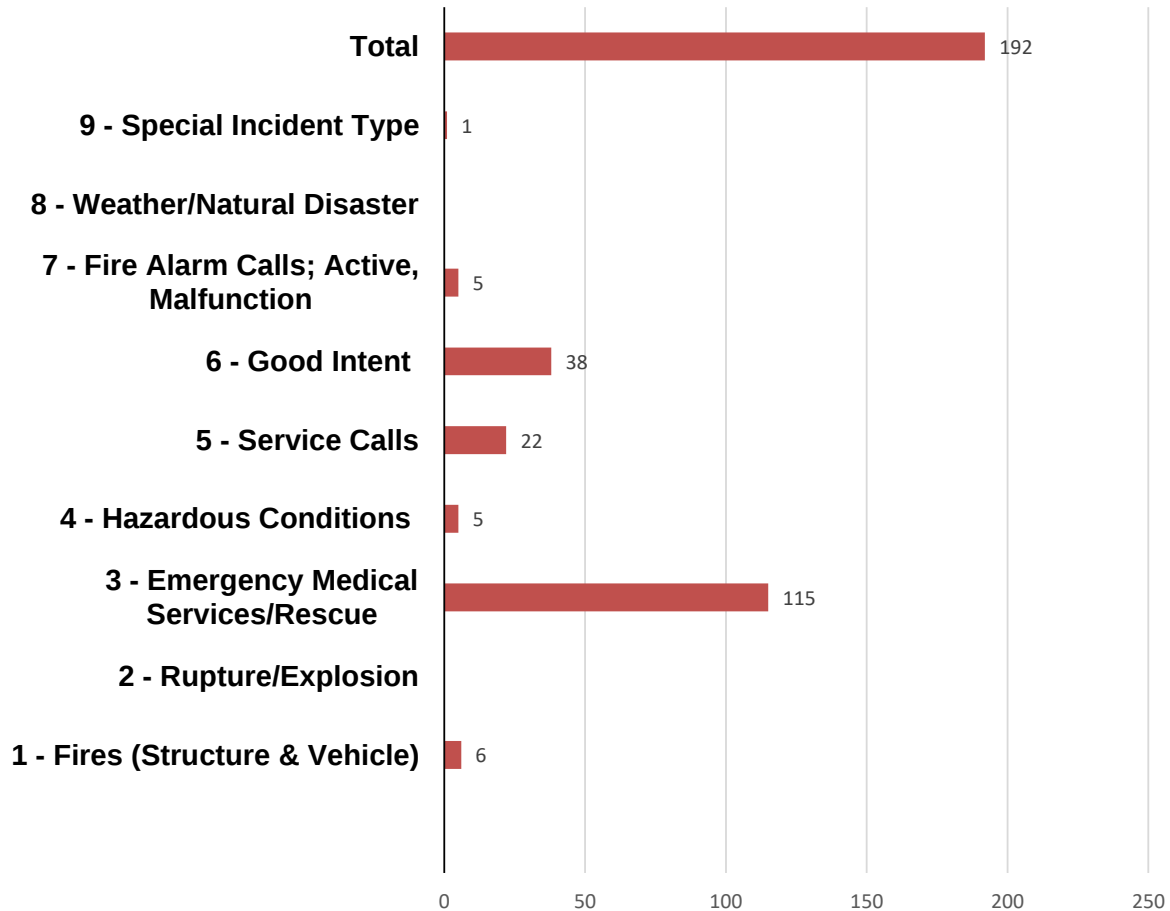

WEEKLY COUNT OF INCIDENT TYPE



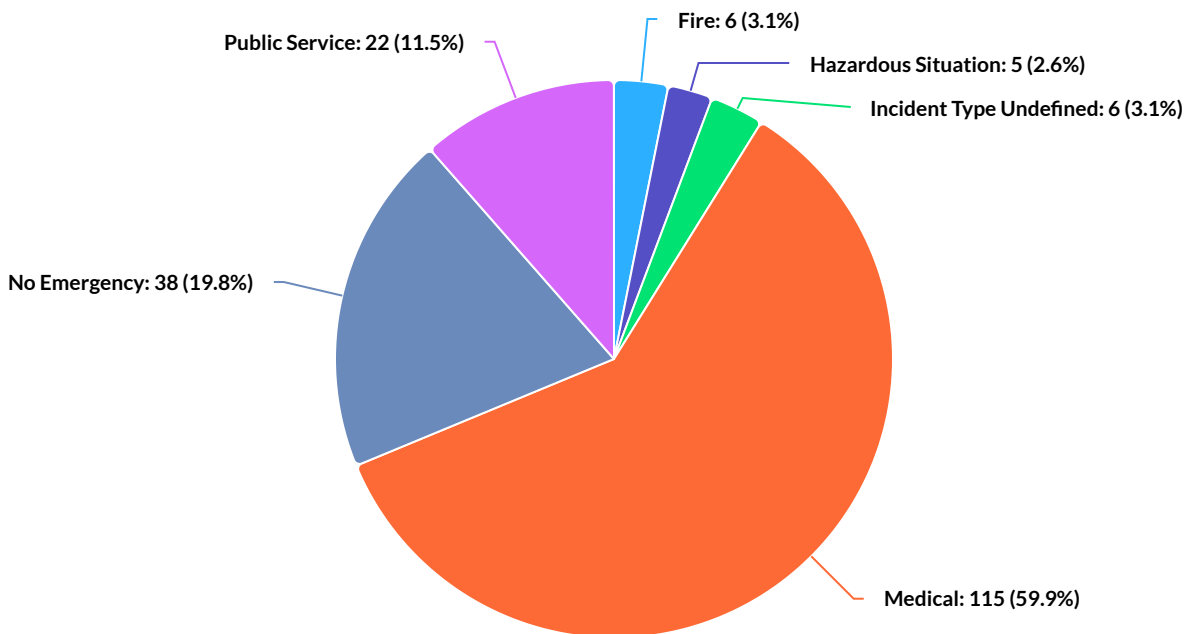

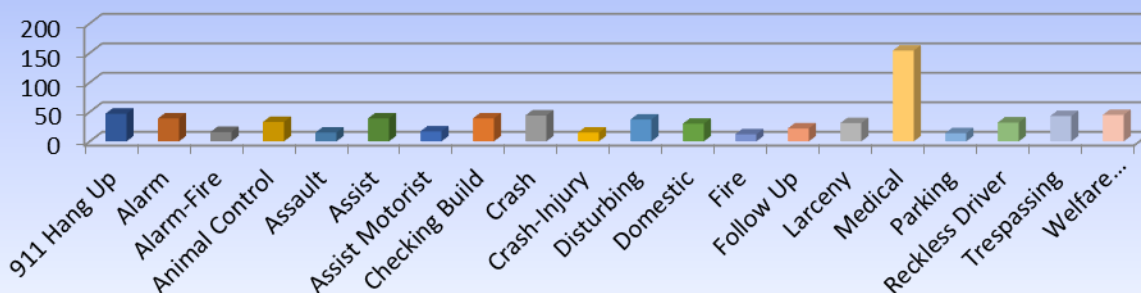

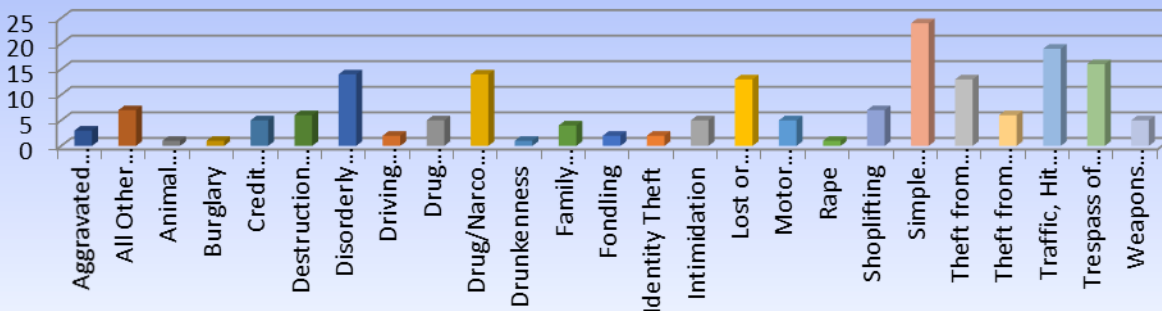

Private Utility Work in ROW

- Currie Subdivision (Cspire) – Pass Rd. to McDonnell Ave. & McDonnell Ave. to Glenn St.; **under construction**
- Forrest Ave., Benachi Ave. from Division to Bayview (AT&T) – start date TBD
- Greater Ave., Iris St., Gardenia St. and Daisy St. (AT&T) – **complete**
- Hawk Creek (Cspire) – **Construction complete**
- Howard Ave. from I-110 to Porter (transfer of wires to new poles) – AT&T has removed 13 of the 20 poles lines have been transferred; Lumen is complete and Sparklight still has a few poles left
- **Jim Byrd Rd. (AT&T) – still start the 1st week of March**
- Main St., Esters Blvd., to Keller Ave. & Howard Ave. (AT&T) – aerial and underground work; start date TBD
- Mallard Creek (Sparklight) – Under construction
- **Parkers Creek Rd. (AT&T) – will start the 1st week of March**
- Rue Magnolia (Jackson St. Parking Lot) – Requested all utilities move from the old pole to the new pole so the old pole can be removed; Sparklight has moved, waiting on AT&T
- Southern Avenue & Greater Ave – Will be started after Circle Park and after BEA sidewalks

Projects

- Bay Vista Water Line Replacement Project No. 1013 – DNA Underground; \$3.3 million; Start May 1, 2025; 335 days; Completion April 1, 2026, 55% Complete as of December 2025
- Biloxi-OS Bridge Walking Path Ramp – BMA working on design, estimated cost \$120,000 project needs funding MDOT had some comments that BMA addressed they're now waiting for final MDOT approval
- Avery Bay Subdivision (Brodie Rd.) – 100% plans have been approved; project is waiting on decision by developer on the detention pond
- East Biloxi Access Rd. Ph III – JE Talley; waiting on contract documents to be executed to schedule notice to proceed date.
- Falcon Glen Subdivision (Belle La Vie Ph 2) – starting to set manholes and lay sewer, working on sod around detention ponds

- Hawk Creek Subdivision Ph III (Oaklawn & Shorecrest) – Construction plans have been approved, project on hold until the issue with the trees has been resolved
- Howard Creek Bridge (Old Hwy 67, just east of Hudson Krohn/Cedar Lake Intersection)
 - Received \$1.6M in State Aid funding (\$0 match) to replace this bridge, DMR/Corps permit has been issued; bridge temporarily closed for emergency repairs; will receive bids for the replacement beginning of March.
- Gruich Center HVAC upgrades – apparent low bidder DNP \$624,750; equipment delivery will begin the week but the air handlers won't be here until February 2026
- Keegan Bayou Restoration – JE Borries, Inc.; \$698K; Awarded April 18, 2025; Pre-construction meeting May 29, 2025; NTP December 1, 2025, work has started.
- Kinglsey Ridge Subdivision – Tribe Drive; issued construction plan approval for phase 1
- Kuhn St. Boat Ramp – Tidelands Application submitted for FY27 funding in the amount of \$500K in additional funding for construction
- North Biloxi Well Casing – Receive bids August 13, 2025, apparent low bidder Lyman Well \$450,000, under construction
- Oak Street Pier (South) – Received 60% design plans; project needs funding; Tidelands application submitted for FY27 funding in the amount of \$2.6M for construction
- Preserve at Parker's Creek Phase II (Shriners Blvd.) – Construction plans have been approved, developer waiting on his contractor
- Phase II Paving (Ward is parenthesis)

- Point Cadet Nearshore #1096 (BMA) – design on-going, permitting is going to take longer than we thought, it's probably going to be another 4-6 months in permitting; Corps is waiting for concurrence from National Marine Fisheries before they can issue their permit.
- Point Cadet Marina Phase II – will be receiving \$5.5 million in Restore funding, grant agreement was approved June 10, 2025; working through the documentation to submit to MDEQ

- Popp’s Ferry Extension #913 – Necaise Bros. \$20.8M, NTP 11/25/2024
 - Contractor is working on installing the road base on the south side of the RR tracks
 - Water, sewer and storm drain between Hwy 90 and RR tracks is substantially complete
 - Will begin working on the retaining wall that leads up to the underpass soon
 - Work is 35% complete as of end of January
- Popp’s Ferry Bridge Draw Replacement – Neel-Schaffer, \$506K,
 - Design on-going
- Repair/Replace Contract – Currently on hold under additional funding is allocated
- Rodenberg at Pass Road Intersection – ROW acquisition is almost complete, one property one is holding out
- Shriners Blvd. Widening – Project was approved in the STIP; ready to begin the MDOT process by requesting Project Activation as soon as grant match is funded
- Southern Magnolia Subdivision (Shorecrest Blvd.) – Construction plans have been approved; construction pending outside agenda approvals; contractor waiting for gas main crossing agreement for the off-site water line
- White Avenue Outfalls – Design selection committee has selected Brown, Mitchell & Alexander; currently negotiating that contract
- Woolmarket Acres Infrastructure Improvements (Tiffany, Oaklawn, Boyette, Shorecrest) (Overstreet) Corps walked to the project prior to developing their final scope of work for our review
