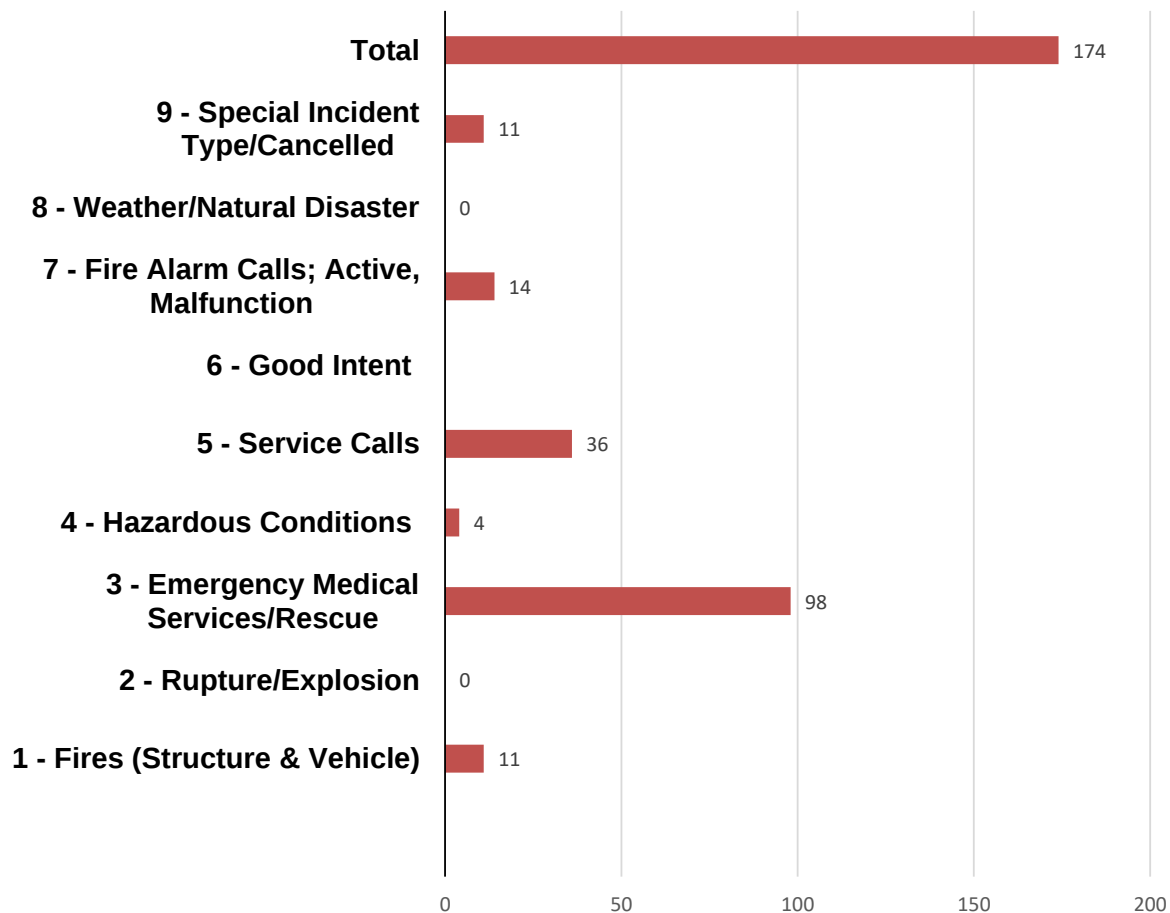

**WEEKLY COUNT OF INCIDENT TYPE**



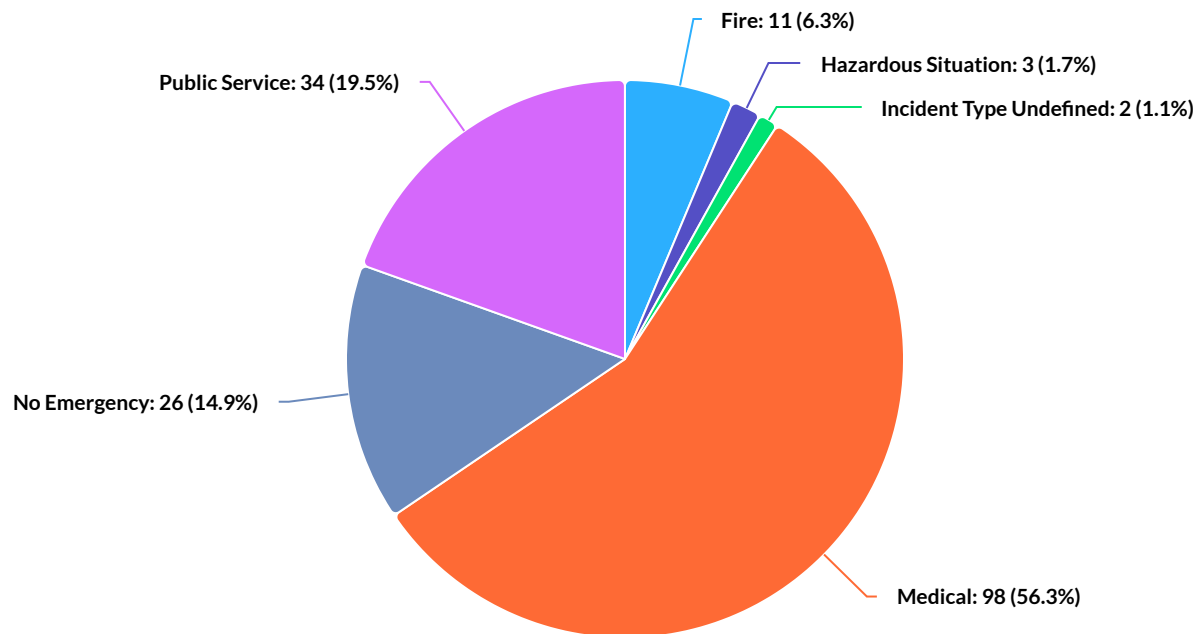

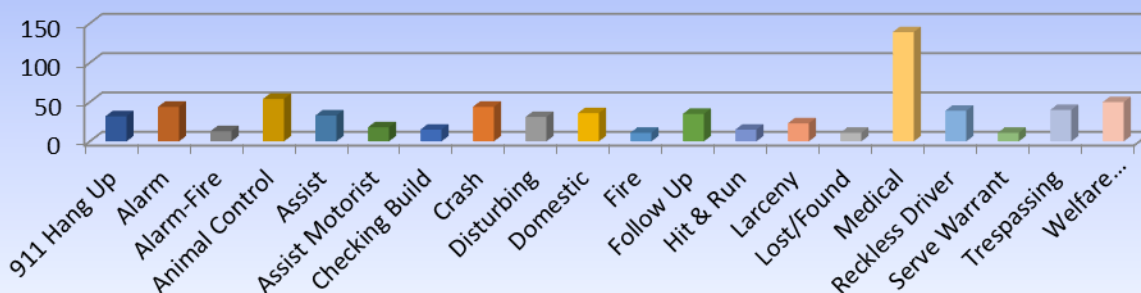
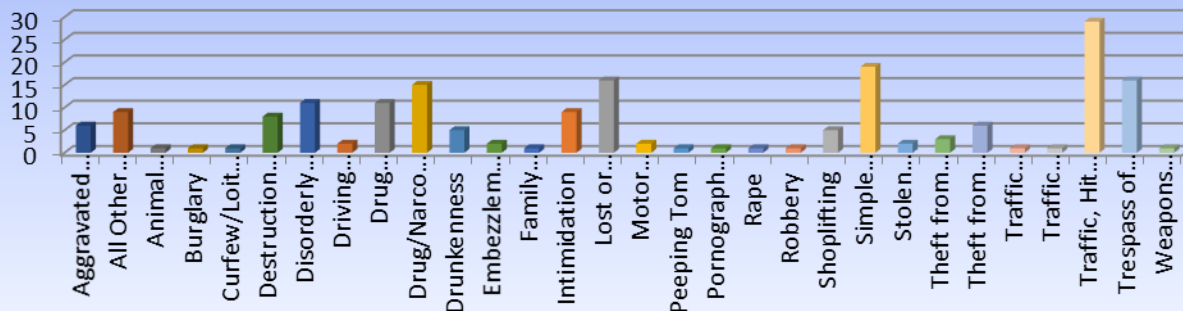
