Cadet Marina West – AnderCorp NTP 10/24, 240-day contract, work on-going, still waiting on electrical components and floating docks Change order on this agenda to make welding repairs on sheet pile wall (above water and below water) and grout to fill behind wall when complete
- Popp’s Ferry Extension #913 – Coliseum has the draft MOU for Board approval; ROW acquisition continues, funding secured for construction, close one additional RR crossing and send final crossing design to CSD, final roadway design required, Plan is to bid in 2023
- Popp’s Ferry Bridge & Approaches – Ph I design complete, contract for right of way acquisition being developed, EA being updated, top priority to obtain funding to repair existing bridge, submitted to emergency road and bridge repair program
- Popp’s Ferry Recreational Complex Lighting – Have condition assessment for lights, meeting with Sparta vendor to review their lights, then will have to decide how to proceed
- Port Repair Replace Contract
  - Porter Avenue North Pier
  - Forrest Avenue Pier
- Repair/Replace Contract – See attached
- Rodenberg at Pass Road Intersection – Activated with MDOT, kickoff meeting held and parcel research underway as initial steps in row & easement acquisition process starts
- Sand Re-Nourishment #1064 – GOMESA / W.C. Fore – **Project complete**
- Sediment Removal – the sites that have SAV, Seymour is trying to work with DMR on a way to mitigate, asked them to do another SAV survey under their existing contract; DMR is starting to allow invasive SAV to be removed
  - Hiller Park Pond (have permits)
  - Parkers Creek – pending permit
  - Point Cadet Marina – pending permits
- Shriners Blvd. Water & Sewer Extension – (Overstreet) Gulf Coast Solutions Completion date: 07/16/23 going to do the change order work as a phase 2 project since the cost is so high, phase 2 will go out to bid in the next few weeks – **Change Order 2 on council this week to tie into the existing 16” instead of private 8” due to pressure issues**
- Sports Complex #1093 – (Machado Patano) Rejected bids received April 26<sup>th</sup>, readvertising this week, open bids June 28<sup>th</sup>
- Spratley sewer/storm drain repairs – Complete just waiting on the county to do the paving

- Sylvania Street Drainage – LNJ will perform the video inspection of the pipe the week of June 12<sup>th</sup>
- Tanglewood Infrastructure Ph II –MP getting project ready to bid, the MCWI grant agreement is on this council agenda for approval
- Ward 2 Recreational Center – Final layout has been approved
- Woolmarket Road Sidewalks – (Machado Patano) – MDOT doing their final plan/spec review, ready to bid as soon as receive concurrence from MDOT, waiting on MDOT to approve CE&I contract
- Woolmarket Road Traffic Study – Traffic counts for 3 intersection involving Shriners with (I-110, Shortcut, and Woolmarket Rd), 2 intersections with Old Hwy 67 (Hudson – Krohn, Woolmarket Road), and 1 intersection at Wash Fayard & John Lee Roads, project has starting
- Woolmarket Acres Infrastructure Improvements (Tiffany, Oaklawn, Boyette, Shorecrest) (Overstreet) design contract awarded, held kick off meeting, survey 90% complete
