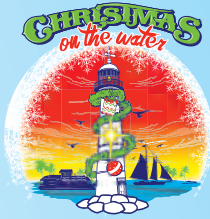

Christmas on the Water weekend

The Christmas on the Water festivities kicks off on Friday, Dec. 1 with the annual Children's Parade at 6 p.m. Kindergarten to fourth graders will ride on hay wagons through downtown to the Biloxi Town Green, 710 Beach Blvd. At the Town Green, Christmas decorations will be lit, and Santa will be waiting to talk with the children. Then on Saturday, Dec. 2, the Annual Christmas in the City takes place along the Rue Magnolia area from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. More than 100 vendors will be selling their wares and Christmas carols will be sung by local choirs. The centerpiece of the weekend takes place on Saturday at 6 p.m. with the parade of decorated boats cruising along the waterfront followed by a fireworks show.
