

Mobile Food Vendor Requirements

Know Before You Go:

- Food trucks are allowed in the following zones: RB regional business, DT downtown, WF- waterfront, CB- community business, and NB- neighborhood business. See maps at biloxi.ms.us/maps.
- Development Review Commission (DRC) approval is required for all food trucks with a permanent location, i.e., a location you park your food truck and sell to the public on a daily/weekly basis. For more info, contact 228-435-6266.
- Biloxi Police Department approval is now required for all Special Events, i.e., any gathering in excess of the number of persons normally using a place of business, before any food truck/arts & crafts vendor approval can be granted.

- Valid copy of lease/letter consent from property owner for each private site.
- Site Plan needed. This is where will your business will be located.
 Provide photos, detailed layout, appearance, and list of products sold.

- Mississippi Department of Health Mobile Food Establishment Permit <u>packets</u> <u>available upon request</u>
- Driver's License
- The sale of alcoholic beverages is prohibited except for the "To Go Cup" Leisure Districts (Online at biloxi.ms.us/maps) in which an ABC Permit is required.

- Proof of valid insurance policy minimum liability coverage of \$300,000
- Biloxi Fire Department Inspection Approval for Long-Term Vendors. (yearly)

Permit Fees

- Long-Term Vendor \$200 per vehicle per year.
 - \$50 for Special events Long-term permits may not be used to operate at special events.
- **Special Events** \$300 per vehicle for two consecutive days within a five-day period.
 - Special events include Mardi Gras, Cruisin' The Coast, airshows, Scrapin The Coast, Spring Break, and any other special event determined by Council Resolution. Visit online at biloxi.ms.us/specialevents.
