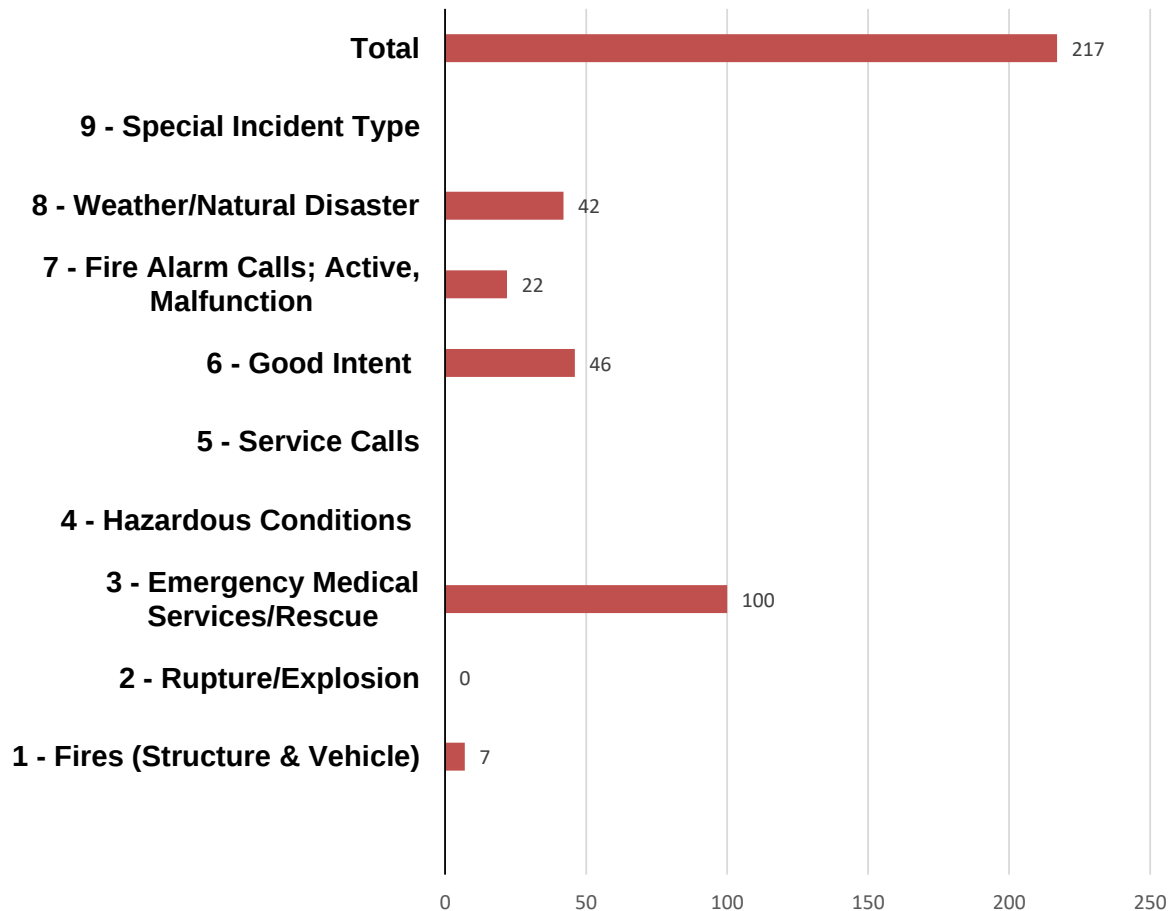

WEEKLY COUNT OF INCIDENT TYPE



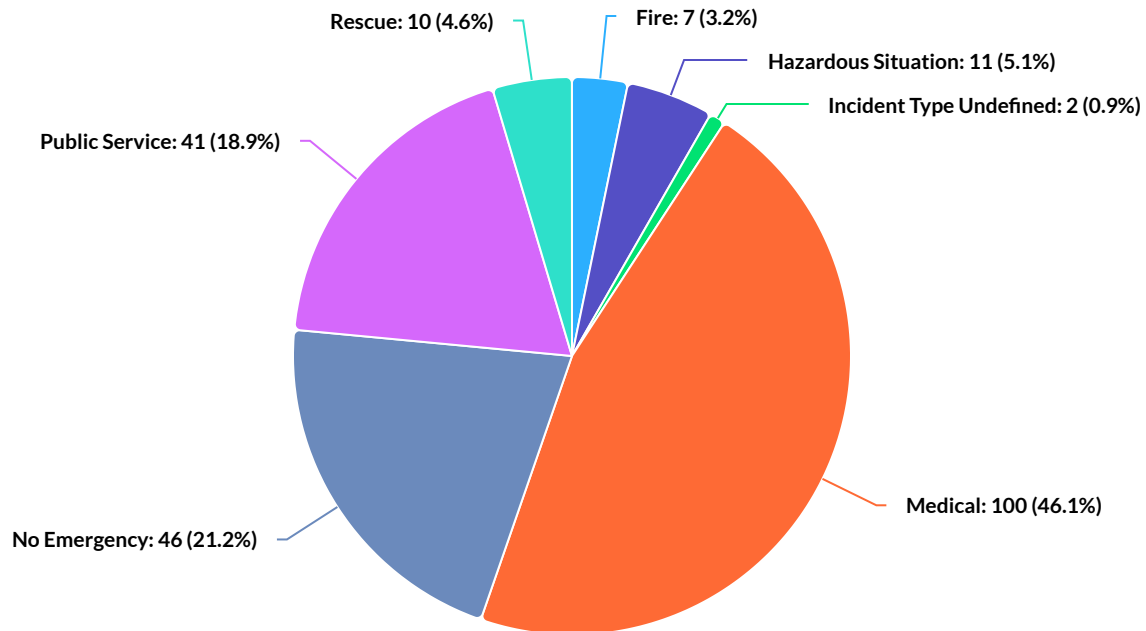

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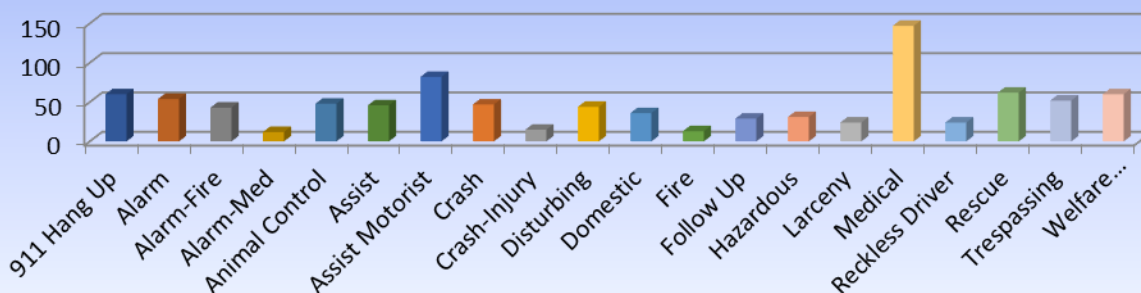

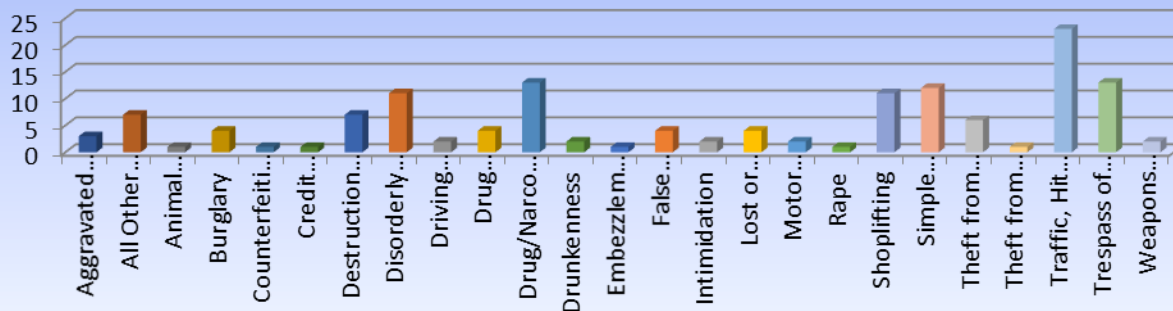

Projects Under Construction

- Bay Vista Water Lines
- East Biloxi Conn Rd. Ph III
- Keegan Bayou Restoration
- North Biloxi Well Casing
- Popps Ferry Extension
- Repair/Replace 2025-2028

Private Utility Work in ROW

- Howard Ave. from I-110 to Porter (transfer of wires to new poles) – Only 2-3 more poles that still have wire on them around Benachi Ave., waiting for an update on when these lines will be moved.
- Rue Magnolia (Jackson St. Parking Lot) – all lines have been removed, waiting to see when the pole can be pulled

Projects

- Bay Vista Water Line Replacement Project No. 1013 – DNA Underground; \$3.3 million; Start May 1, 2025; 335 days; Completion April 1, 2026, 90% Complete as of end of April 2026
- Belle La Vie Parkway Construction Road – **getting the right of way flagged to determine exact location of roadway; going to work on getting the wetlands permit**
- East Biloxi Access Rd. Ph III – JE Talley; demolition work has started
- Falcon Glen Subdivision (Belle La Vie Ph 2) – starting to set manholes and lay sewer, working on sod around detention ponds
- Hawk Creek Subdivision Ph III (Oaklawn & Shorecrest) – **Received updated construction plans now that the tree permit has been approved**
- Hiller Park Nutrient Reduction – received GOMESA grant in the amount of \$1,300,000;
- Howard Creek Bridge (Old Hwy 67, just east of Hudson Krohn/Cedar Lake Intersection) – Received \$1.6M in State Aid funding (\$0 match) to replace this bridge,
- Keegan Bayou Restoration – JE Borries, Inc.; \$698K; work has started
- Kinglsey Ridge Subdivision – Tribe Drive; issued construction plan approval for phase 1
- Kuhn St. Boat Ramp – An additional \$500K was authorized by HB1896 for tidelands funding; brings funding up to \$1.5M; funding will not be available until we receive the tidelands grant agreement in Nov. 2026
- North Biloxi Well Casing – Receive bids August 13, 2025, apparent low bidder Lyman Well \$450,000, under construction

- Oak Street Pier – An additional \$500K was authorized by HB1896 for tidelands funding; brings funding up to \$900K; funding will not be available until we receive the tidelands grant agreement in Nov. 2026
- Point Cadet Nearshore #1096 (BMA) – Corps permit has been approved just waiting for it to come back from the Corps executed
- Point Cadet Marina Phase II – Everything has been submitted to MDEQ for construction plan approval
- Popp’s Ferry Extension #913 – Necaise Bros. \$20.8M, NTP 11/25/2024
 - Road base is complete south of the RR Tracks
 - Water, sewer and storm drain north of the tracks is underway
 - Work on the retaining wall that leads up to the underpass is under construction
 - Work is 44% complete as of end of April
- Popp’s Ferry Bridge Draw Replacement – Neel-Schaffer, \$506K,
 - Design on-going
- Rodenberg at Pass Road Intersection – ROW acquisition is almost complete, one property one is holding out
- Southern Magnolia Subdivision (Shorecrest Blvd.) – Installation of 16” offsite water main on Shorecrest is complete
- White Avenue Outfalls – Design selection committee has selected Brown, Mitchell & Alexander; contract being placed on the agenda is pending an MOU with Harrison County
- Woolmarket Acres Infrastructure Improvements (Tiffany, Oaklawn, Boyette, Shorecrest) Corps is working through the grant paperwork on their end.
