



Mobile Food Vendor Requirements

Required Permissions

- Allowed in the following zoning classifications: **RB, DT, WF, CB, NB**
- Mobile food vendors may not be located within 250 ft from an established restaurant, measured from any point of the principal structure to the nearest point of the mobile food vendor.
- Development Review Committee (DRC) approval required for all Long-Term Vendors.
- DRC approval required for any Temporary Food Truck Event not organized by the City
- Valid copy of lease/letter consent from property owner for each private site.
- Site Plan Approval – detailed site layout, appearance photos, and products sold.
- Written indemnity agreement holding city employees/officers harmless for any loss, liability damage for bodily injury, or property damage.
- Fire Department Inspection Approval for all enclosed mobile food vehicles.

Required Licenses and Permits

- Mississippi Department of Health Mobile Food Establishment Permit
- Driver's License
- ABC Permit for sale of alcoholic beverages - The sale of alcoholic beverages is prohibited except for the "To Go Cup" Leisure Districts.
- Proof of valid insurance policy minimum liability coverage of \$300,000 with City of Biloxi named as Additional Insured.
- Privilege License
- MS State Tax ID from the Department of Revenue designated as a Biloxi business.

Permit Fees

- Long-Term Vendor
 - \$250 per vehicle for 90 consecutive days
 - \$25 renewal for an additional 90 consecutive days
 - \$75 for Special events
 - Long-term permits may **not** be used to operate at special events.
- Special Events
 - \$300 per vehicle for two consecutive days
 - Special events include Mardi Gras, Cruising the Coast, Airshow, Scraping the Coast, Spring Break, & any other special event to be determined.
